# **Corporate Performance Report**

#### Disclaimer

The Corporate Performance Report is produced for internal purposes to measure the performance of our people, resources and systems, and to assist with the management of our business. The Report is made available to external stakeholders as the figures contained may be of public interest. Data are not extracted for the Report until one month after the reporting period has concluded. This one month period ensures there are sufficient opportunities for data to be entered into police systems and for quality assurance to be undertaken. However, the primary purpose of the Report is to measure internal performance, not provide official Departmental figures. There may be discrepancies between measures provided in this Report and official Departmental figures due to several possible factors.

Electronic data was extracted on 4 January 2021. Manual data is collated monthly by Reporting Services from information self-reported by organisational units within DPFEM or provided/downloaded from a variety of sources as indicated throughout the Report.

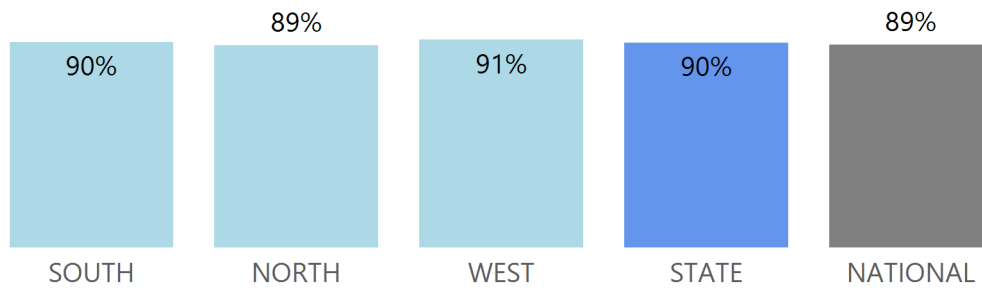

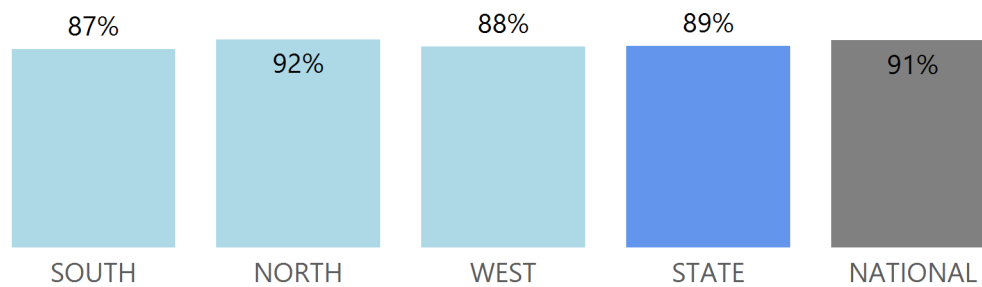

The question: "How safe do you feel at home in the daytime" has been removed from the SRC survey

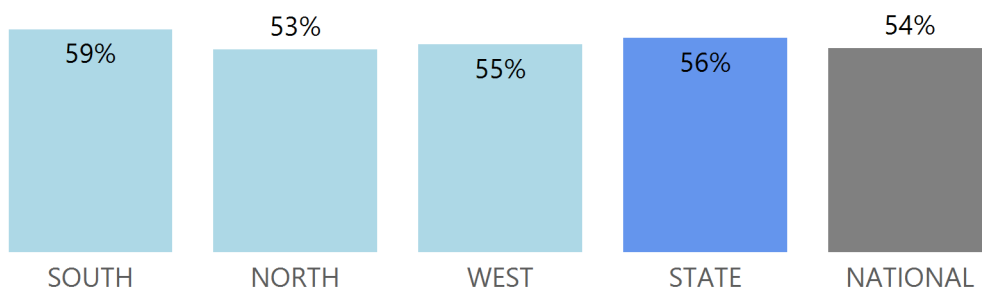
## Public Safety - Out in Public Locally (Daytime)

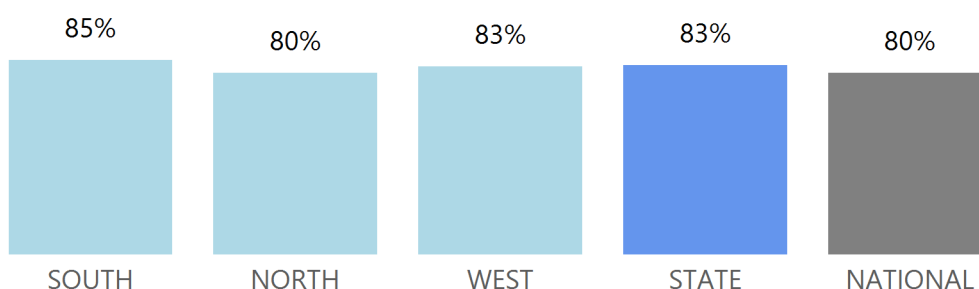

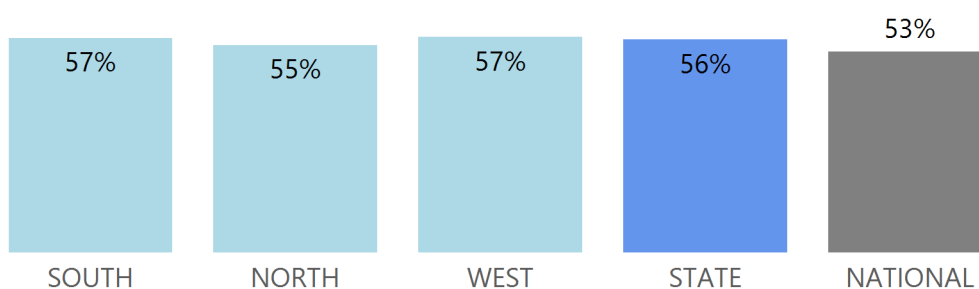
## General Satisfaction with Police Services

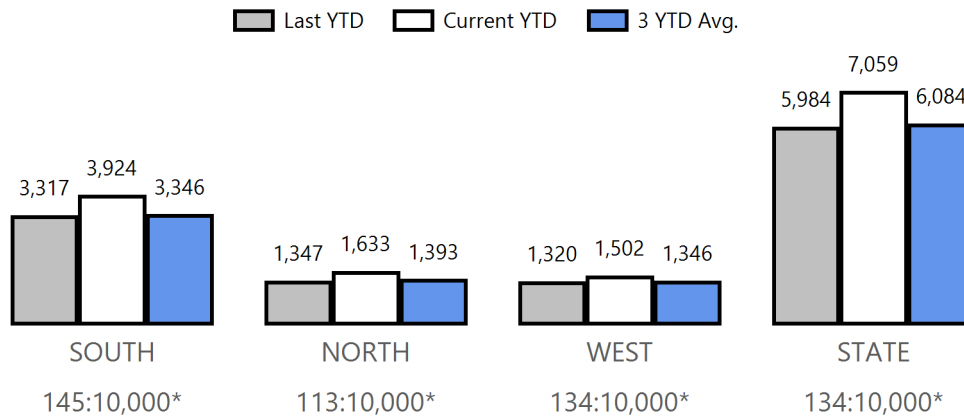
## Satisfaction - Dealing with Public Order Problems

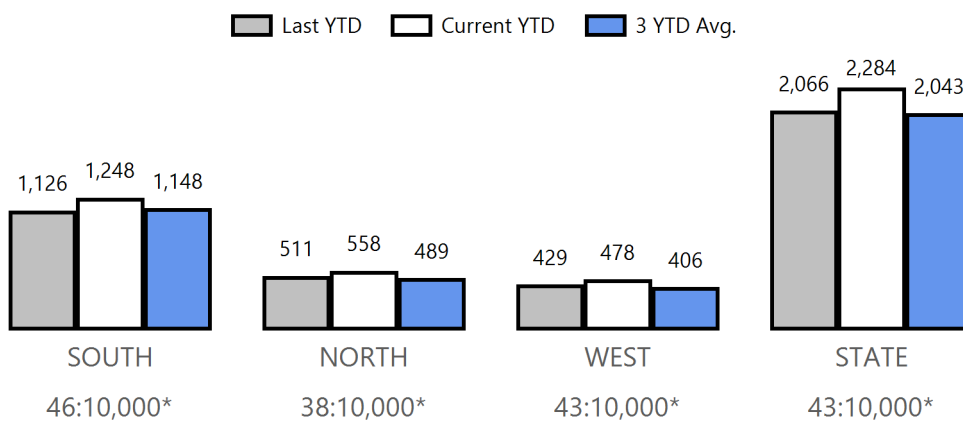
## Public Order Incidents - November 2020

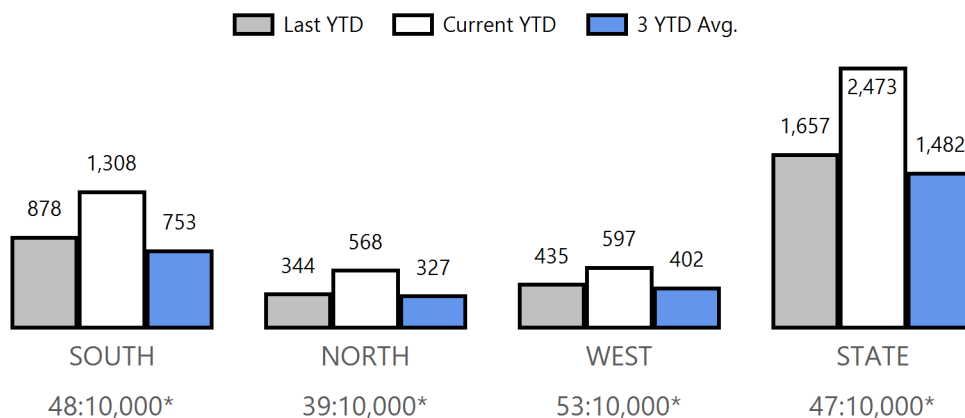
## Public Order : Disturbance - November 2020

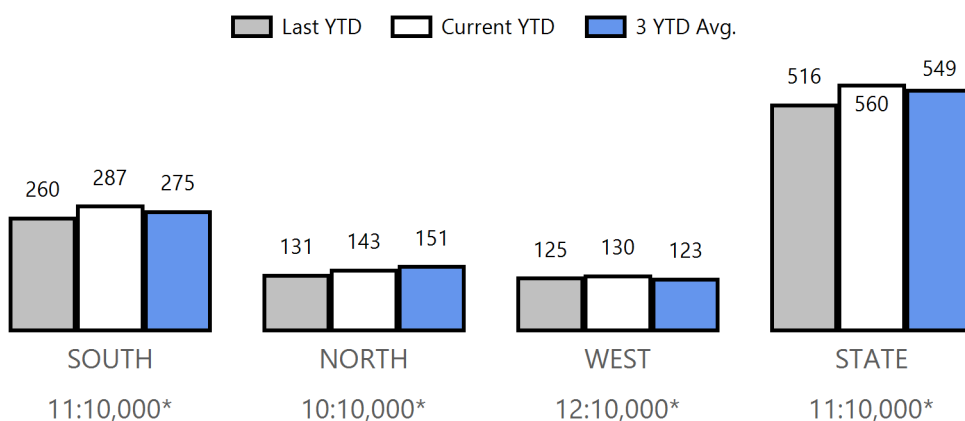
## Public Order : Noise - November 2020

## Public Order : Vandalism - November 2020

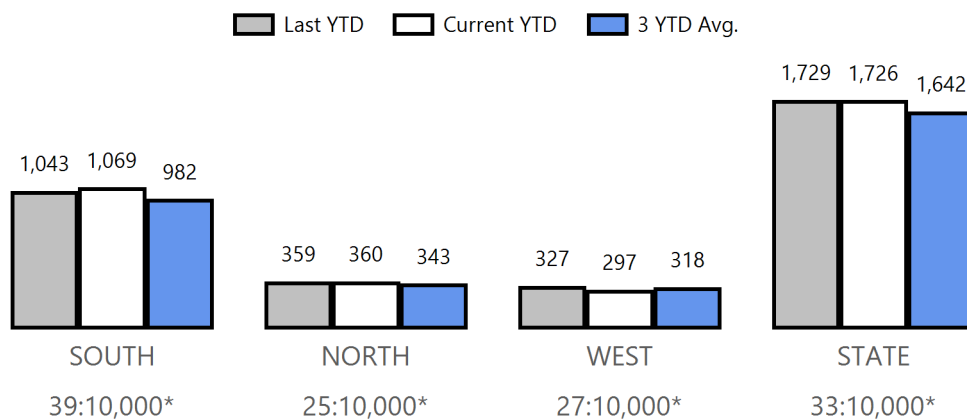

## Public Order : Offensive Behaviour - November 2020

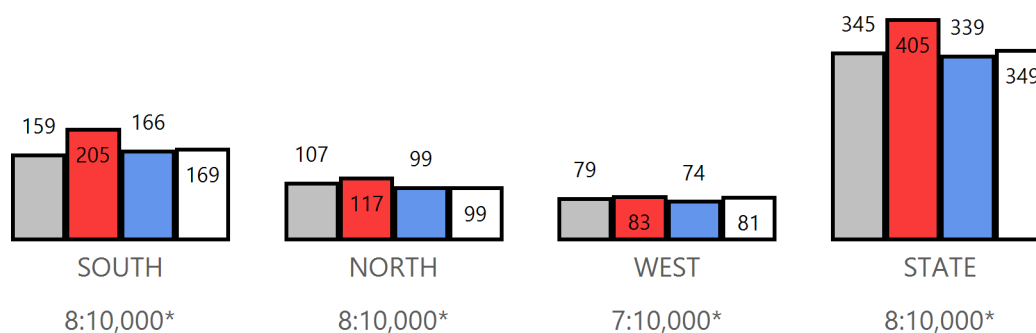

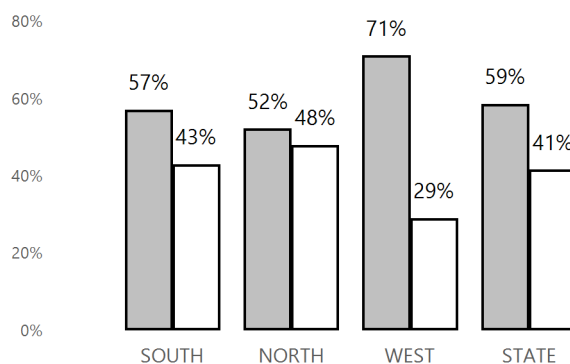

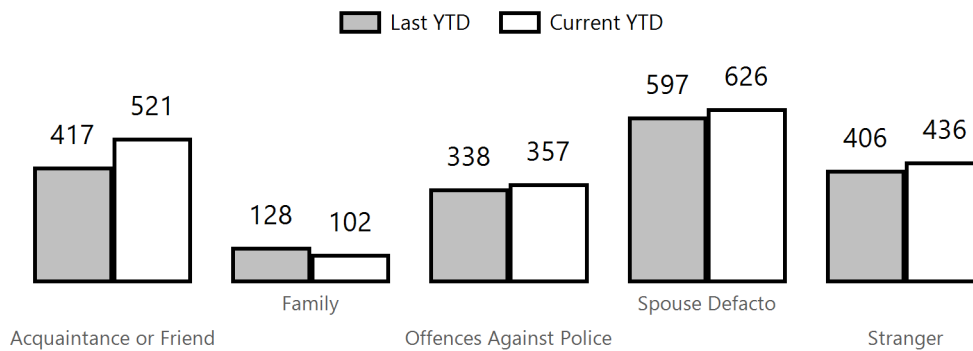

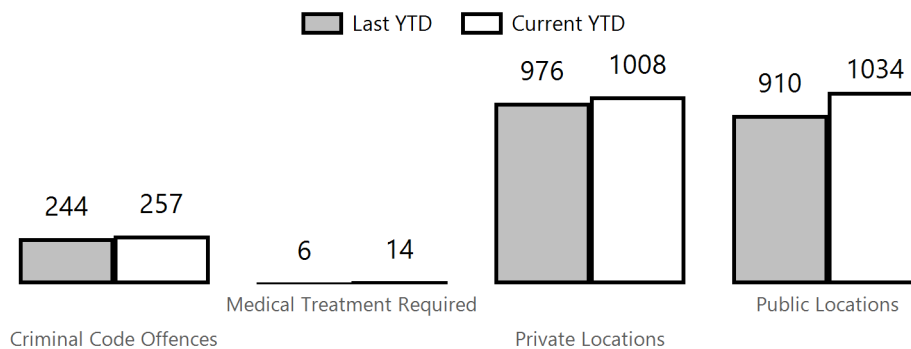

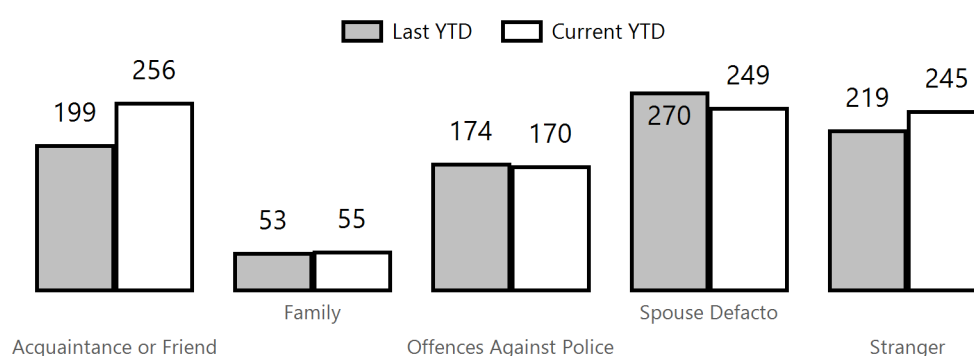

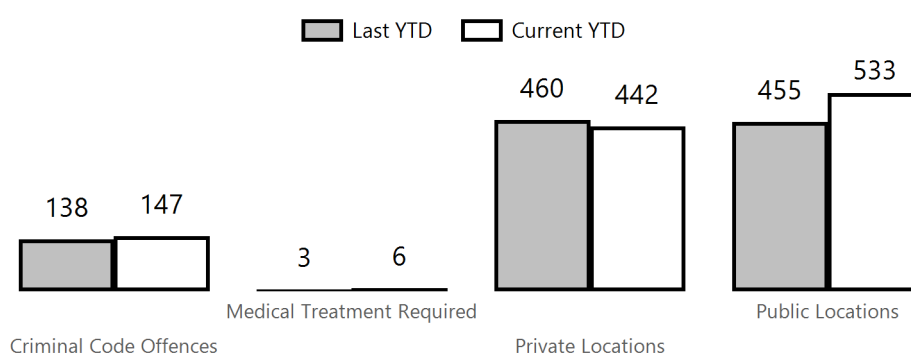

## Total Person Offences - Victim Categories - SOUTH



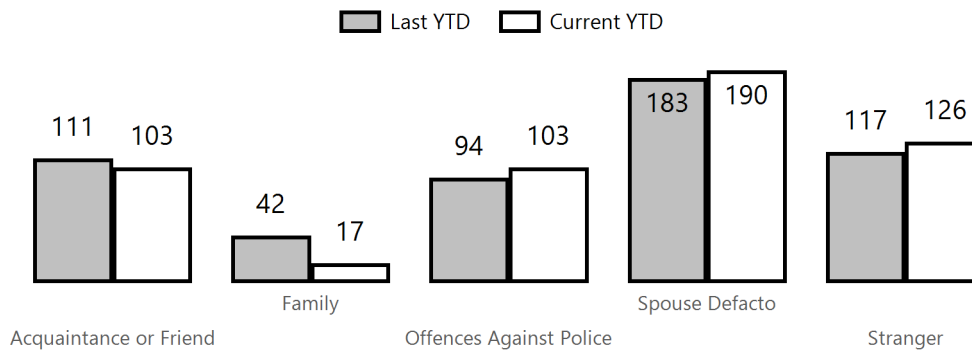

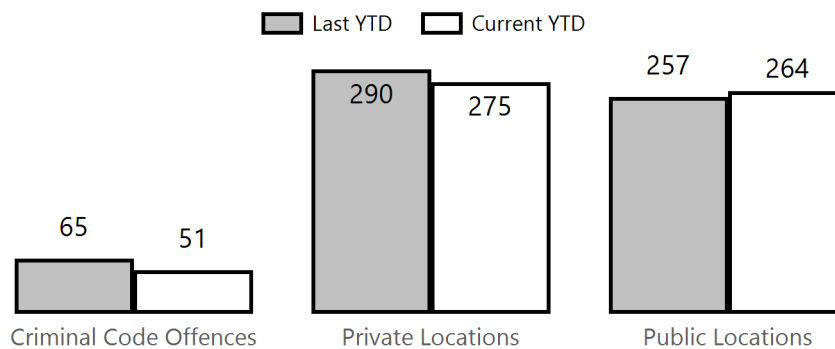

## Total Person Offences - Victim Categories - NORTH



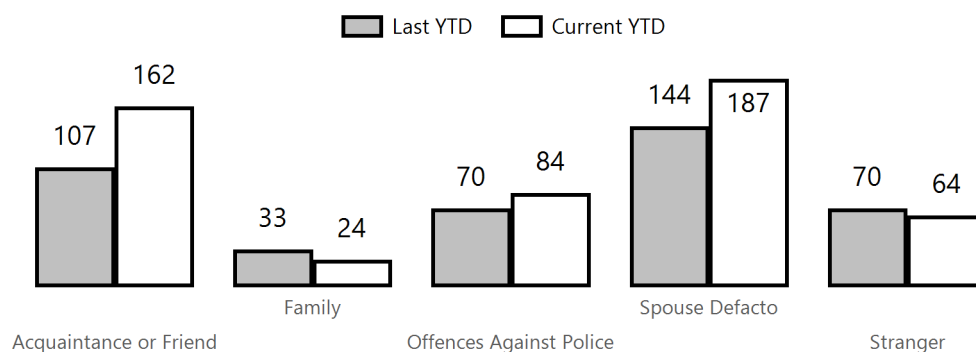

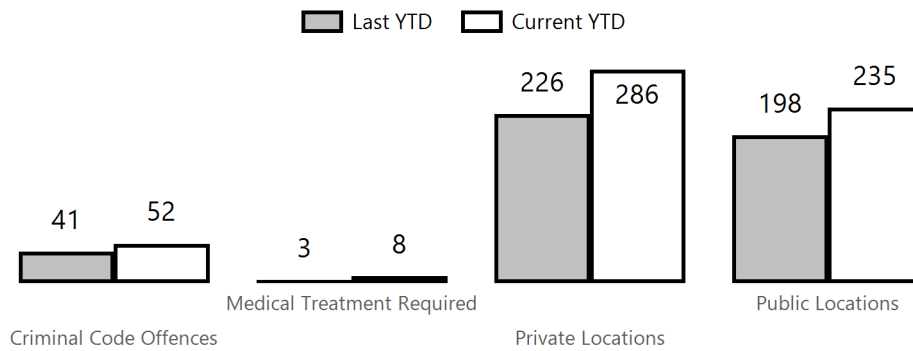

## Total Person Offences - Victim Categories - WEST



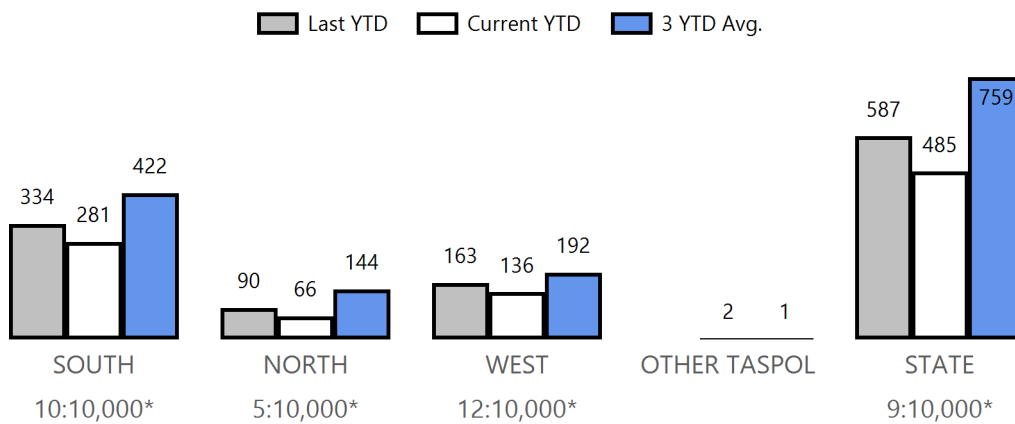

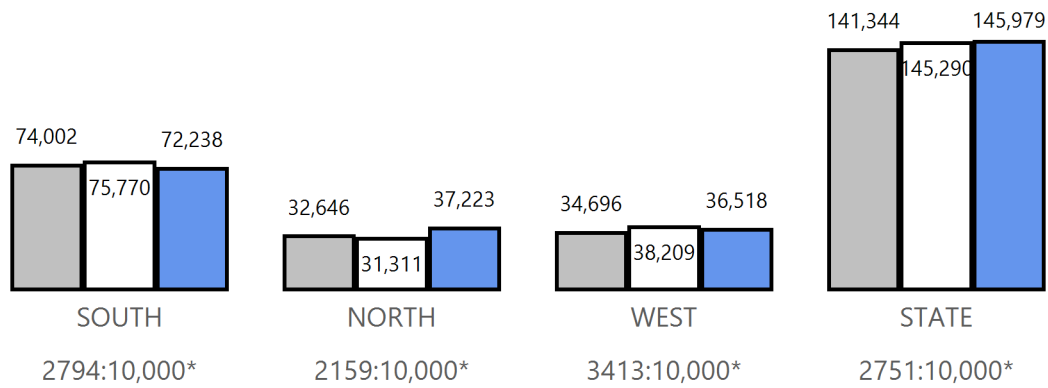

The use of mean for response times reporting is no longer viable due to the changes in business processes following the implementation of the new dispatch system in 2017. The changeover to median reporting brings police into line with the other Tasmanian Emergency Services agencies and is consistent with the findings of an external audit into response times reporting.



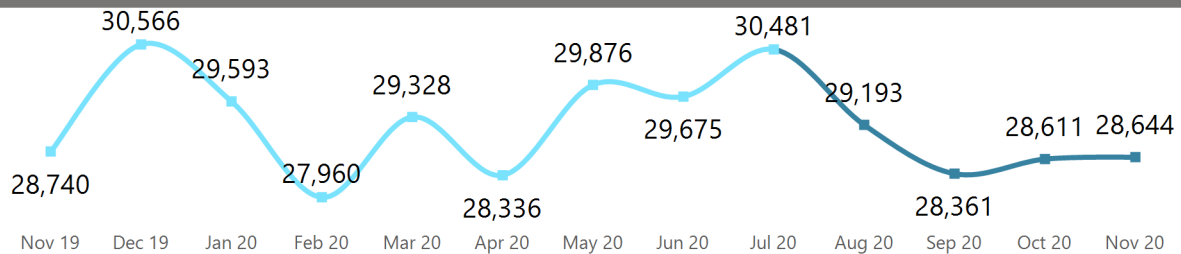
## Total Uniform Police Patrol Hours - November 2020

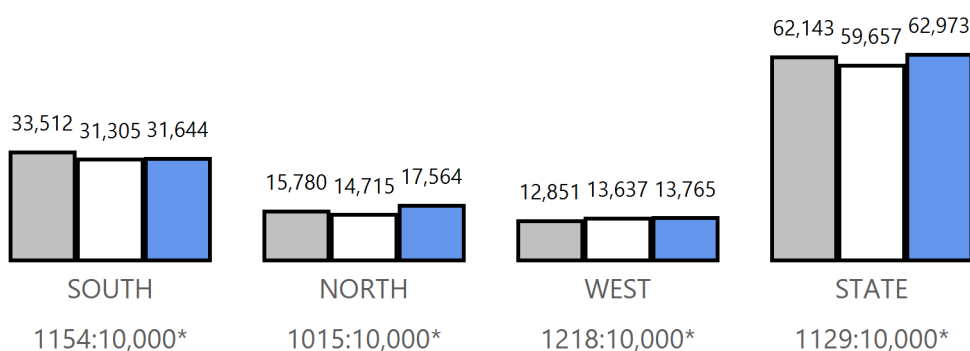
## Uniform Police - Patrol Hours

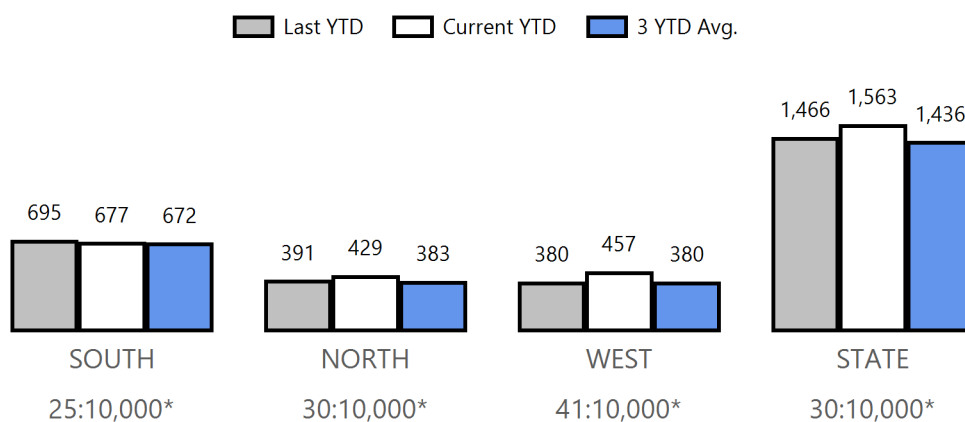

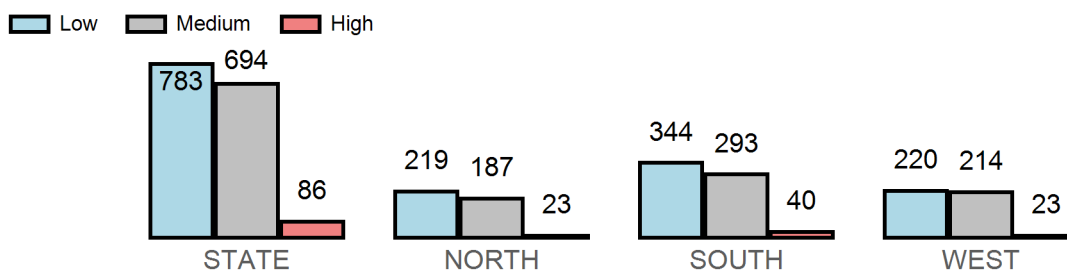
## Family Violence Incidents - November 2020

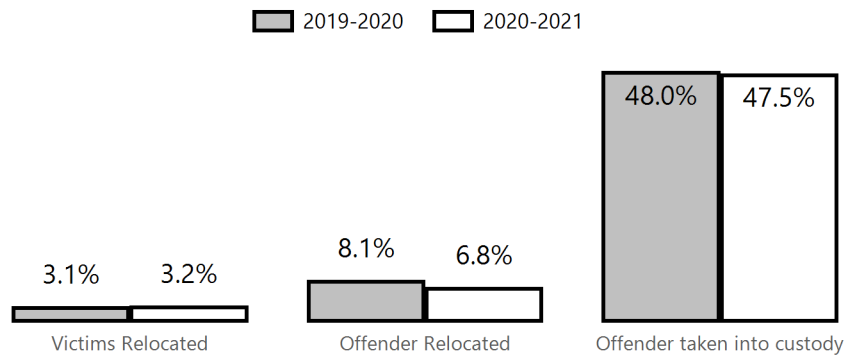

## Family Violence RAST - Excludes Other and Argument Categories



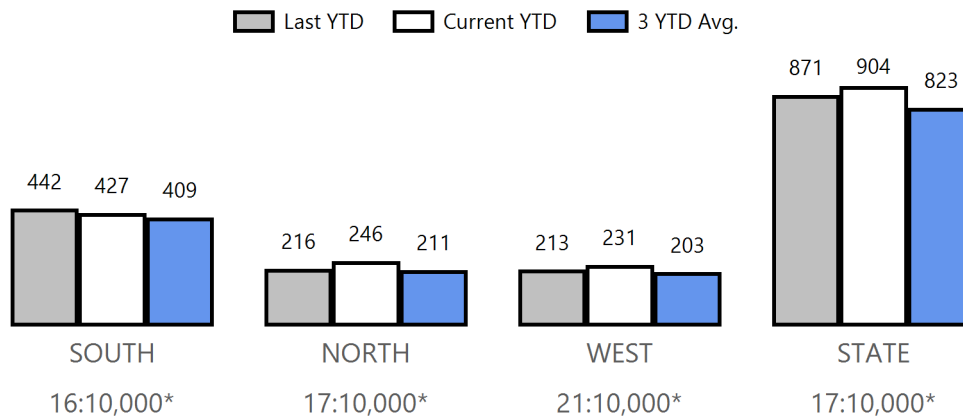

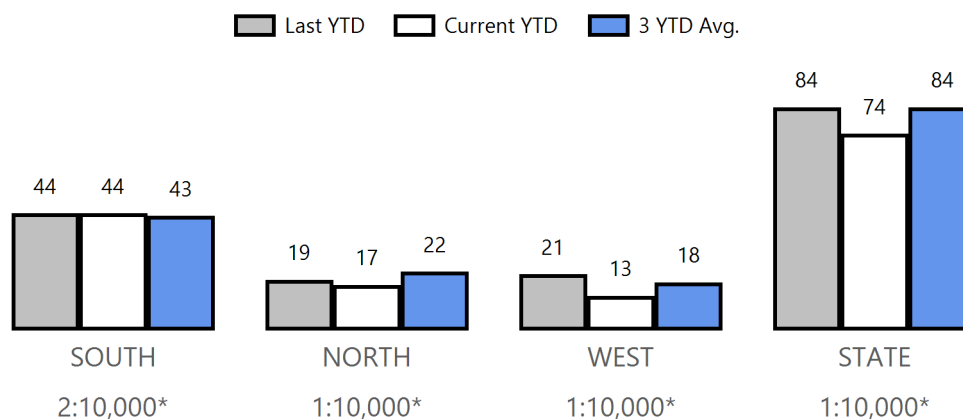
## Family Violence : Juveniles Affected - November 2020

## Family Violence : Weapons Present - November 2020



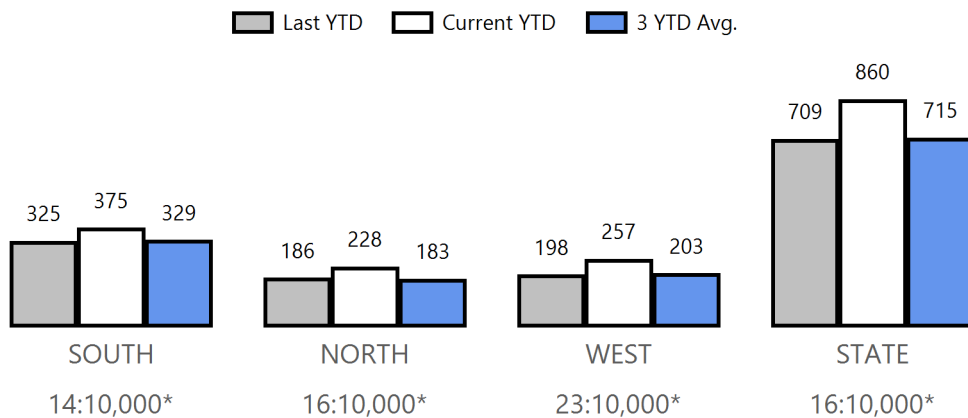

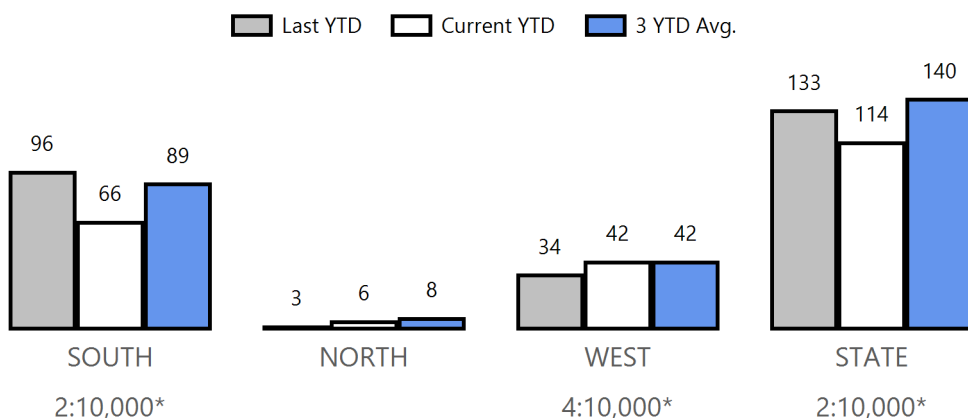
### Family Violence Orders : Police Issued - November 2020

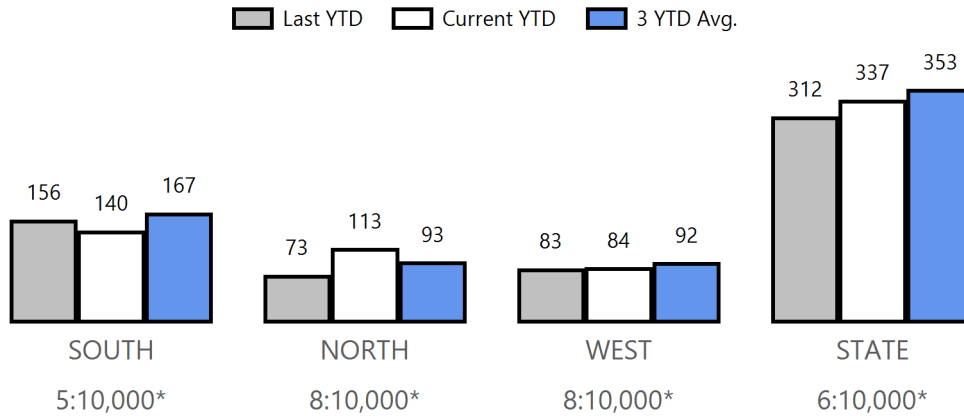
### Family Violence Orders : Court Application - November 2020

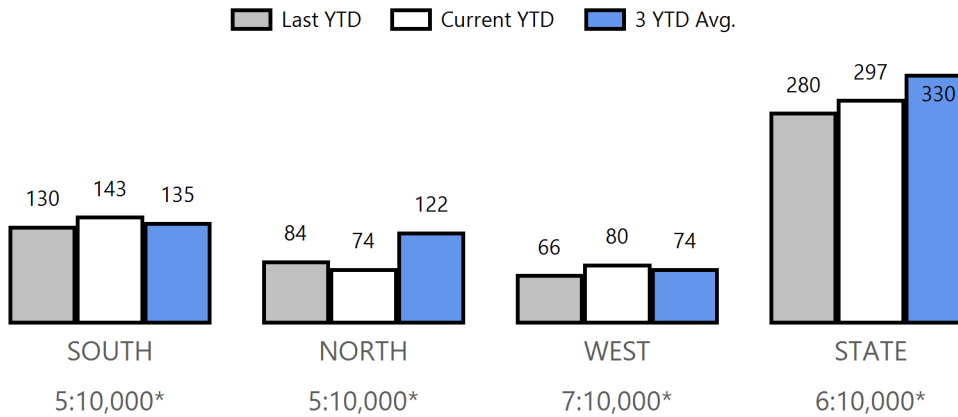
## Family Violence - PFVO Breaches - November 2020

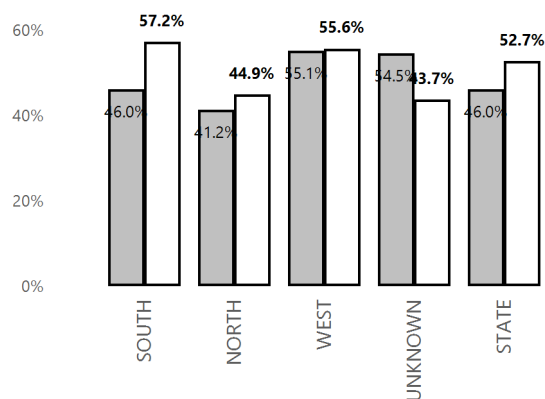

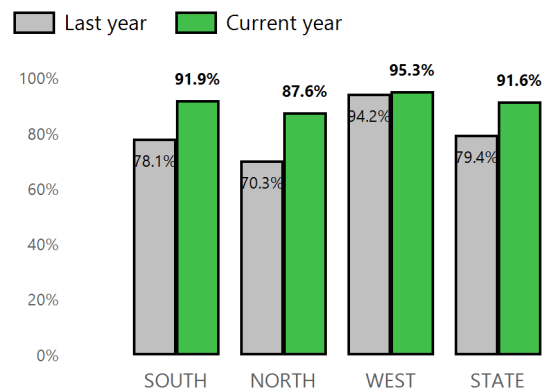

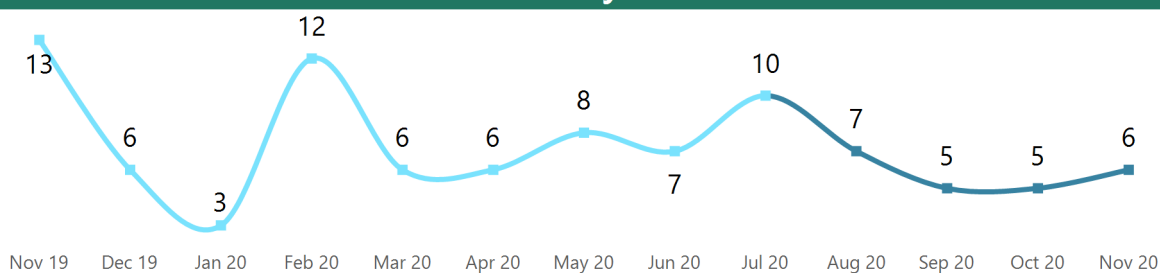


## Robbery Offences - November 2020

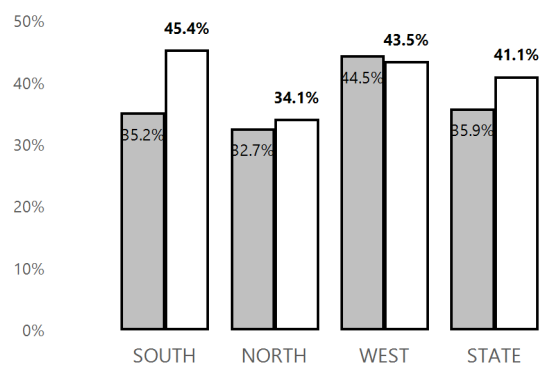

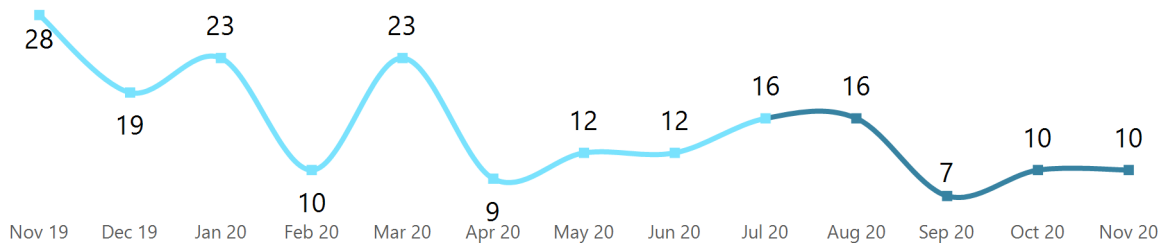
## SMV : Fire Damaged - November 2020

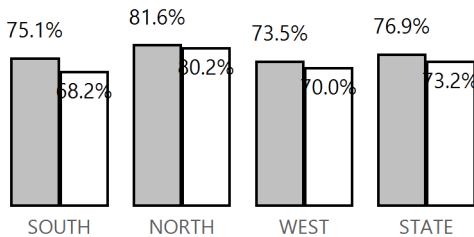

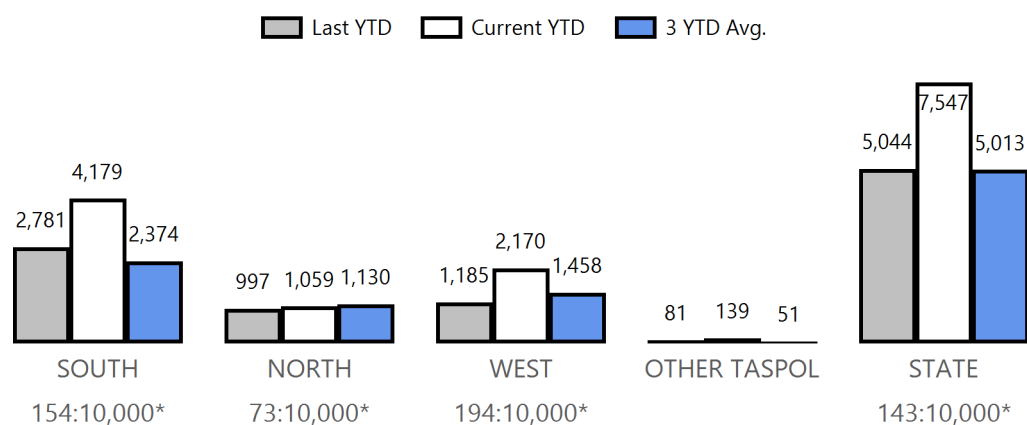

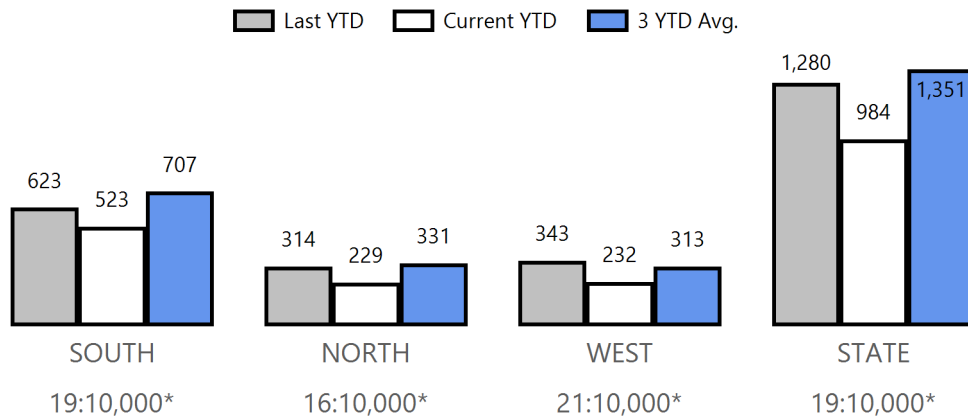
## Total Street Checks - November 2020

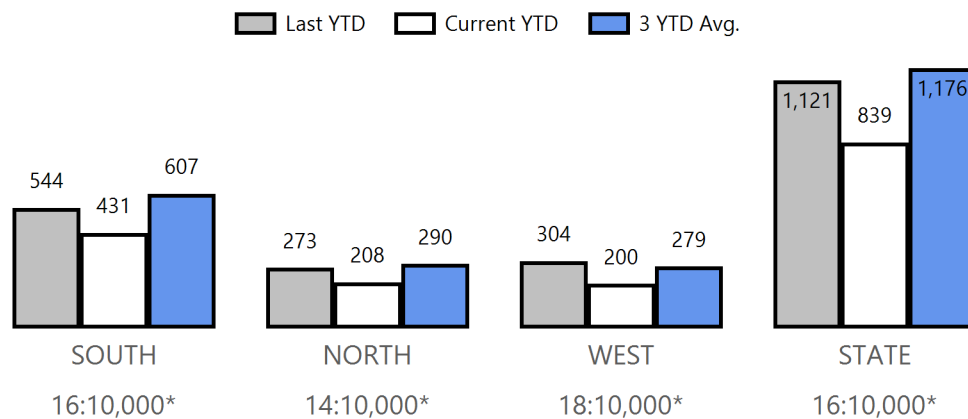
## CIB: Total Offenders - November 2020

## CIB: Total Crime Offenders - November 2020



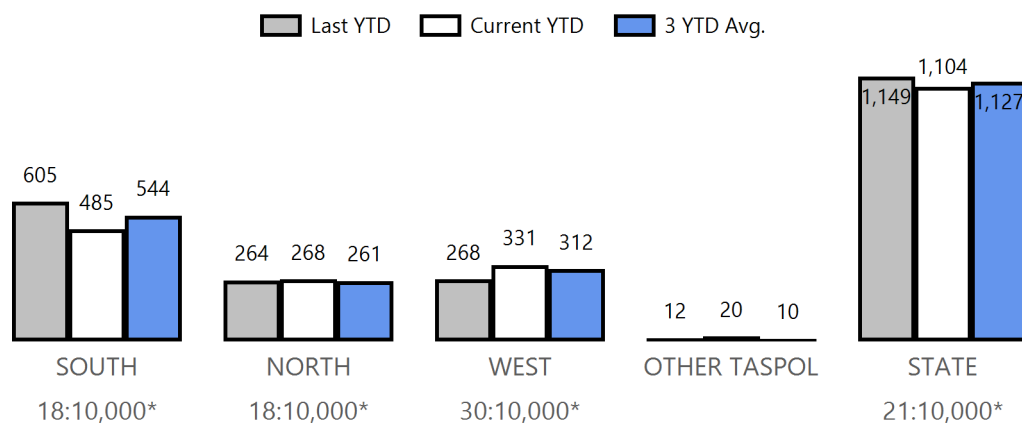

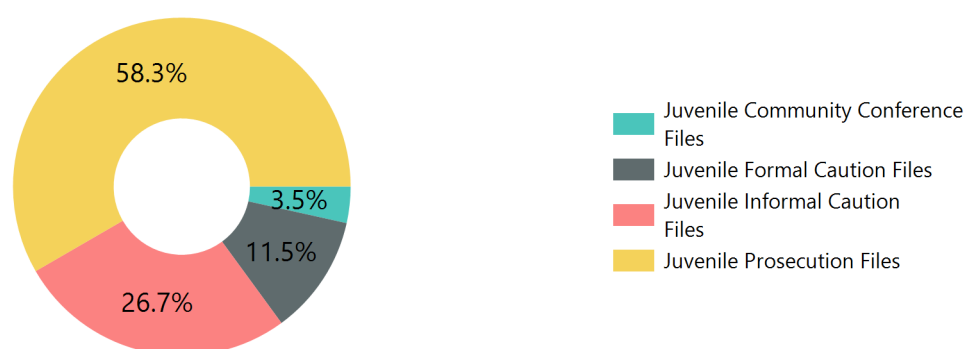

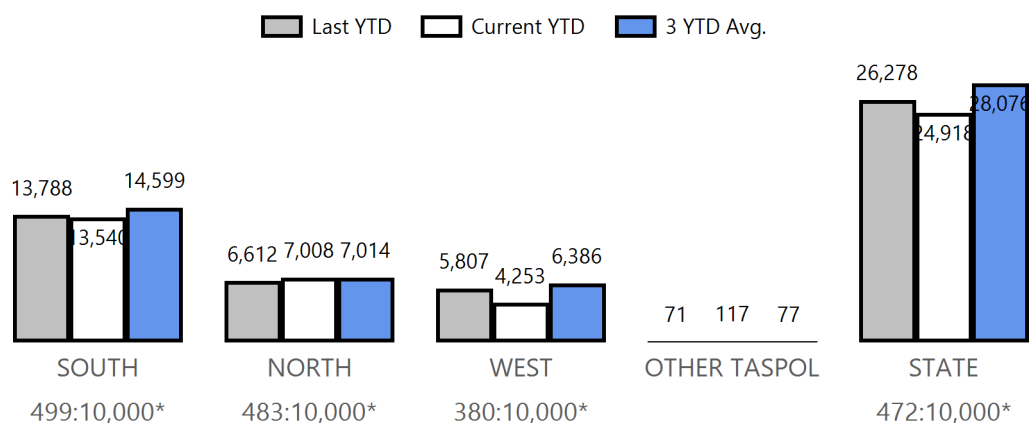

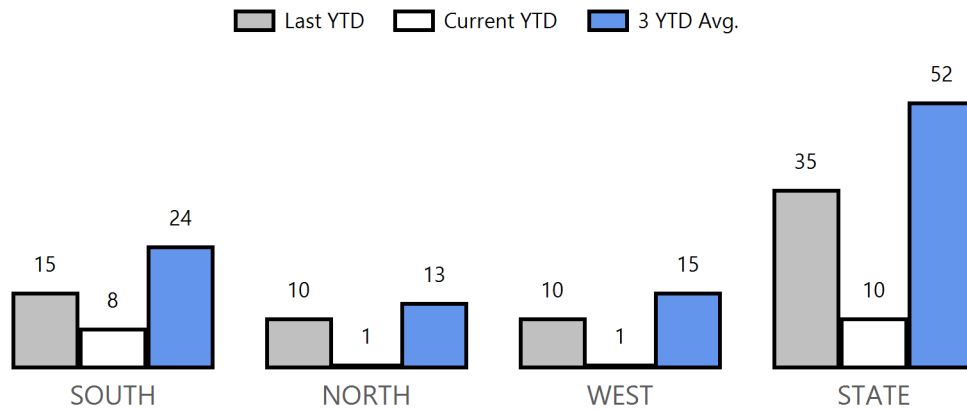

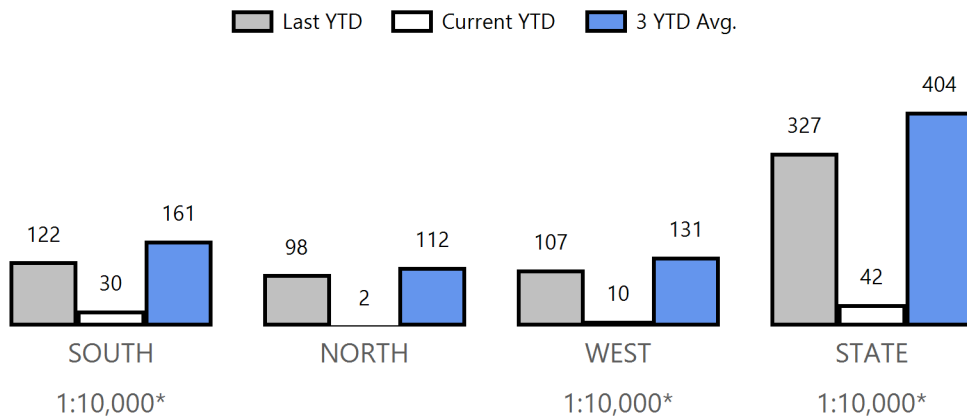
## Major Traffic Operations - November 2020

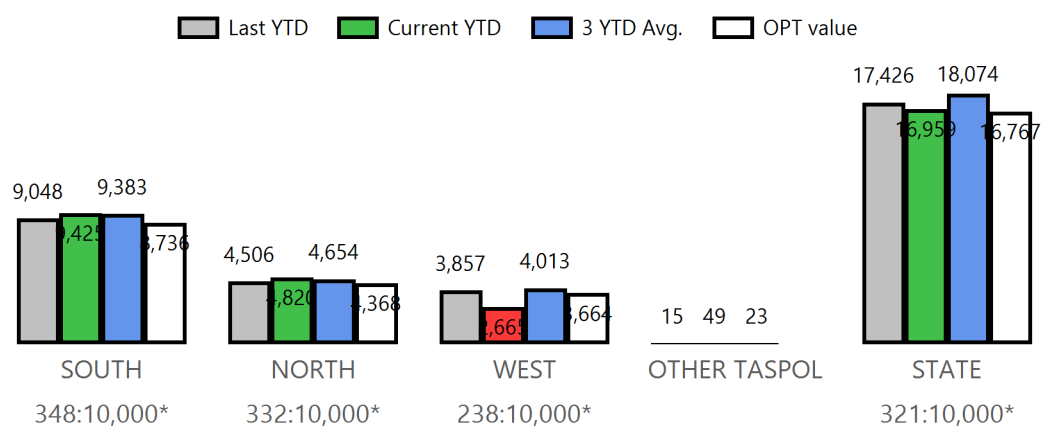

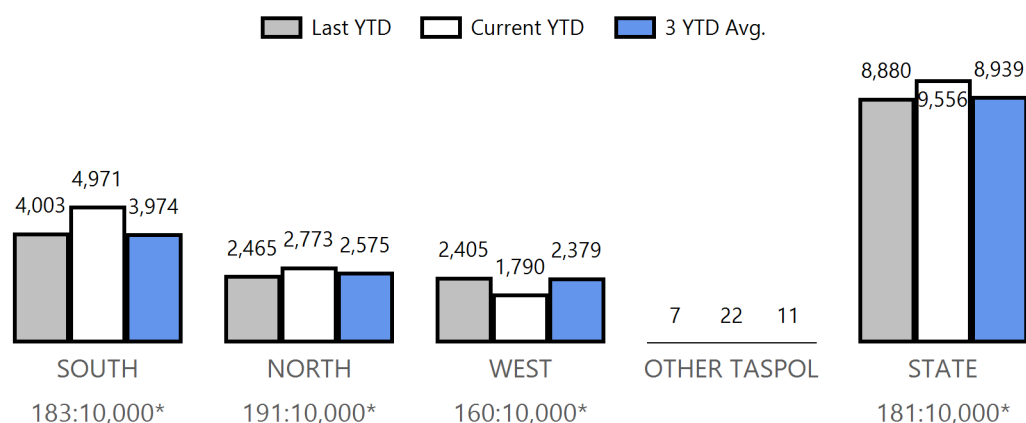
## Speeding Offenders - November 2020

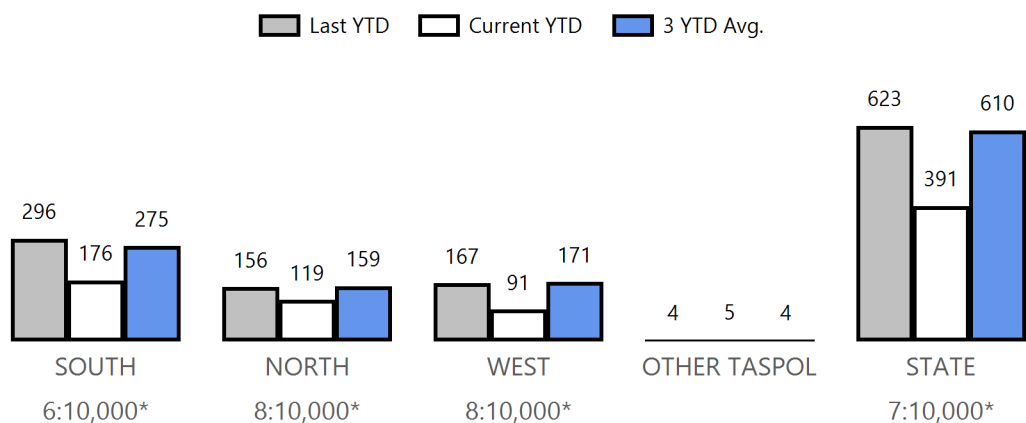
## Excessive Speed Offenders - 15-29km/h - November 2020

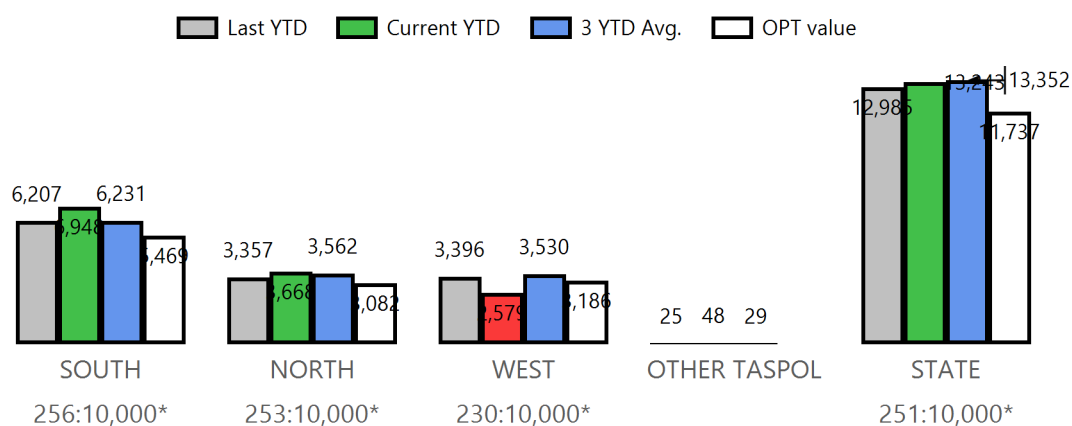
## Excessive Speed Offenders - 30km/h + - November 2020

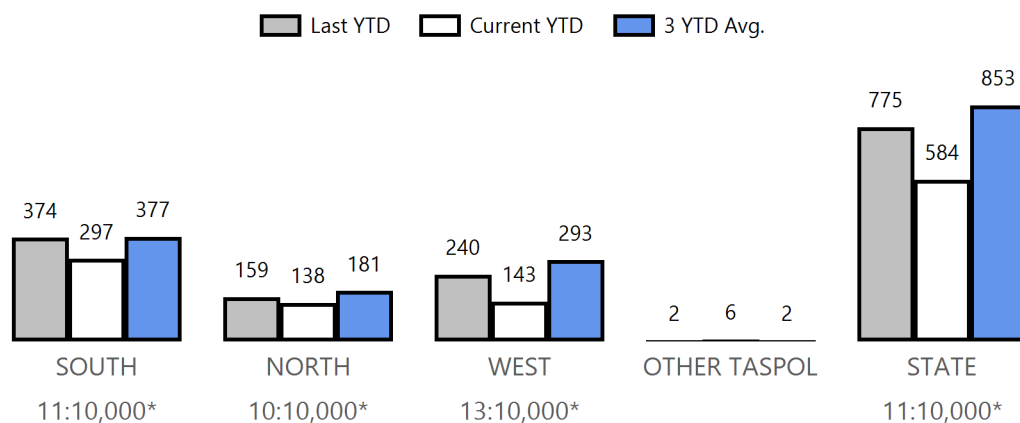
## High Risk Offenders - November 2020

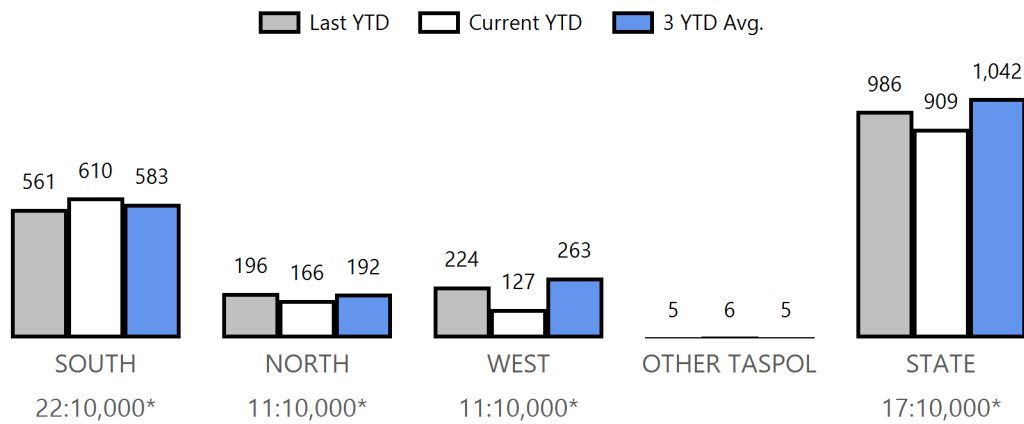
## Seatbelt Compliance Offenders - November 2020

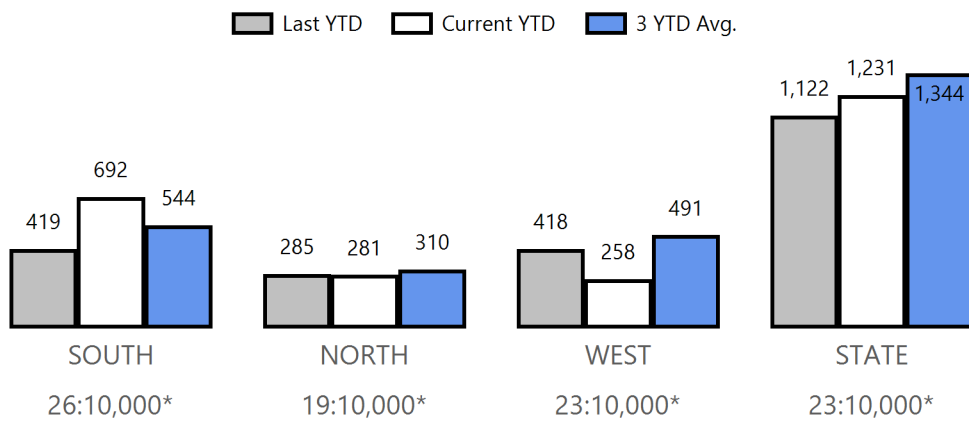
## Mobile Phone Offenders - November 2020

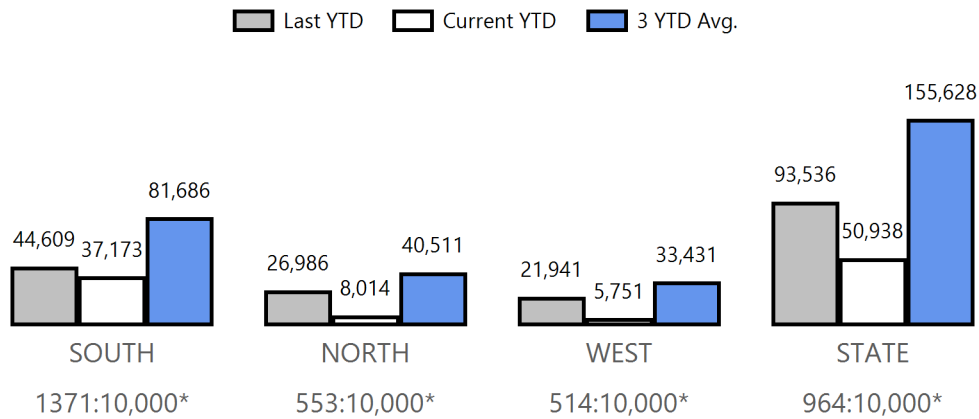
## Vehicle Defect Notices - November 2020

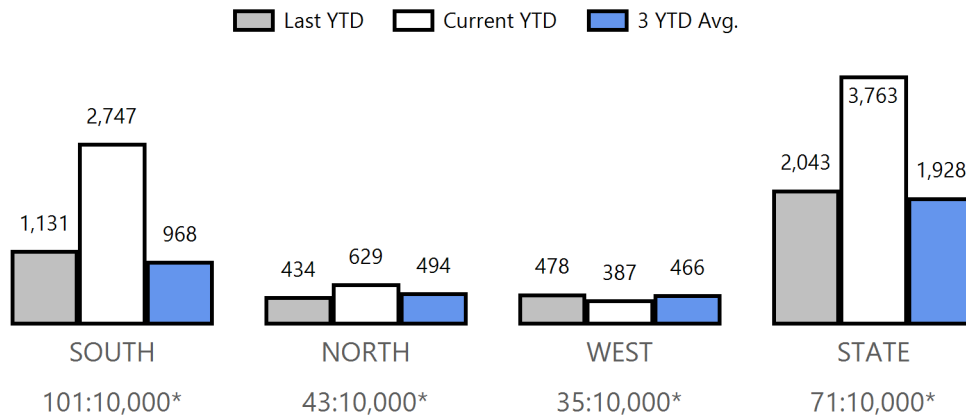
## Random Breath Tests (ALCOHOL) - November 2020

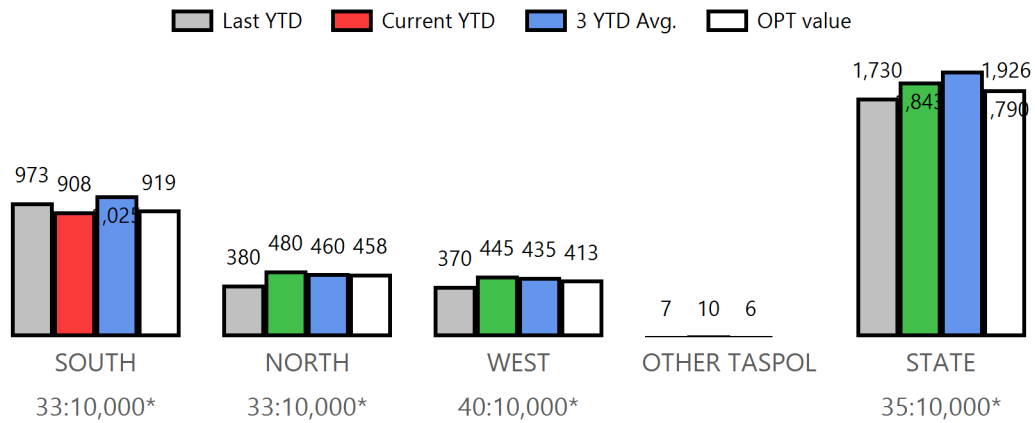

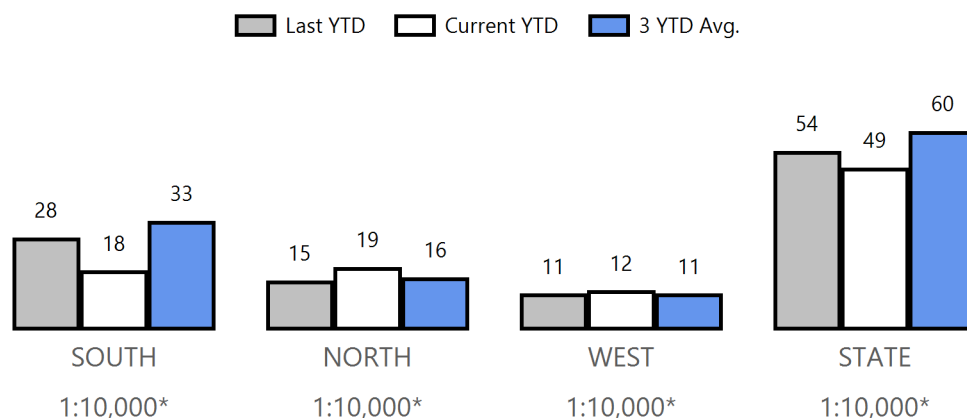

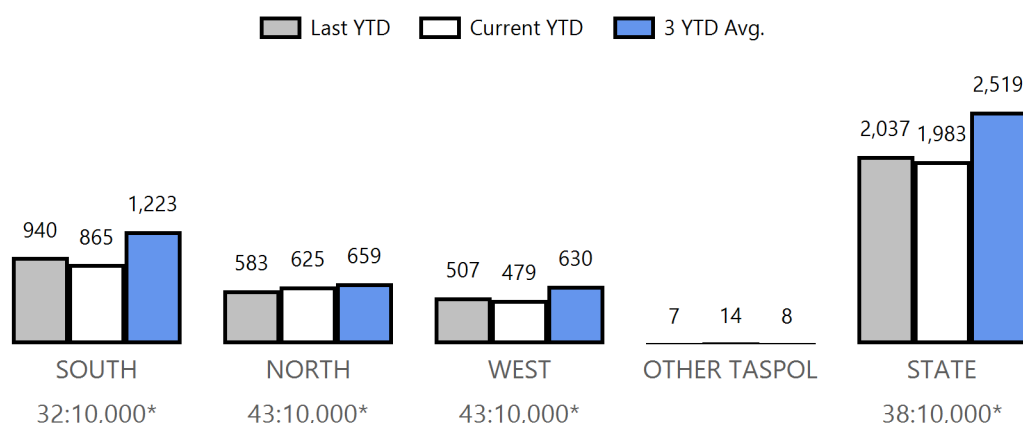

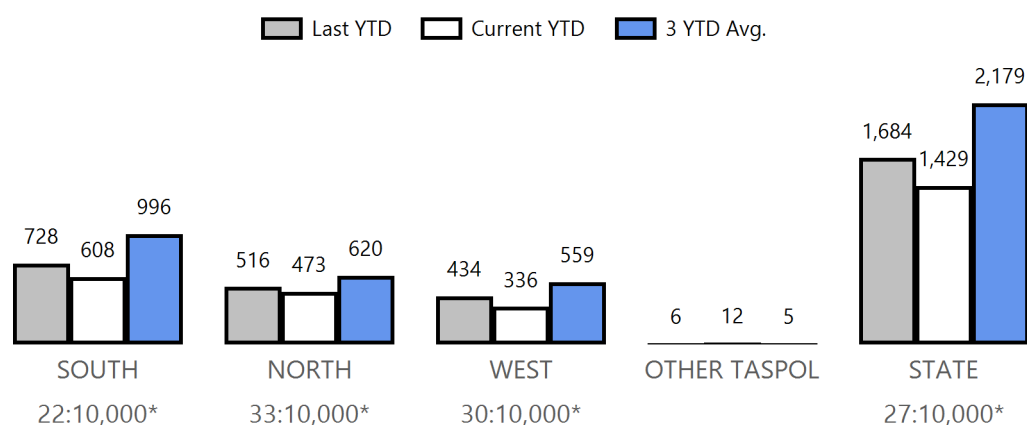

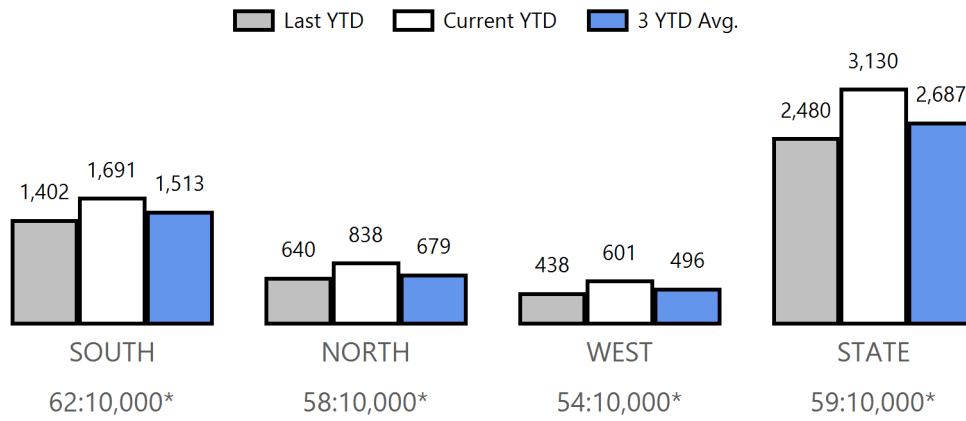

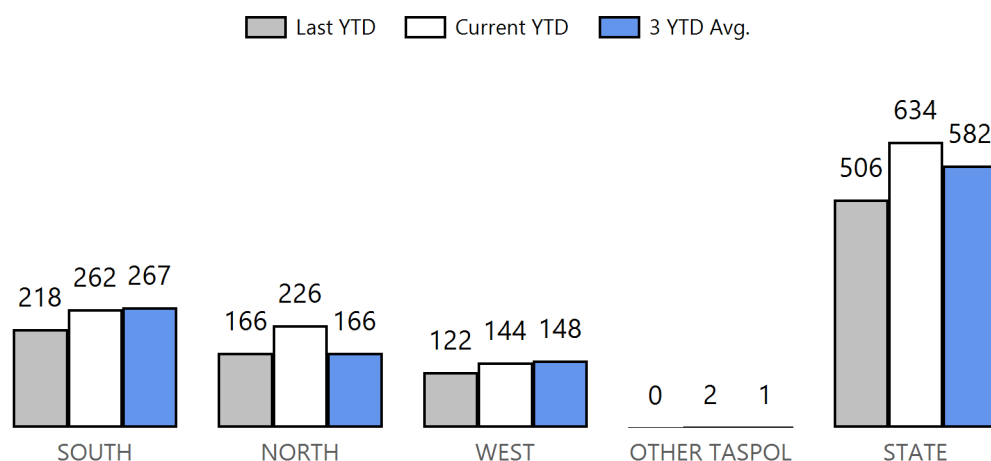
## Vehicle Complaints made to RDS - November 2020

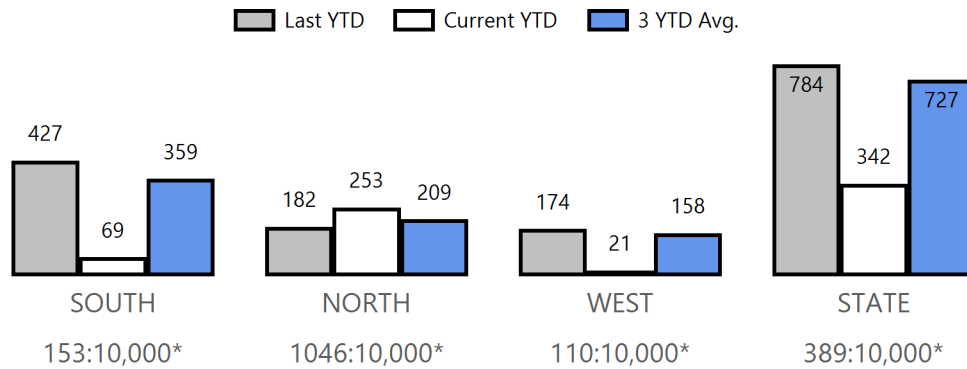

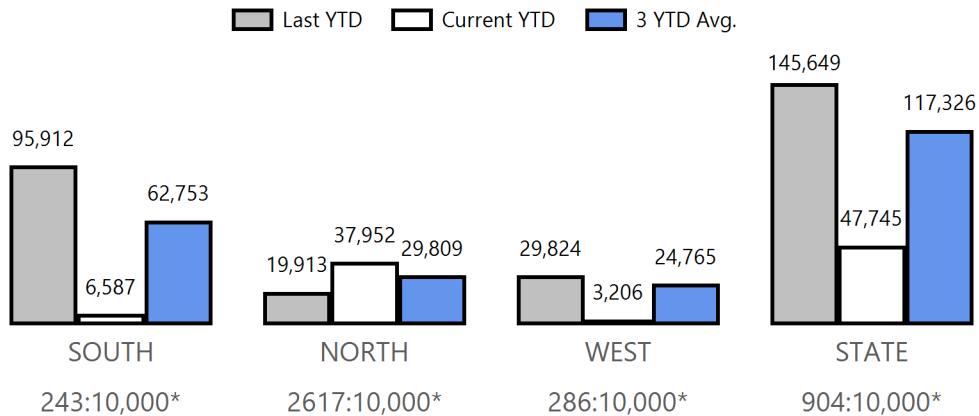

## ANPR: Total Vehicles Captured - November 2020



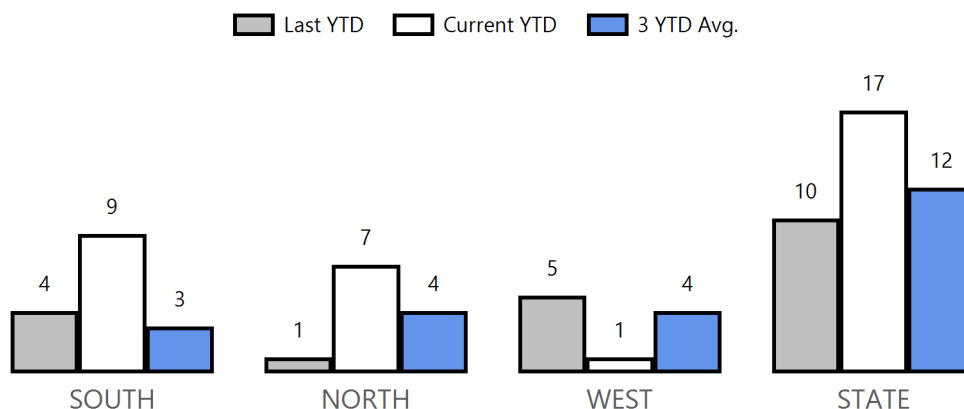

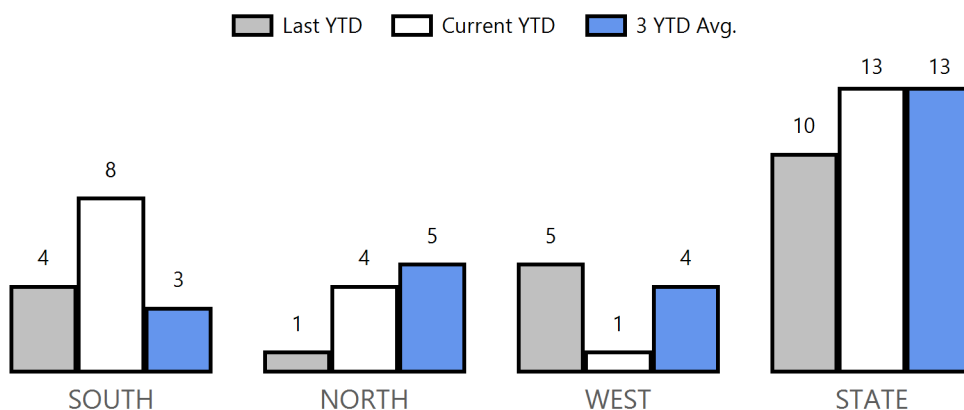
## Road Crashes: Fatalities YTD - November 2020

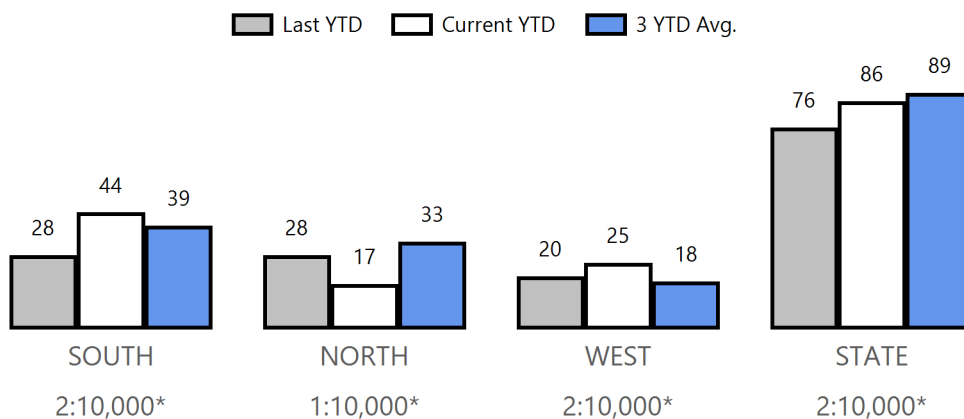
## Fatal Crashes - November 2020

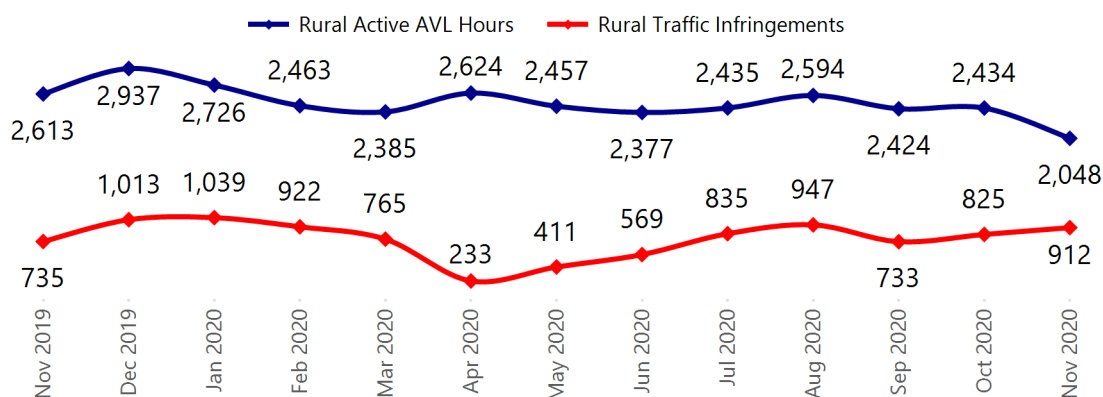

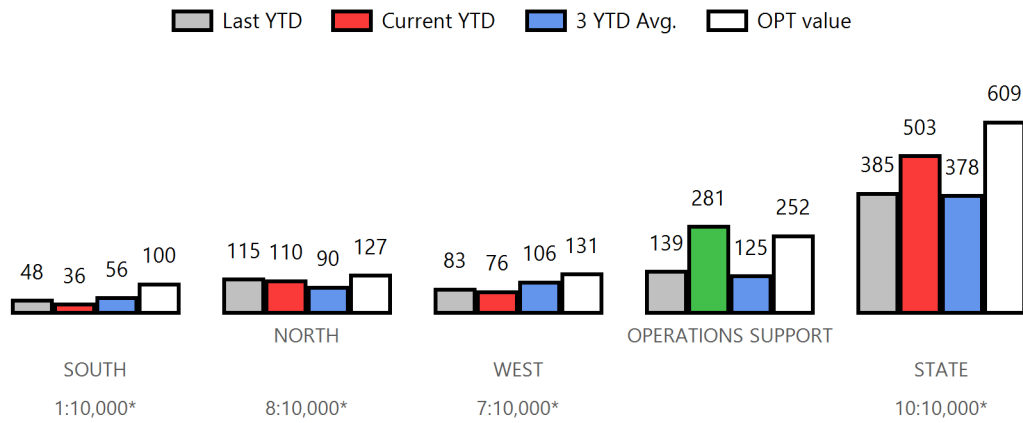

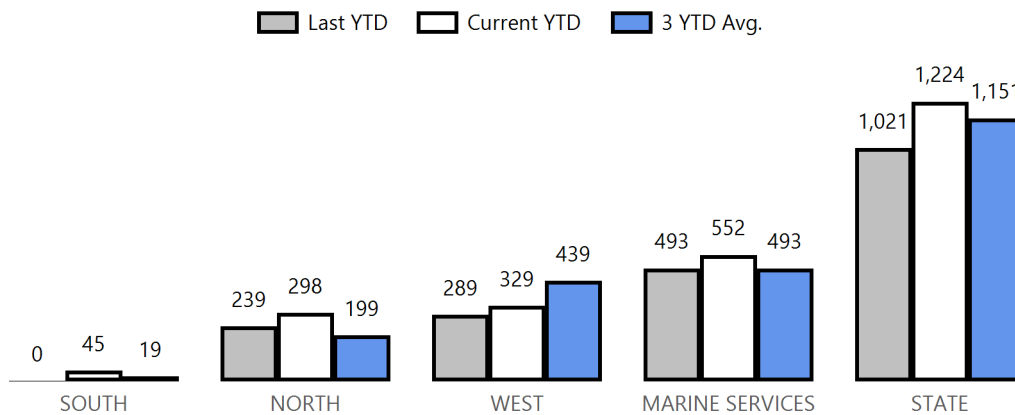

## Sea Inspections (Vessel & Non-Vessel) - November 2020



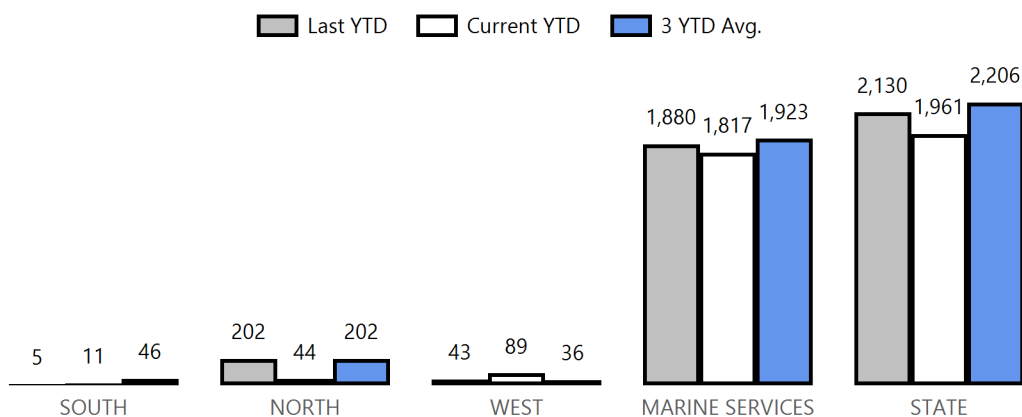
