### Disclaimer

The Corporate Performance Report is produced for internal purposes to measure the performance of our people, resources and systems, and to assist with the management of our business. The Report is made available to external stakeholders as the figures contained may be of public interest. Data are not extracted for the Report until one month after the reporting period has concluded. This one month period ensures there are sufficient opportunities for data to be entered into police systems and for quality assurance to be undertaken. However, the primary purpose of the Report is to measure internal performance, not provide official Departmental figures. There may be discrepancies between measures provided in this Report and official Departmental figures due to several possible factors.

Electronic data is extracted one month after the end of the reporting period (on the first day of the month).

Manual data is collated monthly by Reporting Services from information self-reported by organisational units within DPFEM or provided/downloaded from a variety of sources as indicated throughout the Report.

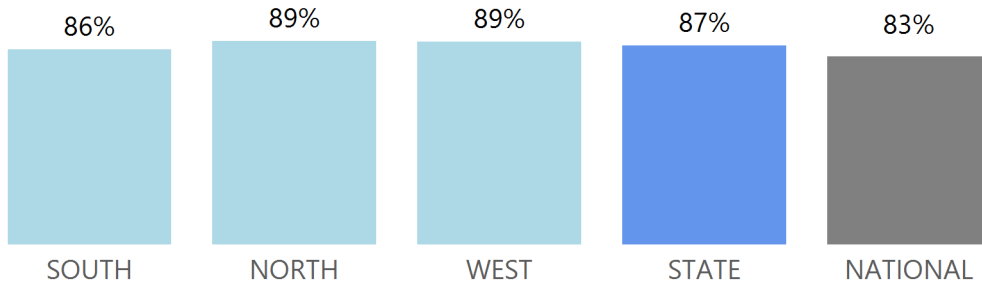

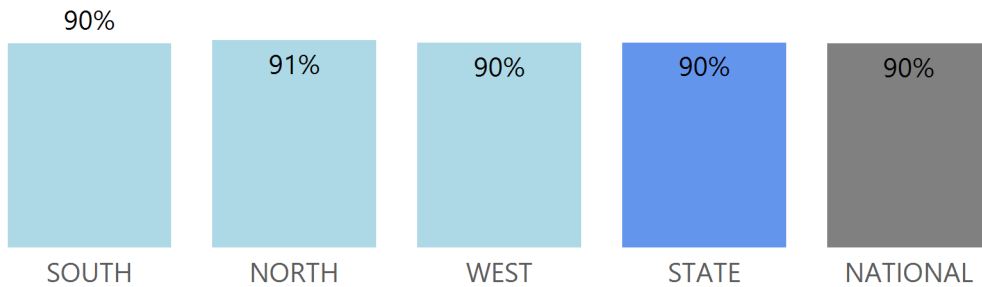

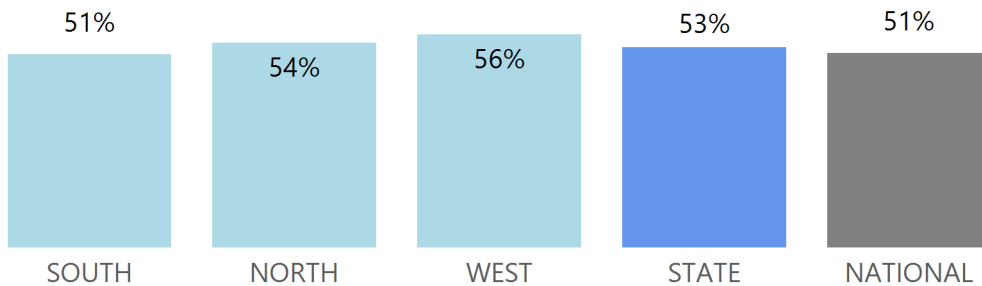
## Safety In Neighbourhood During the Day

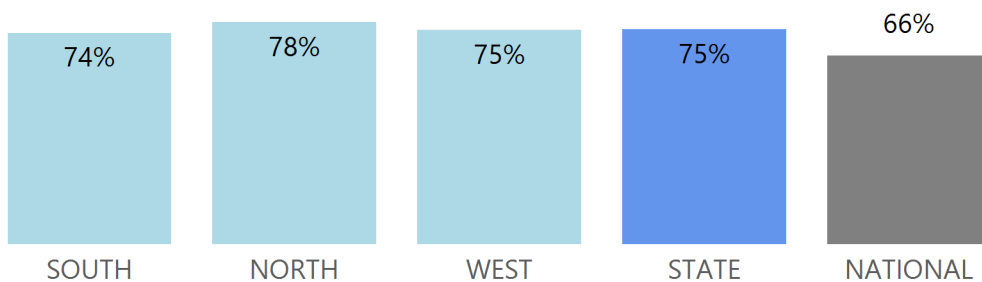

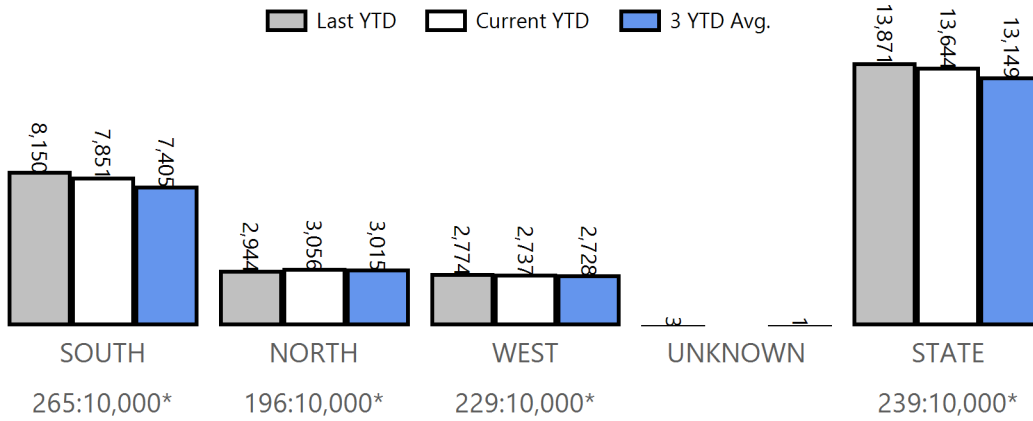

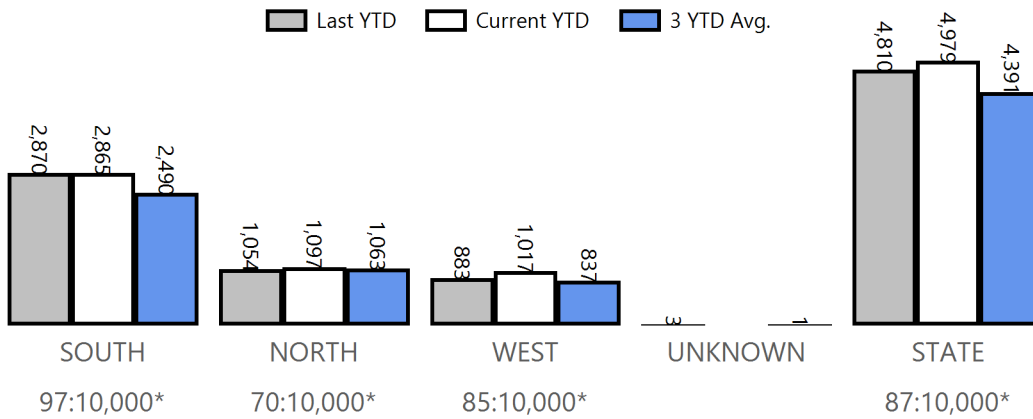
## Public Order Incidents - February 2024

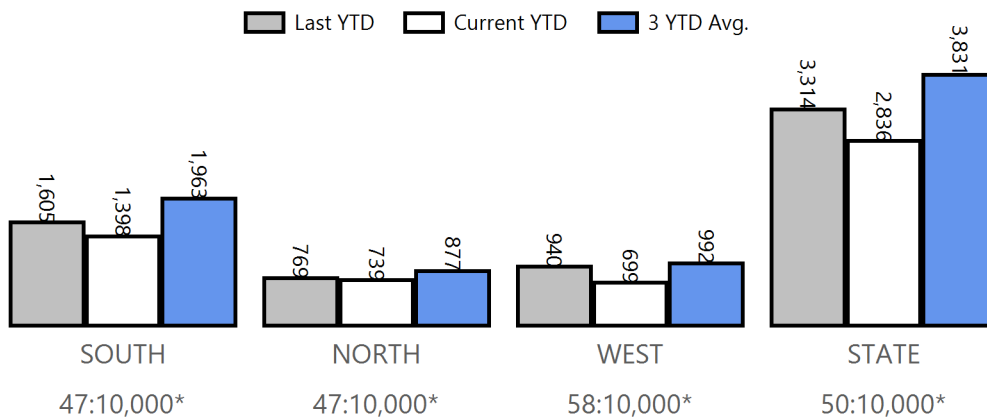
## Public Order : Disturbance - February 2024

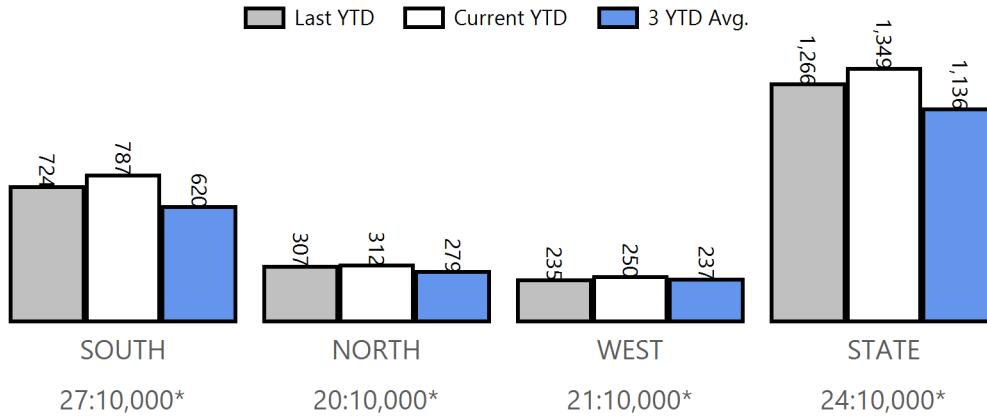
## Public Order : Noise - February 2024

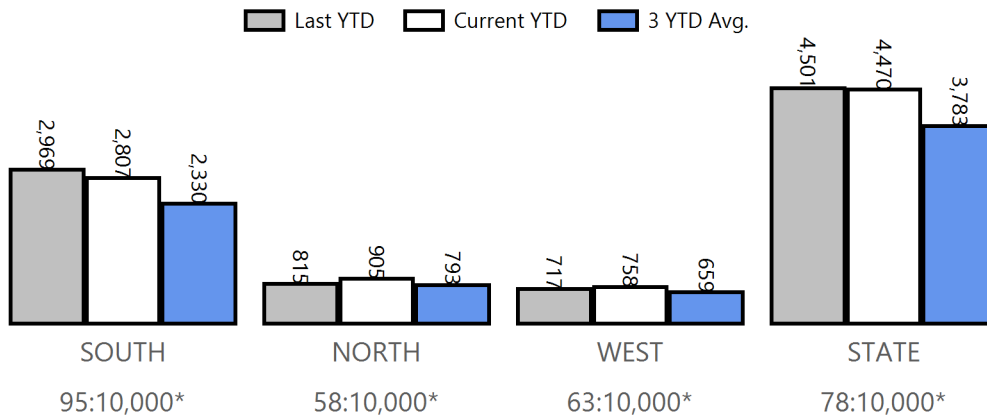
## Public Order : Vandalism - February 2024

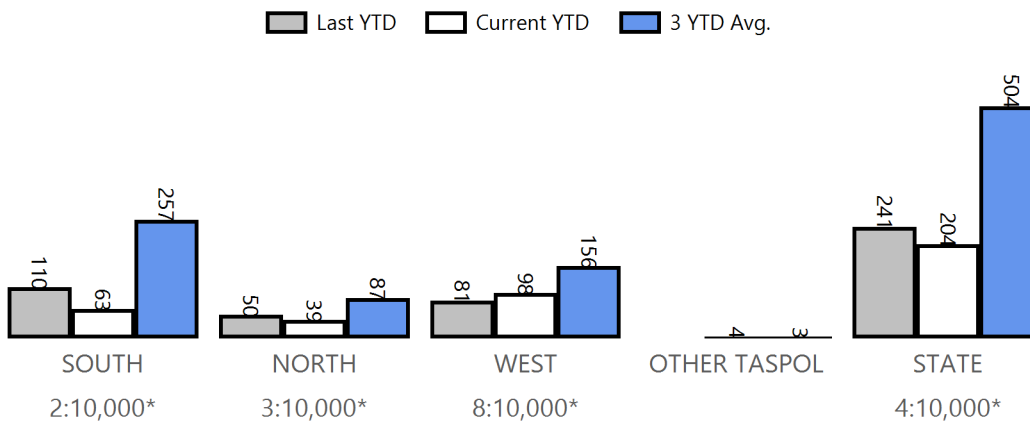
## Public Order : Offensive Behaviour - February 2024

## Liquor Infringement Notices - February 2024



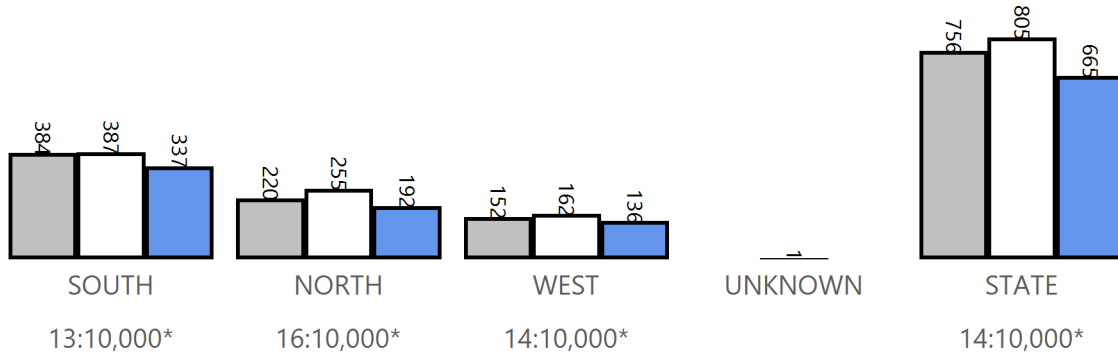

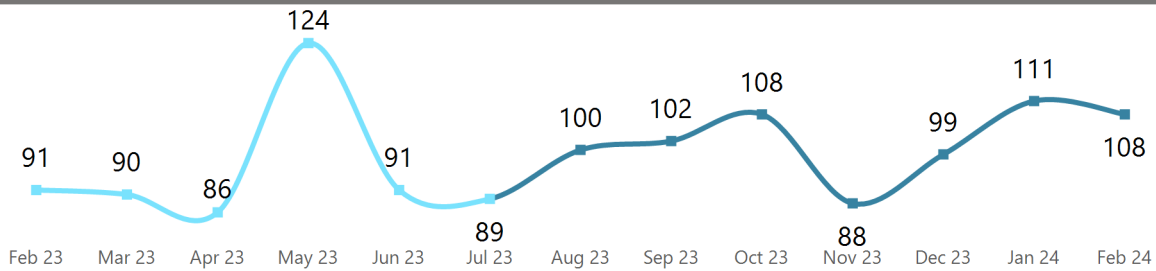


## Public Place Assaults - February 2024

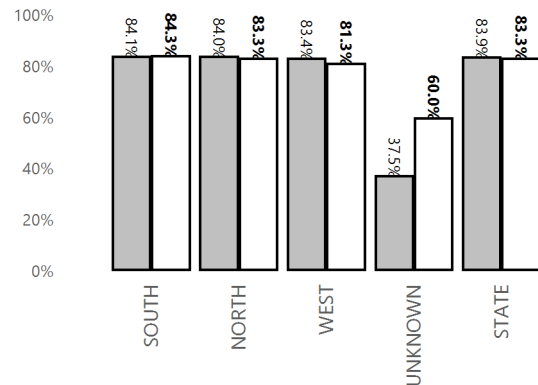

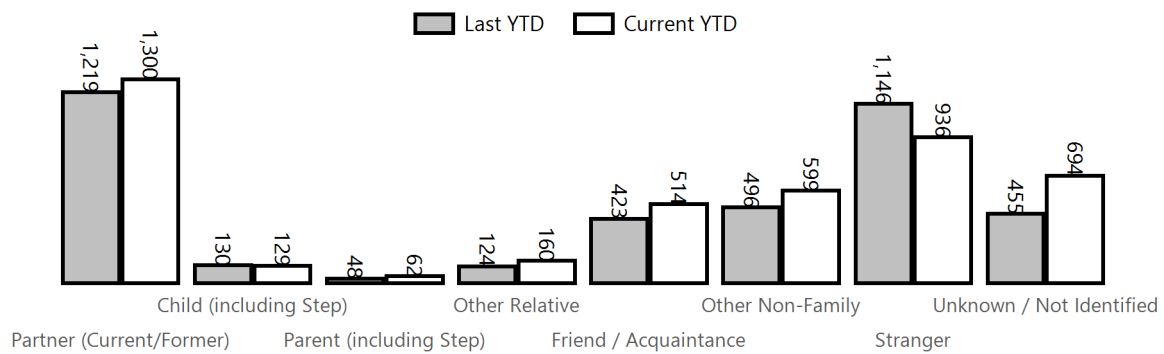

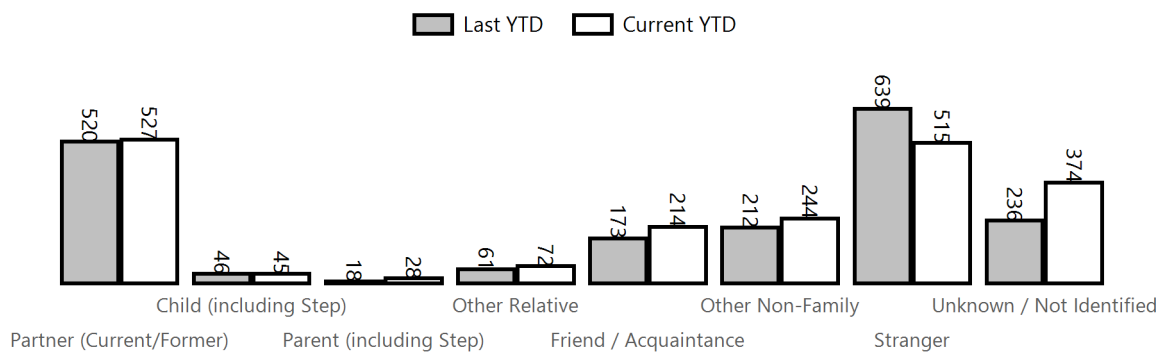

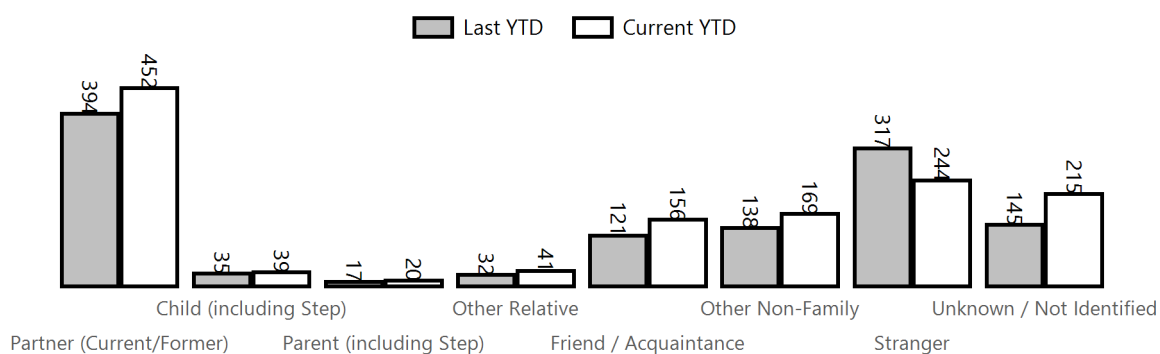

## Total Person Offences - Victim Relationship - SOUTH



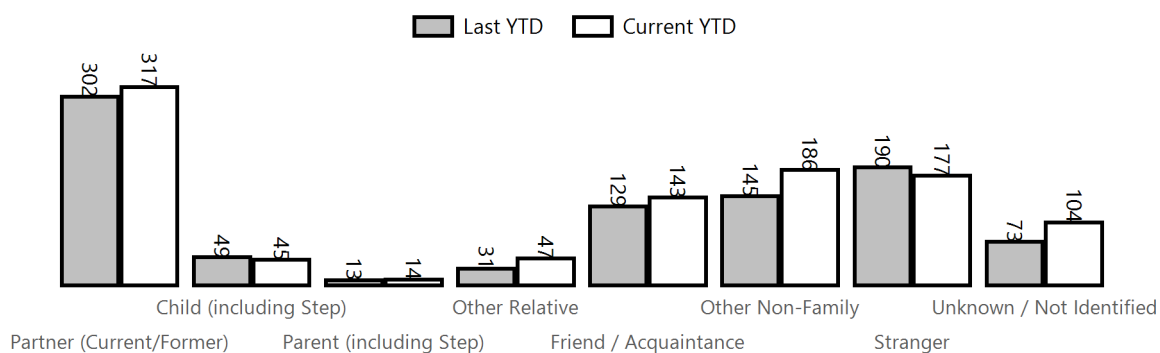

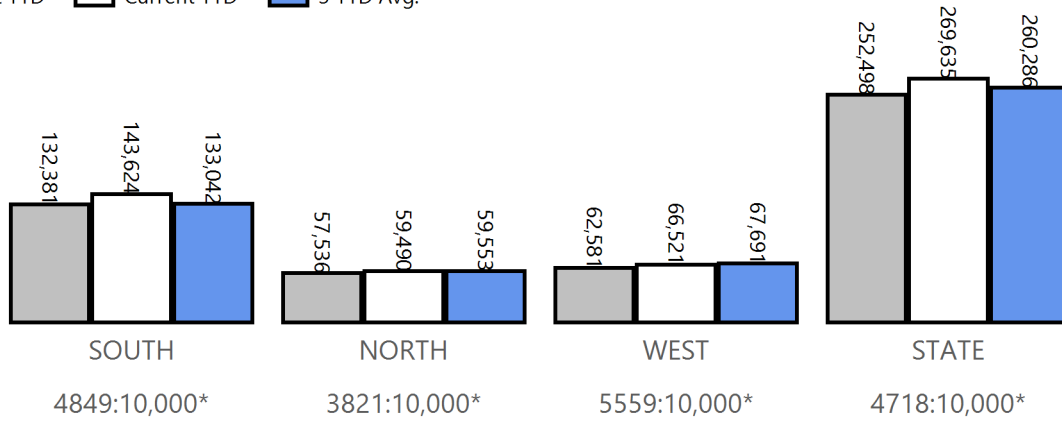

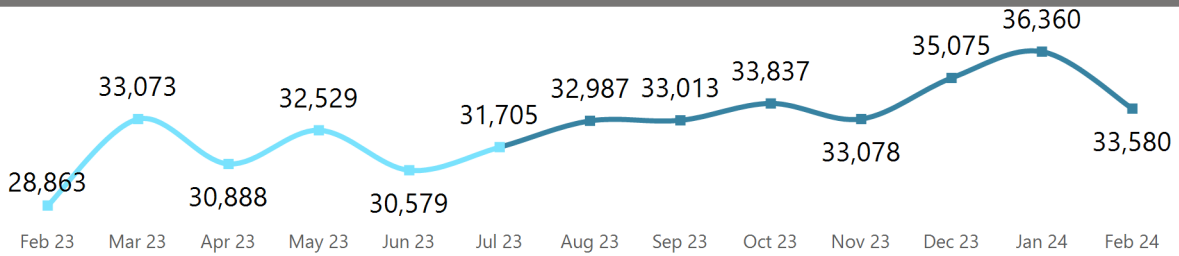
## Uniform Police Patrol Hours - February 2024

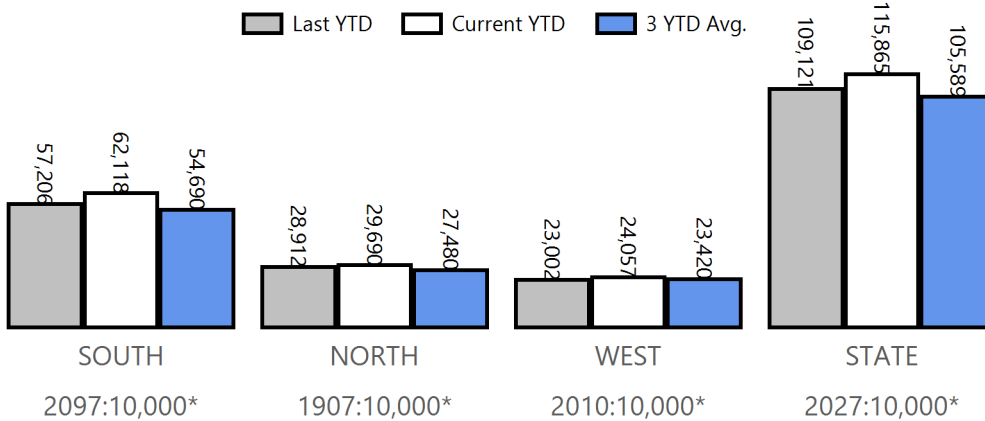
## Uniform Police - Patrol Hours

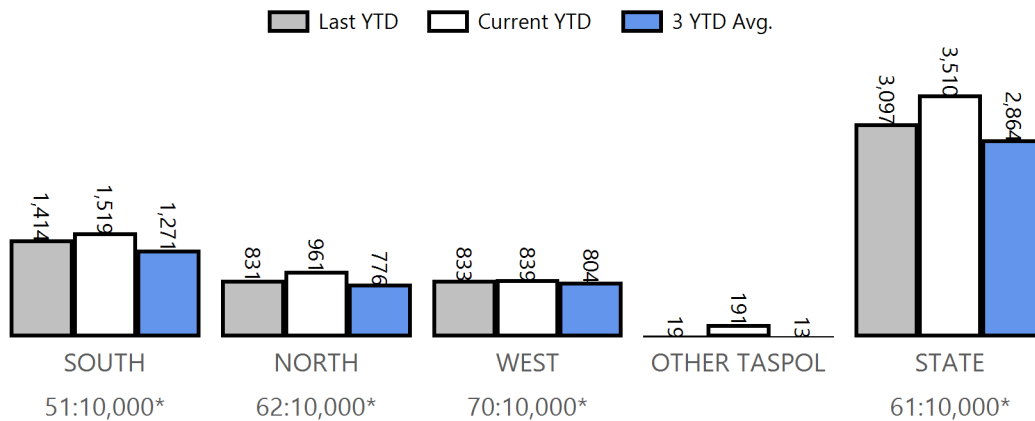

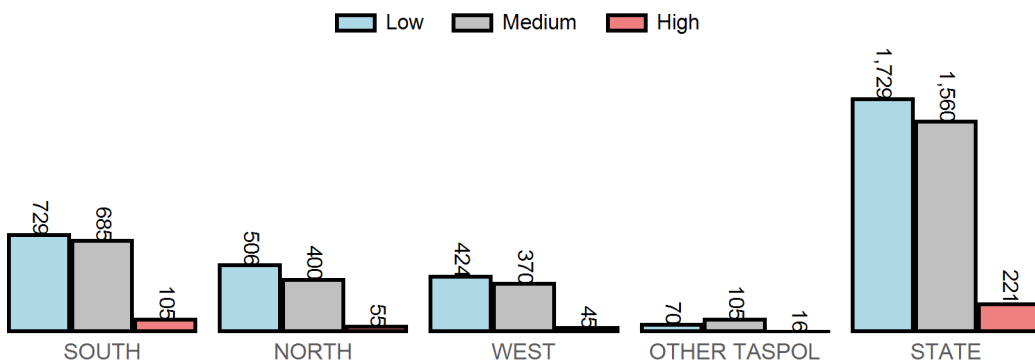

## Family Violence Incidents - February 2024



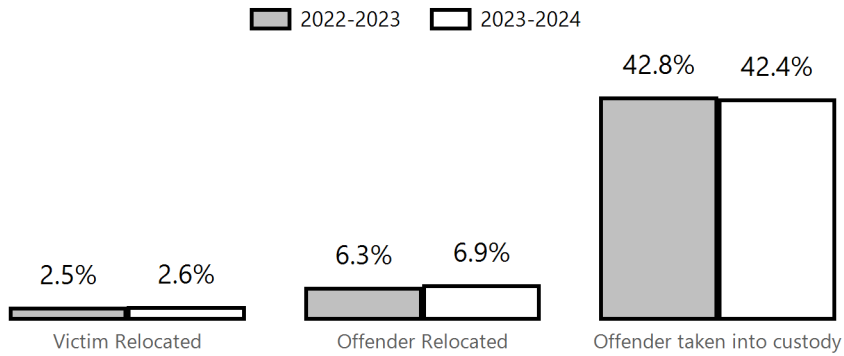

## Family Violence RAST - Excludes Other and Argument Categories



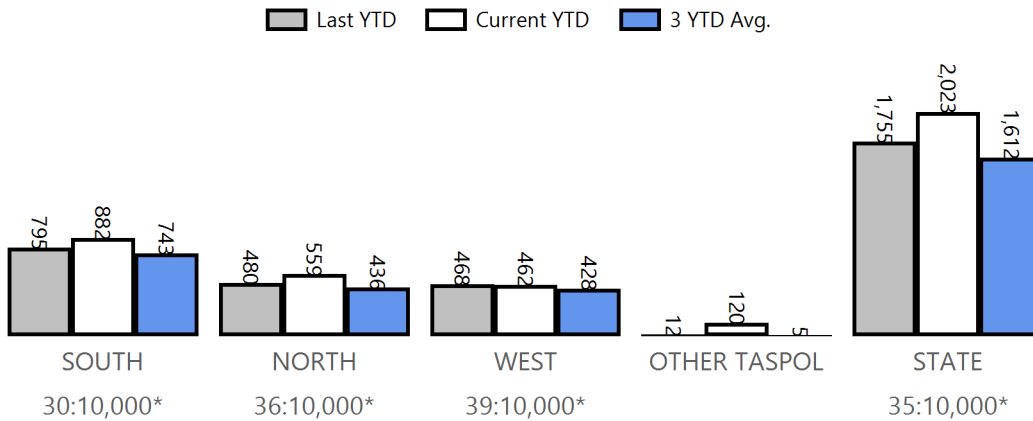

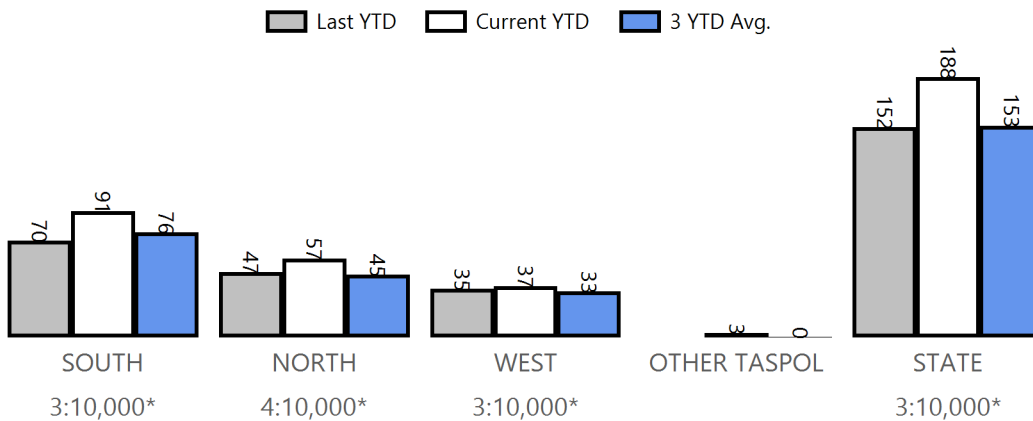
## Family Violence Incidents with Child Witness - February 2024

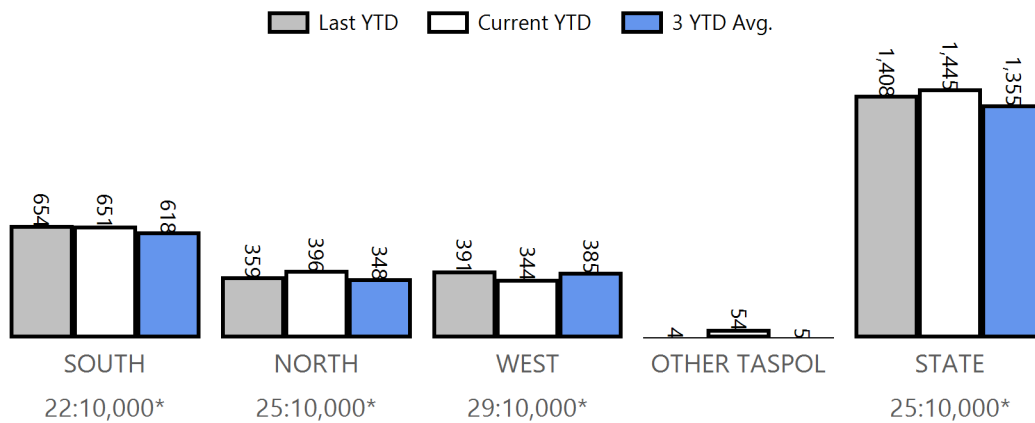

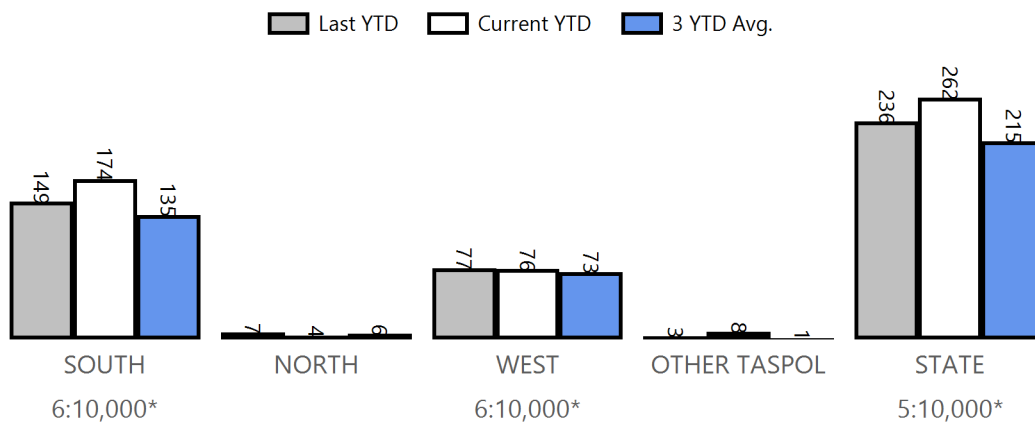
### FV Incidents with Police FV Order Issued - February 2024

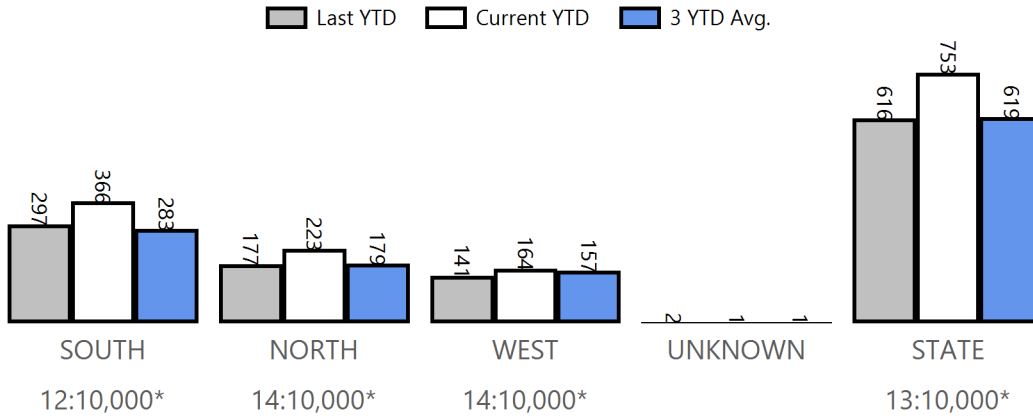
### FV Incidents with FV Order Application - February 2024

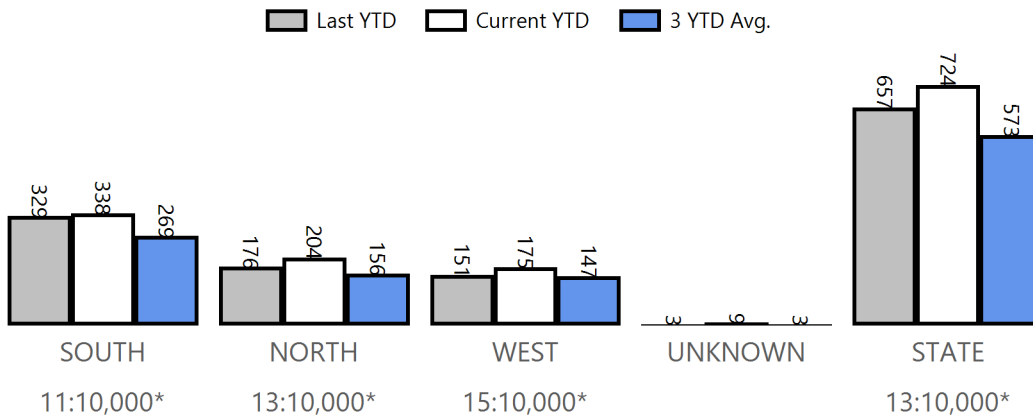
## Breach of Police Family Violence Orders - February 2024

## Breach of Family Violence Orders (excluding PFVOs) - February 2024

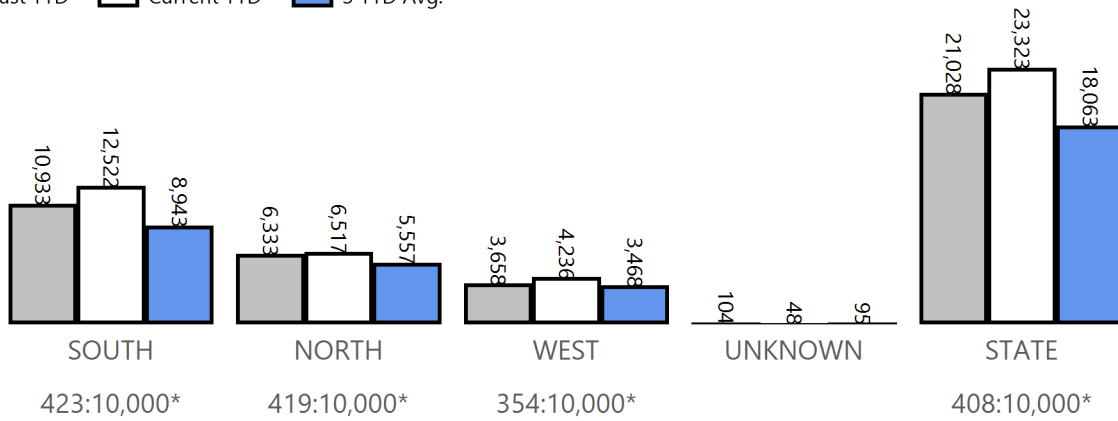

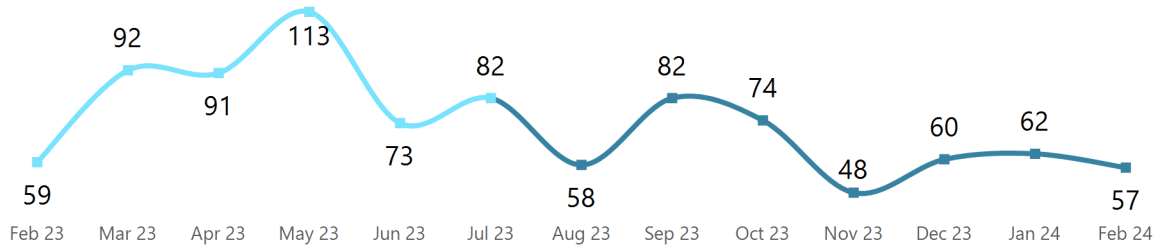

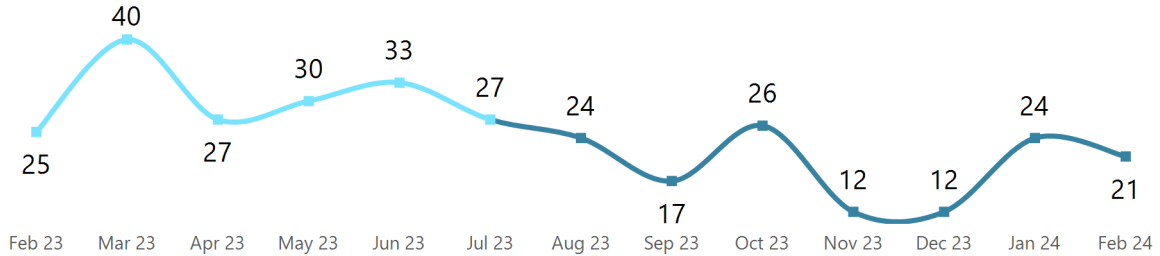
## SMV : Recovered Fire Damaged - February 2024

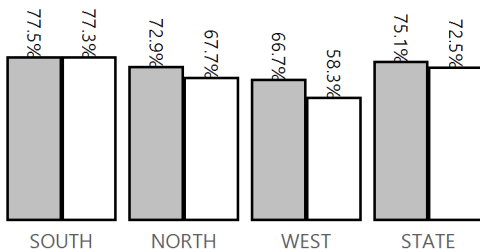

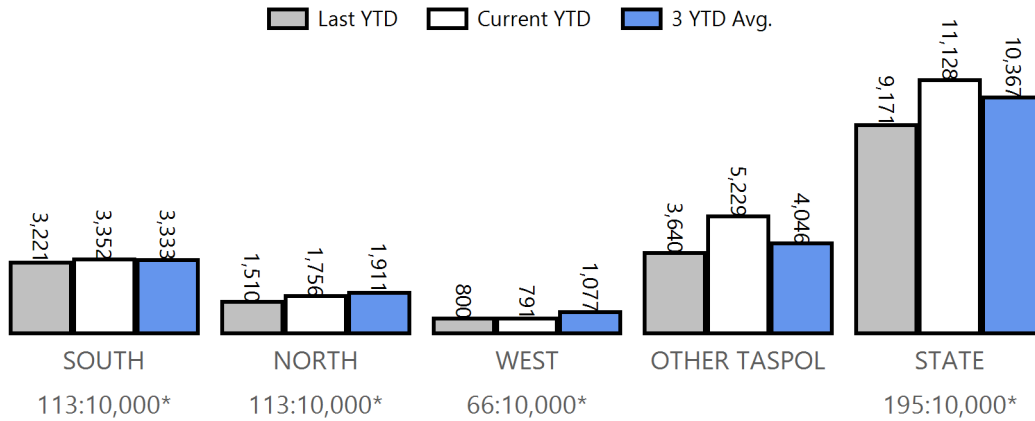

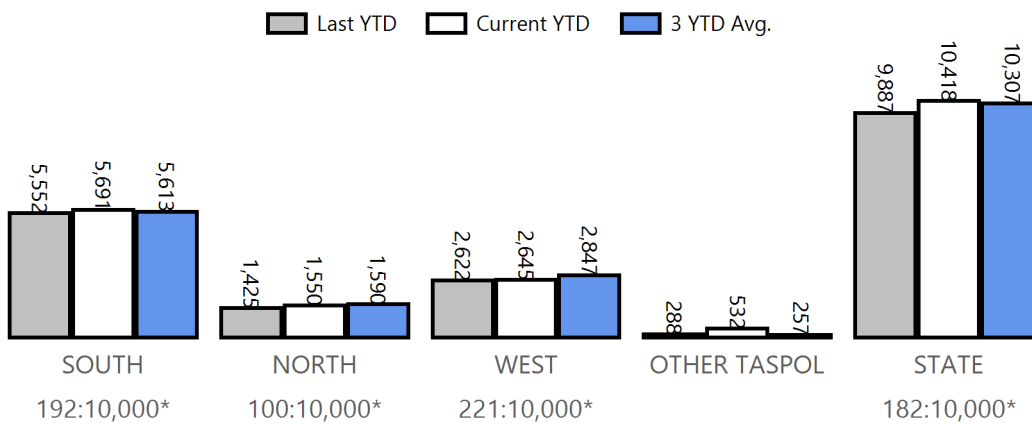
## Intelligence Submission Occurrences - February 2024

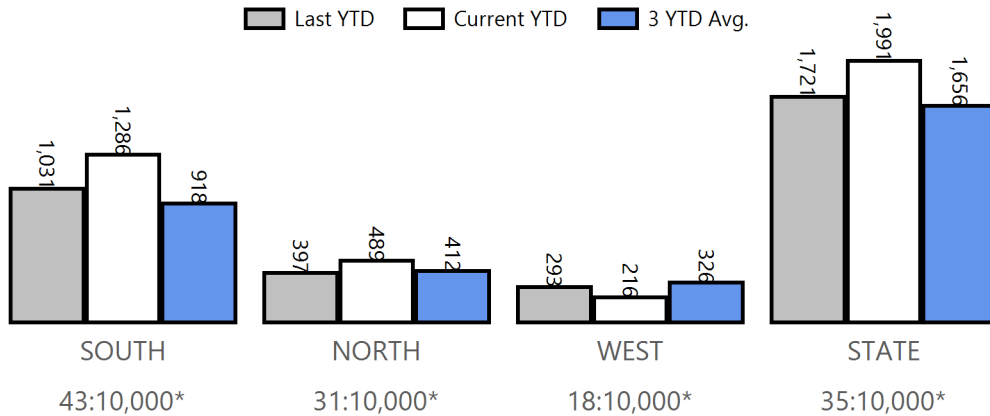
## Street Check Occurrences - February 2024

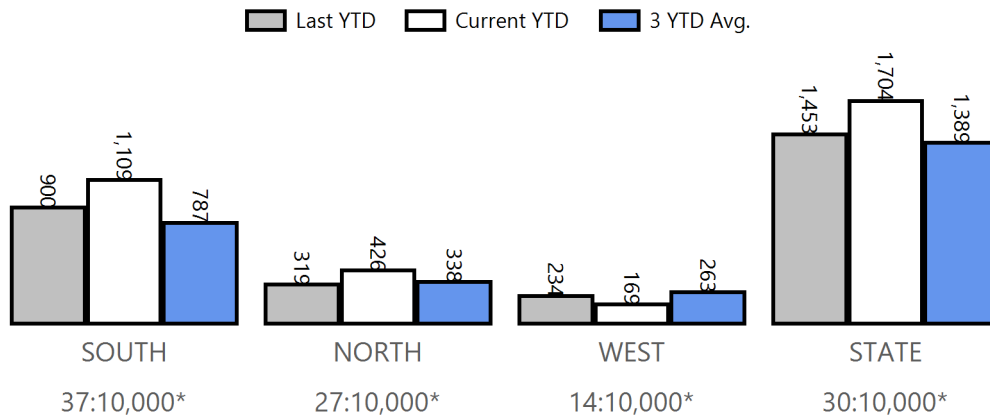
## CIB: Total Offenders - February 2024

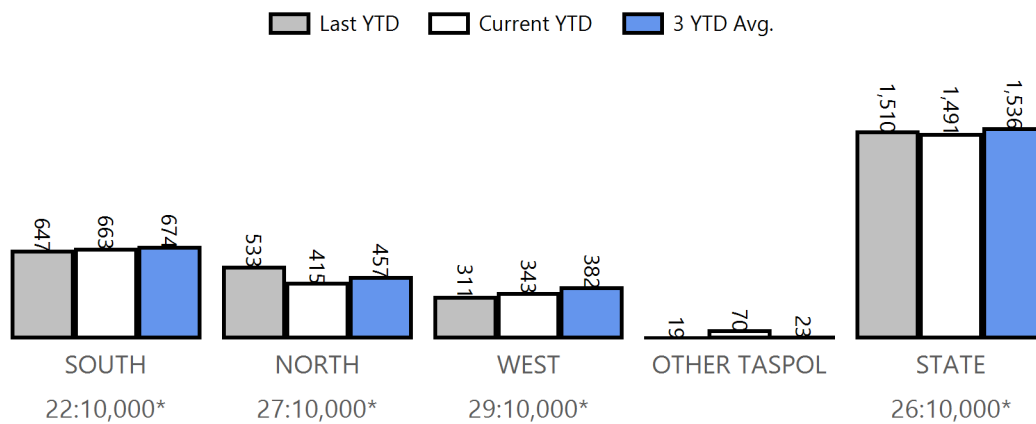

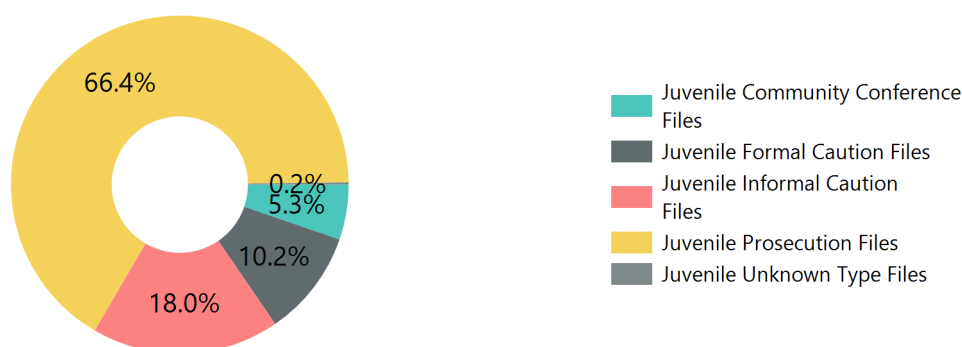

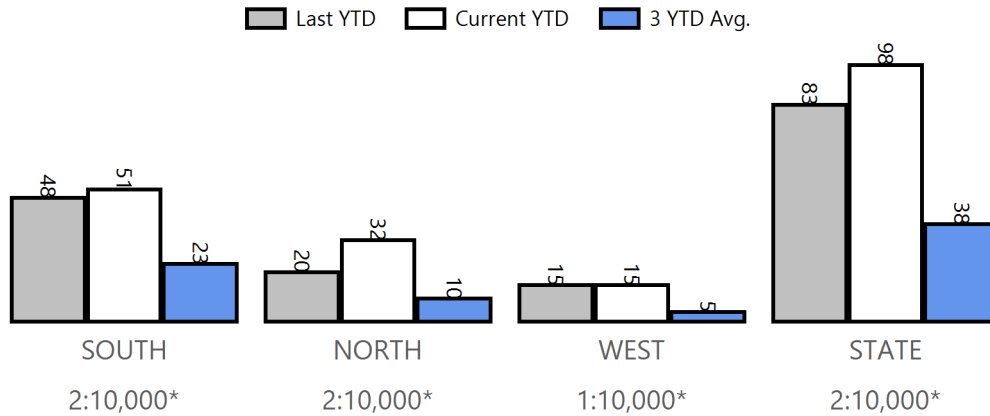

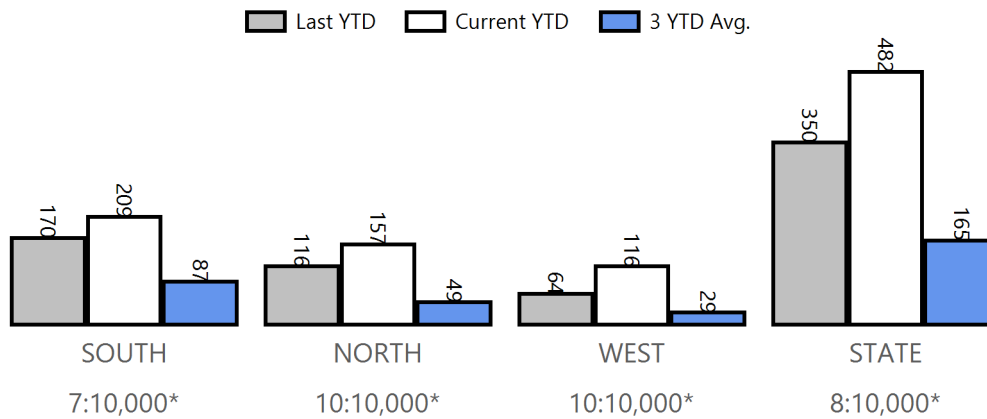
## Major Static District Traffic Operations - February 2024

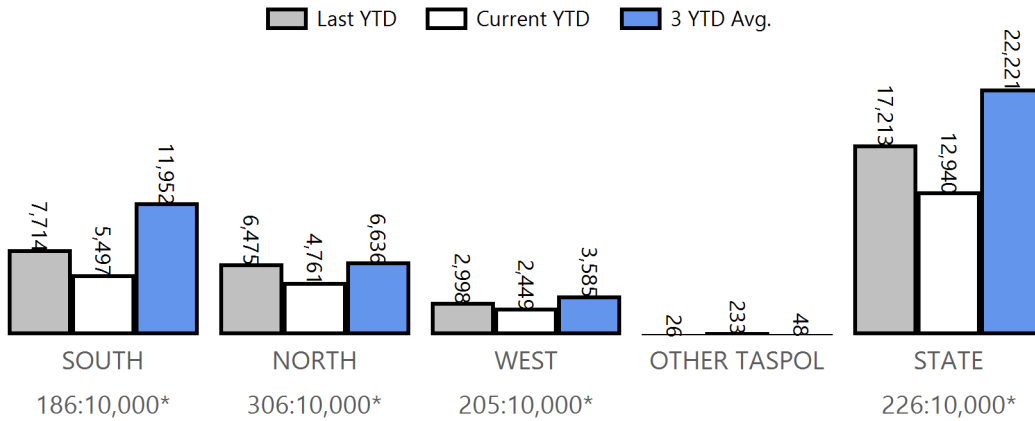

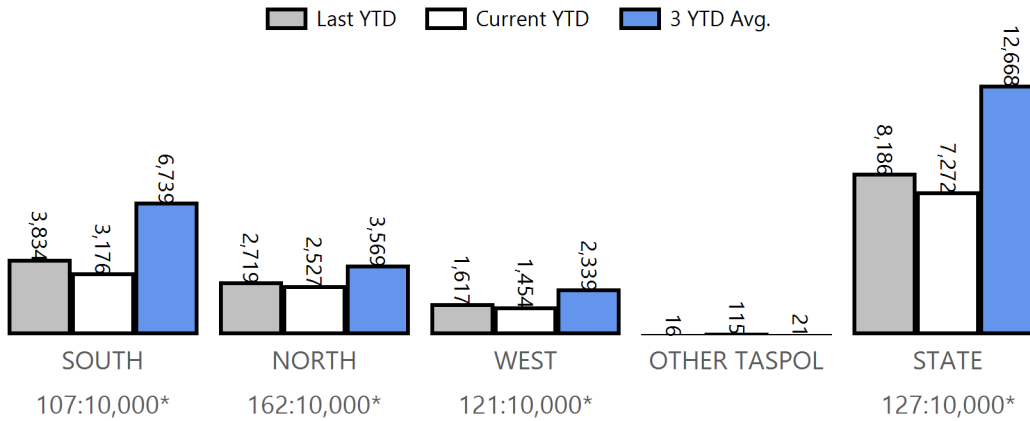
## Speeding Offenders - February 2024

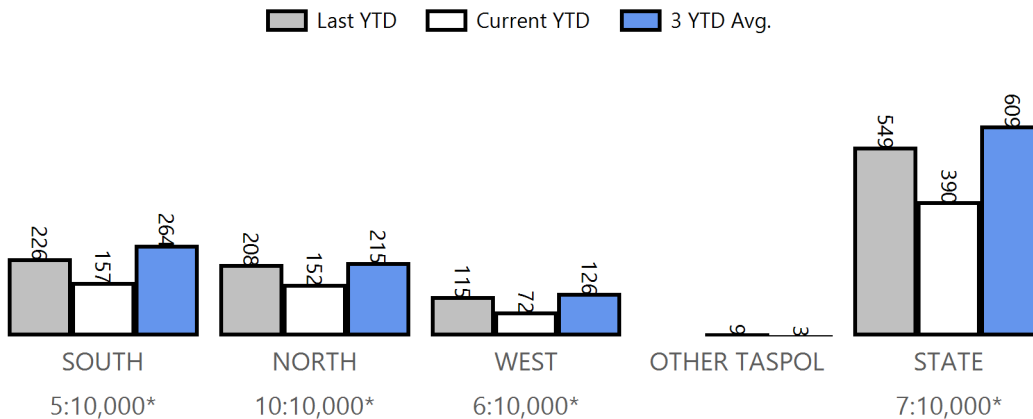
## Speeding 15-29 km/h Offenders - February 2024

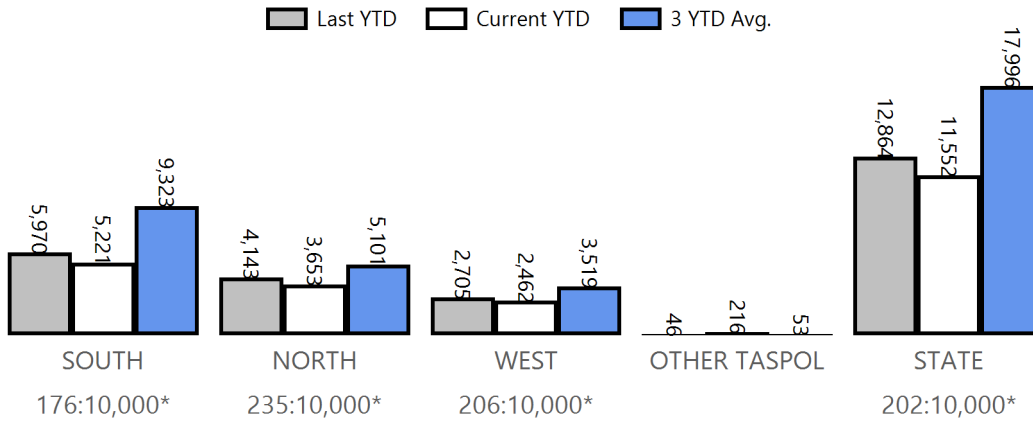

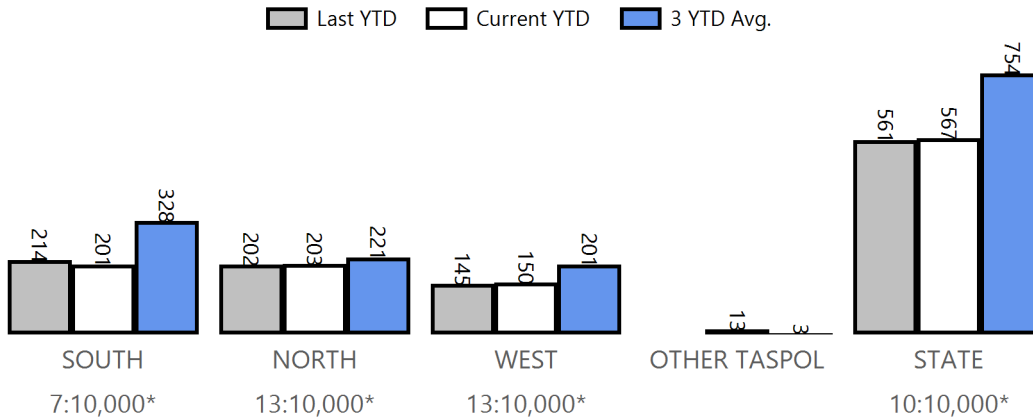
## High Risk Traffic Offenders - February 2024

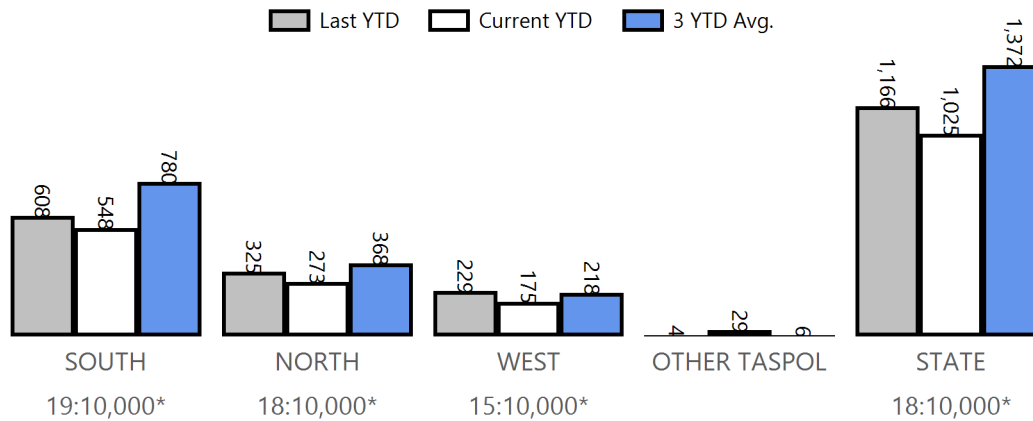
## Seatbelt Compliance Offenders - February 2024

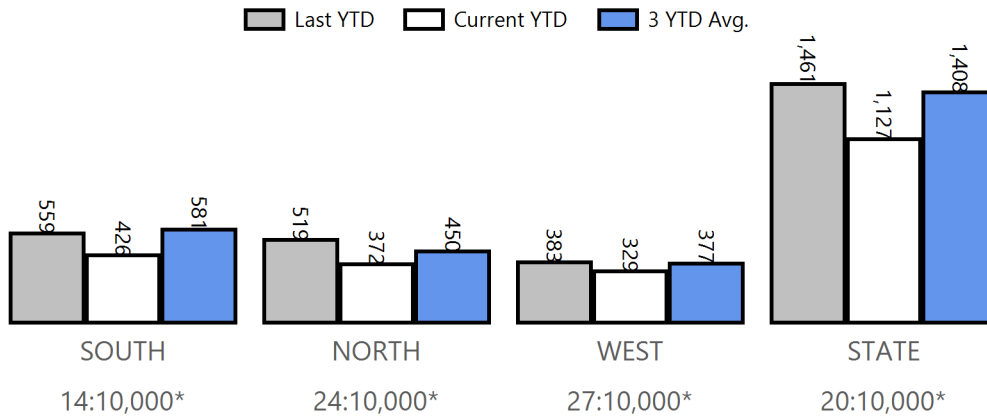
## Mobile Phone Offenders - February 2024

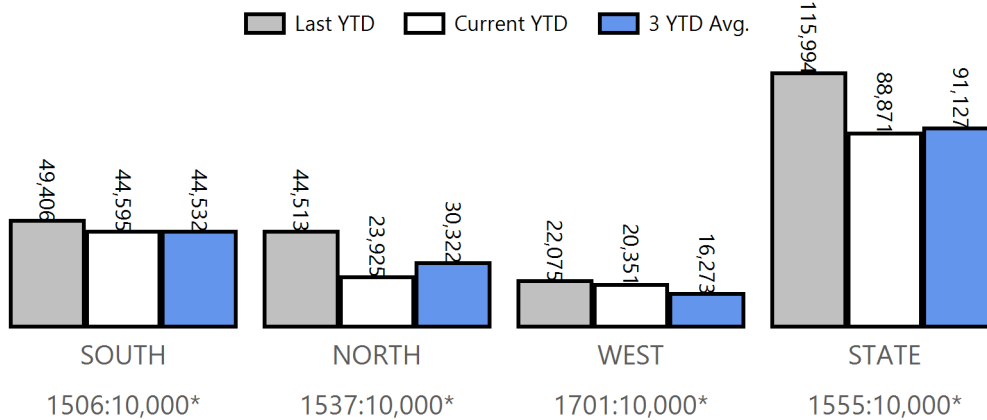
## Vehicle Defect Notices - February 2024

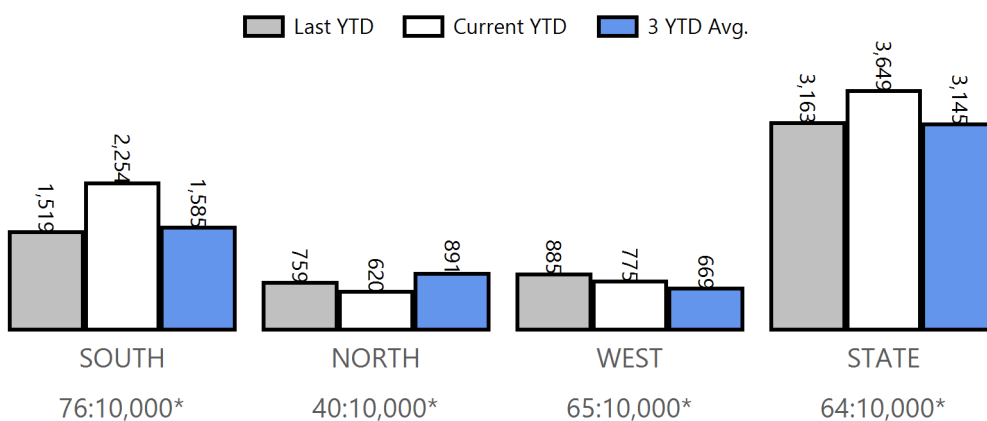
## Random Breath Tests (Alcohol) - February 2024

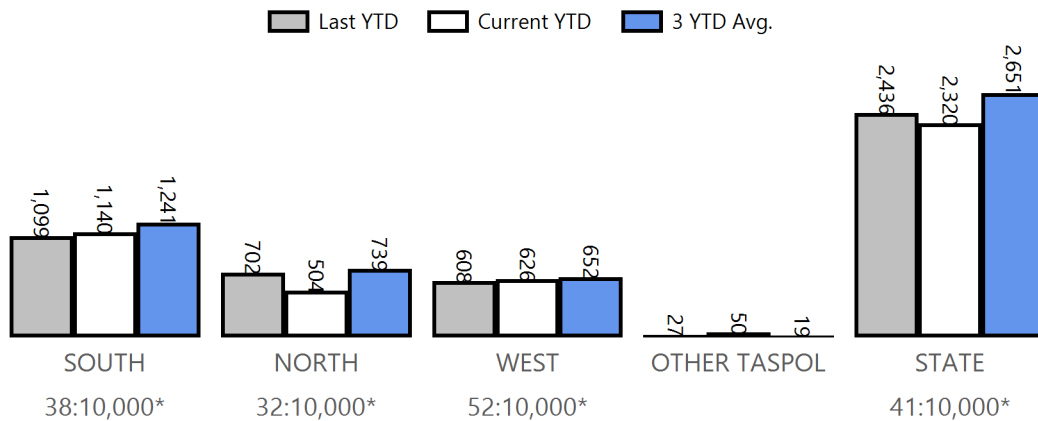
## Oral Fluid Tests (Drugs) - February 2024

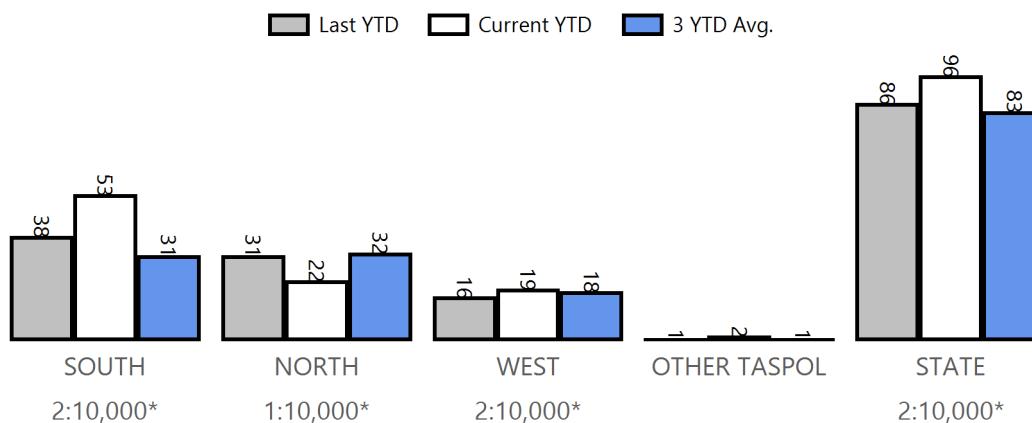

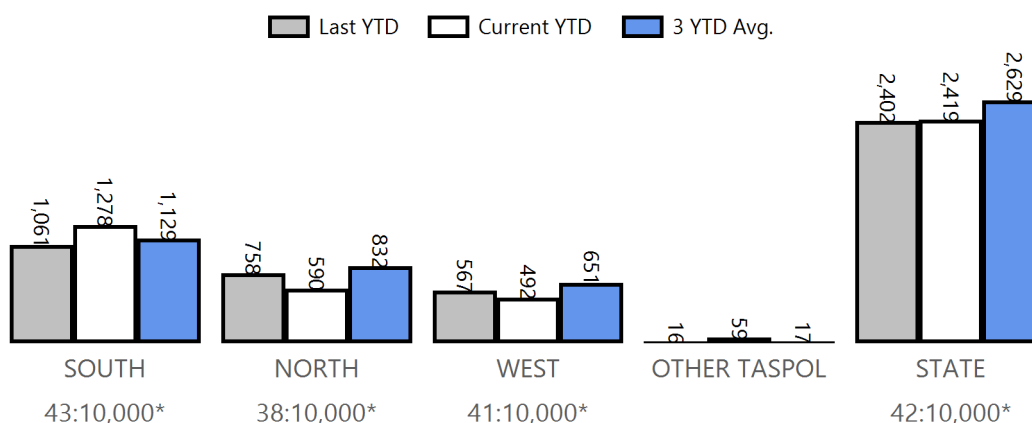
## Dangerous and Reckless Driving Offenders - February 2024

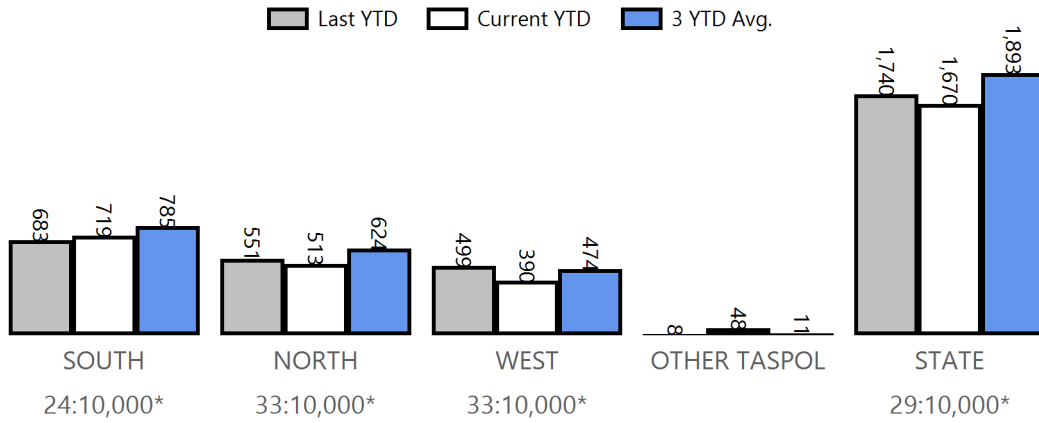

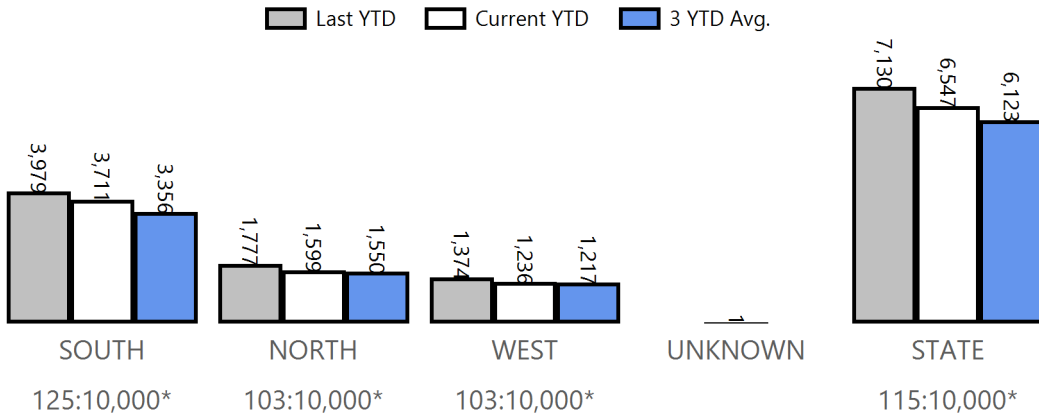
## Unregistered Vehicle Offenders - February 2024

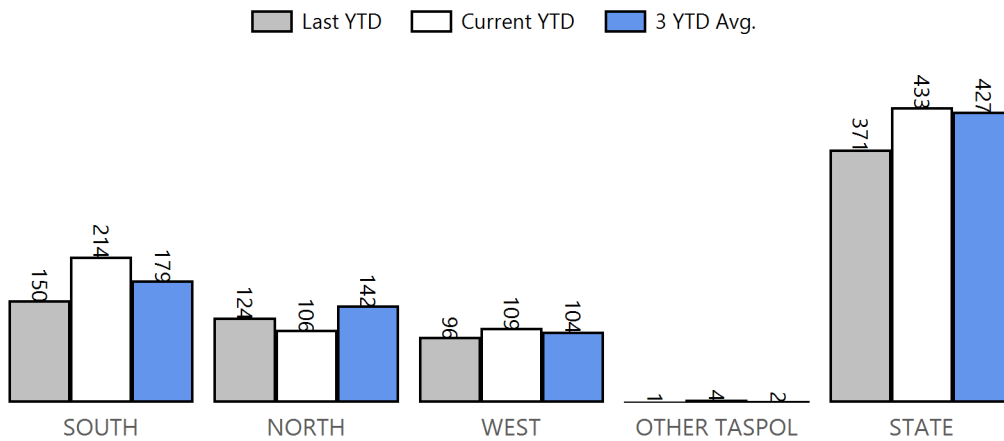
## Vehicle Complaint Dispatch Incidents - February 2024

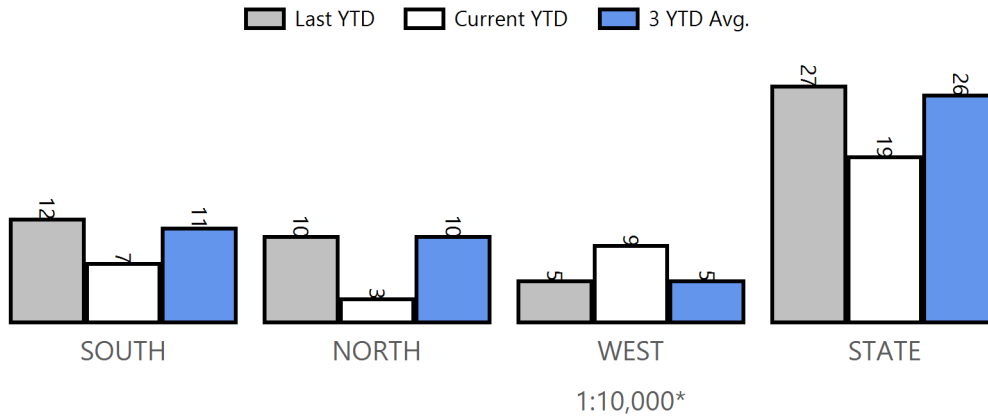

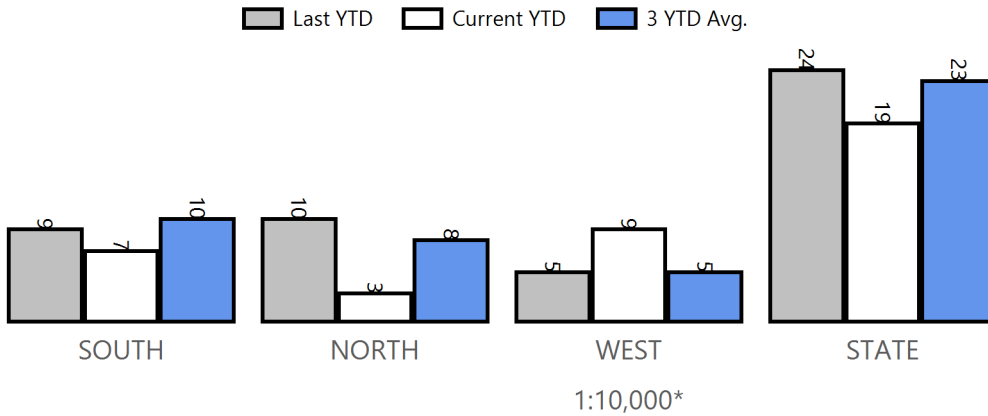
## Crash Fatalities - February 2024

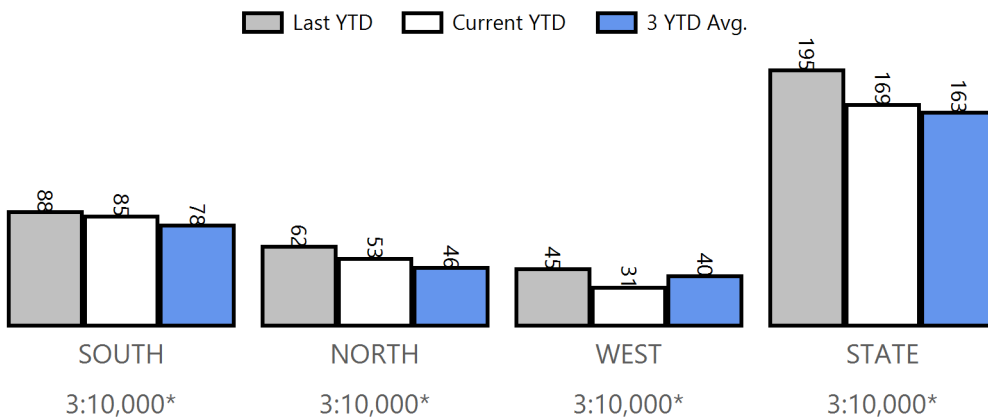
## Fatal Crashes - February 2024

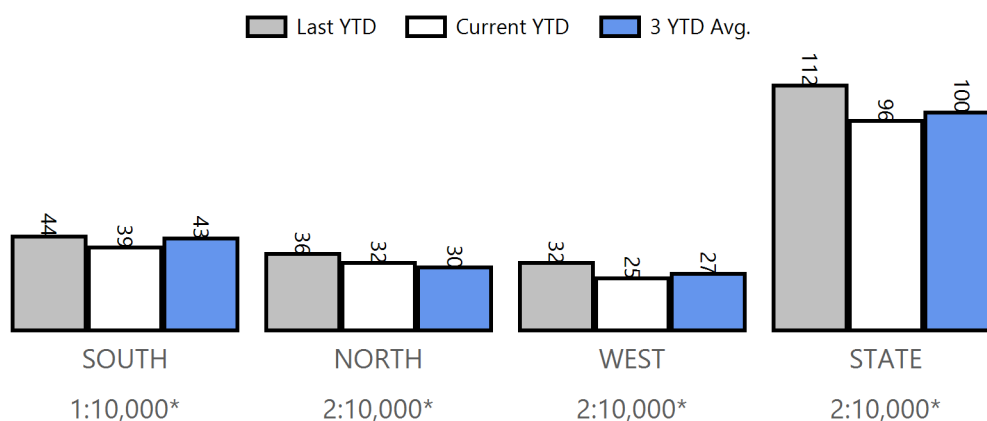

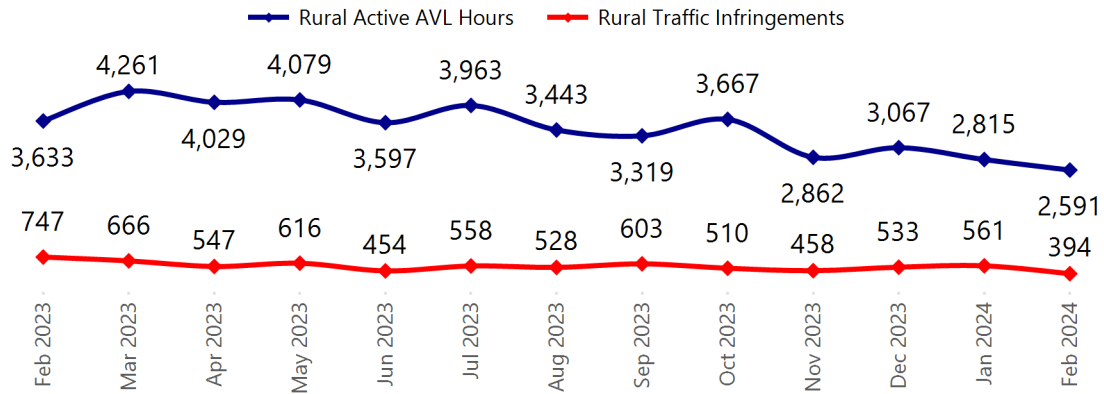
### On Road Fatal and Serious Crashes in Rural Areas - February 2024



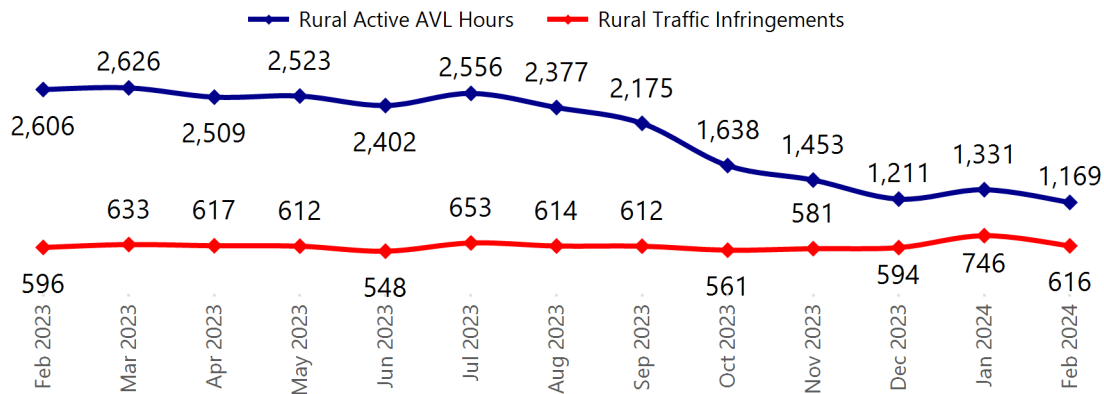

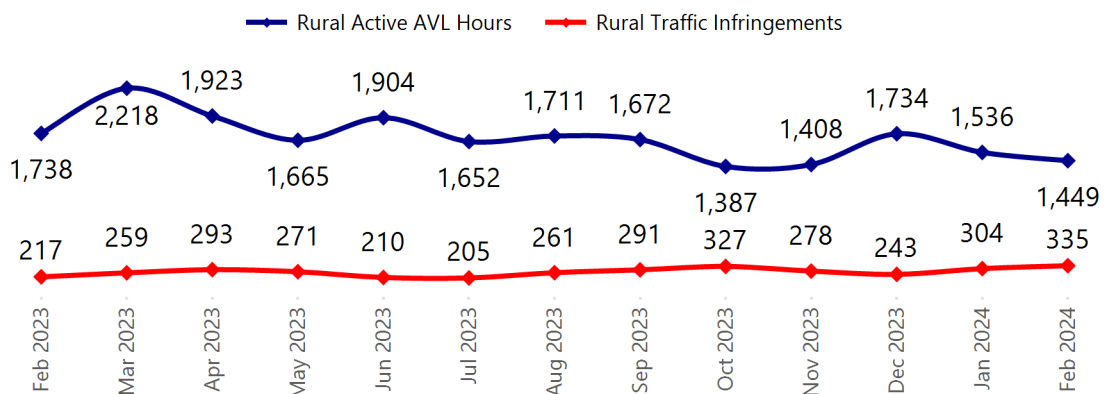
### Southern District Rural Policing



### Northern District Rural Policing

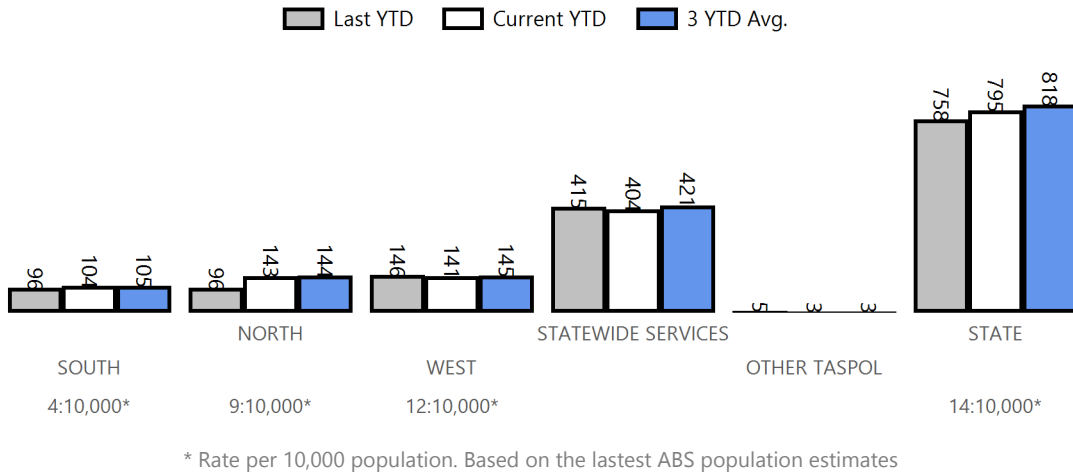

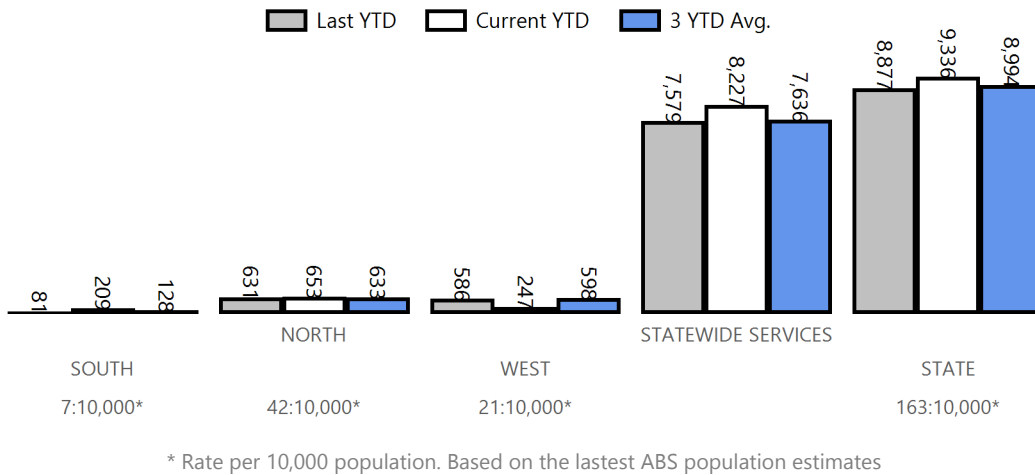

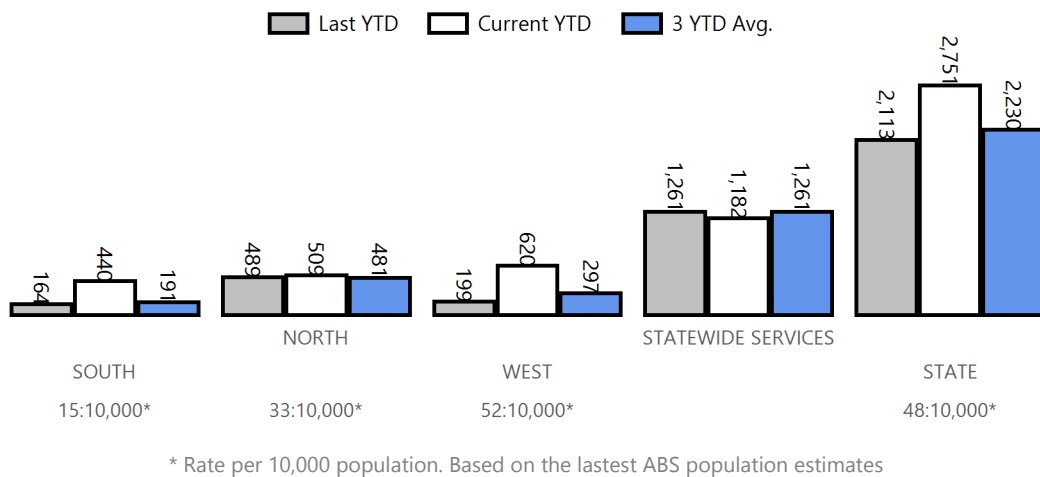


## Sea Inspections (Vessel & Non-Vessel) - February 2024



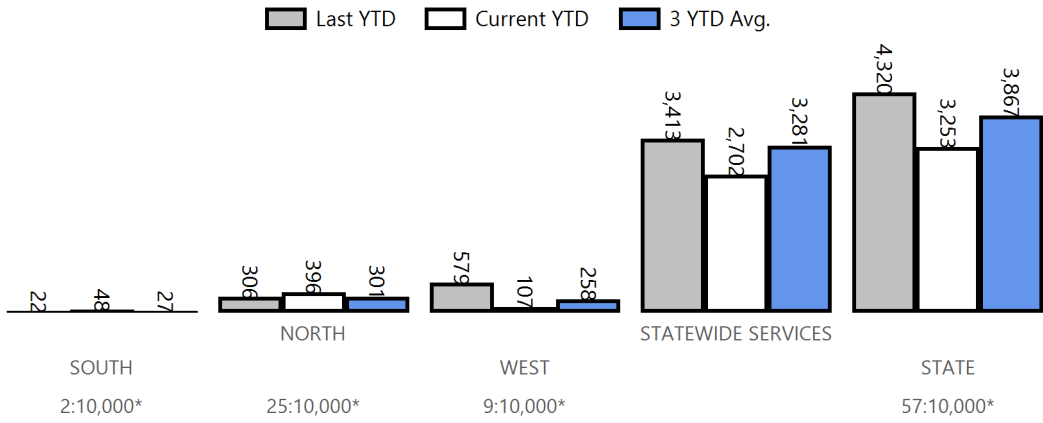
