
official Departmental figures. There may be discrepancies between measures provided in this Report and official Departmental figures due to several possible factors.

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


Public Safety - Out in Public Locally (Daytime)


Total Person Offences - Victim Relationship - SOUTH



Family Violence Orders : Police Issued - March 2023






Vehicle Defect Notices - March 2023

Road Crashes: Fatalities YTD - March 2023








Sea Inspections (Vessel & Non-Vessel) - March 2023




