# Tasmanian Crime Prevention & Community Safety Awards 2008

Every year individuals and organisations make significant contributions to making Tasmania a safer place.

The Tasmanian Crime Prevention & Community Safety Awards acknowledge outstanding contributions to crime prevention and community safety in the Tasmanian community. The Awards aim to raise awareness about crime prevention and community safety issues.

Nominations are being called for the following categories:

## CATEGORY 1 Volunteer Award

This Award recognises the outstanding contribution by a volunteer to a crime prevention organisation or community safety program.

## CATEGORY 2 Individual Award

Awarded in recognition of a paid individual's outstanding contribution to an innovative crime prevention and/or community safety project/program.

## CATEGORY 3 Group Innovation Award

Awarded in recognition of an outstanding contribution by a group to an innovative crime prevention and/or community safety project/program. The program must have commenced between 1st July 2007 and 30th June 2008 in order to be eligible.

## CATEGORY 4 Journalism Award

The Journalism Award recognises an outstanding contribution to community understanding of crime prevention and/or community safety issues. The Award includes all forms of media (radio, press, newspaper, printed publications and electronic media). The article or item must have been published or aired between 1st July 2007 and 30th June 2008.

## CATEGORY 5 Women's Safety Award

Awarded on behalf of *Women Tasmania* in recognition of an outstanding contribution by an individual or group to a crime prevention or community safety initiative that aims to increase women's safety in the community.

## Award Ceremony

Award Certificates will be presented at a formal ceremony in early December with the date, time and place to be announced closer to the day.

## Eligibility

Individuals or groups in Tasmania from a business, project, government department, non-government organisation or a combination thereof are eligible for nomination.

## Criteria

Nominations must be made on the official Awards Nomination Form. Be sure to include all relevant supporting documentation with the Nomination Form.

### CATEGORY 1 Volunteer Award

- Completed Nomination Form
- A description of the project, program or organisation including its aims and objectives
- A brief 250-300 word overview about the volunteer's contribution to the organisation (this should include the length and quality of service provided by the volunteer and why their contribution has been outstanding).

### CATEGORY 2 Individual Award

- Completed Nomination Form
- A description of the project, program or organisation including its aims and objectives
- Why the project/program is innovative, and its effect on crime prevention and community safety
- A 250-300 word overview about the individual's contribution to the project/program and why their contribution has been outstanding.

### CATEGORY 3 Group Innovation Award

- Completed Nomination Form
- A description of the project, program or organisation including its aims and objectives
- Why the project/program is innovative, and its effect on crime prevention and community safety

- A 250-300 word overview about the group's contribution to the project/program and why their contribution has been outstanding.

### CATEGORY 4 Journalism Award

- Completed Nomination Form
- A copy of the article or program and the title
- A brief 250-300 word overview of the article or program and details of the research involved
- Some evidence of the impact it made on the community's understanding of crime prevention and/or community safety and why it is considered to be outstanding.

### CATEGORY 5 Women's Safety Award

- Completed Nomination Form
- A description of the project including its aims and objectives and how it has increased women's safety in the community
- A 250-300 word overview about the individual's or group's contribution to the initiative and why it is considered to be outstanding.
