#### Disclaimer

The Corporate Performance Report is produced for internal purposes to measure the performance of our people, resources and systems, and to assist with the management of our business. The Report is made available to external stakeholders as the figures contained may be of public interest. Data are not extracted for the Report until one month after the reporting period has concluded. This one month period ensures there are sufficient opportunities for data to be entered into police systems and for quality assurance to be undertaken. However, the primary purpose of the Report is to measure internal performance, not provide official Departmental figures. There may be discrepancies between measures provided in this Report and official Departmental figures due to several possible factors.

Electronic data is extracted one month after the end of the reporting period (on the first day of the month).

Manual data is collated monthly by Reporting Services from information self-reported by organisational units within DPFEM or provided/downloaded from a variety of sources as indicated throughout the Report.


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
## Safety at Home During the Night

(Survey respondents who answered "Safe/Very Safe".)




## Safety In Neighbourhood During the Day






## Public Order Incidents - January 2024


## Public Order : Disturbance - January 2024


## Public Order : Noise - January 2024


## Public Order : Vandalism - January 2024


## Public Order : Offensive Behaviour - January 2024

## Liquor Infringement Notices - January 2024













## Total Person Offences - Victim Relationship - SOUTH









The use of mean for response times reporting is no longer viable due to the changes in business processes following the implementation of the new dispatch system in 2017. The changeover to median reporting brings police into line with the other Tasmanian Emergency Services agencies and is consistent with the findings of an external audit into response times reporting.




## Uniform Police - Patrol Hours

## Uniform Police Hours on Dispatch Tasks - January 2024






### Family Violence Incidents - January 2024



### Family Violence RAST - Excludes Other and Argument Categories






## Family Violence Incidents with Child Witness - January 2024

## Family Violence Incidents: Weapons Present - January 2024






### FV Incidents with Police FV Order Issued - January 2024


### FV Incidents with FV Order Application - January 2024


## Breach of Police Family Violence Orders - January 2024

## Breach of Family Violence Orders (excluding PFVOs) - January 2024










## SMV : Recovered Fire Damaged - January 2024




## Intelligence Submission Occurrences - January 2024


## Street Check Occurrences - January 2024


## CIB: Total Offenders - January 2024

## CIB: Total Crime Offenders - January 2024








## Major Static District Traffic Operations - January 2024




## Speeding Offenders - January 2024


## Speeding 15-29 km/h Offenders - January 2024


## Speeding 30+ km/h Offenders - January 2024


## High Risk Traffic Offenders - January 2024


## Seatbelt Compliance Offenders - January 2024


## Mobile Phone Offenders - January 2024


## Vehicle Defect Notices - January 2024


## Random Breath Tests (Alcohol) - January 2024






## Dangerous and Reckless Driving Offenders - January 2024




## Unregistered Vehicle Offenders - January 2024


## Vehicle Complaint Dispatch Incidents - January 2024




## Crash Fatalities - January 2024


## Fatal Crashes - January 2024




## On Road Fatal and Serious Crashes in Rural Areas - January 2024






## Sea Inspections (Vessel & Non-Vessel) - January 2024


## Vessel Inspections on Land - January 2024
