#### Disclaimer

The Corporate Performance Report is produced for internal purposes to measure the performance of our people, resources and systems, and to assist with the management of our business. The Report is made available to external stakeholders as the figures contained may be of public interest. Data are not extracted for the Report until one month after the reporting period has concluded. This one month period ensures there are sufficient opportunities for data to be entered into police systems and for quality assurance to be undertaken. However, the primary purpose of the Report is to measure internal performance, not provide official Departmental figures. There may be discrepancies between measures provided in this Report and official Departmental figures due to several possible factors.

Electronic data was extracted on 9 December 2019. Manual data is collated monthly by Reporting Services from information self-reported by organisational units within DPFEM or provided/downloaded from a variety of sources as indicated throughout the Report.

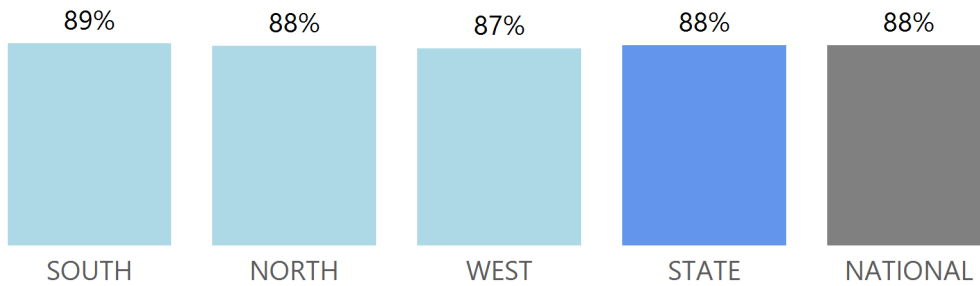

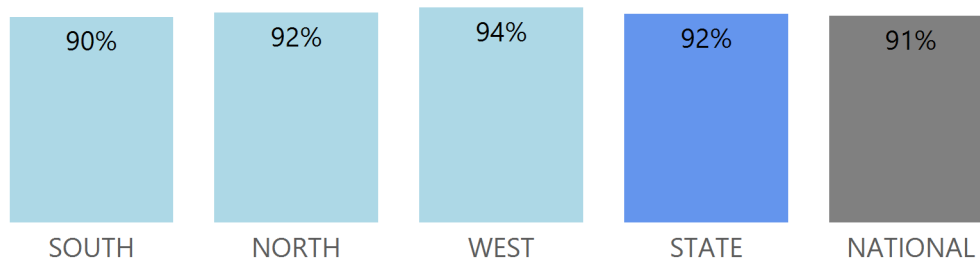

The question: "How safe do you feel at home in the daytime" has been removed from the SRC survey

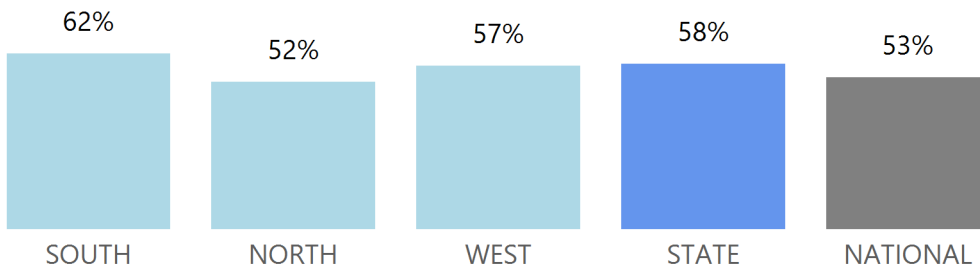
## Public Safety - Out in Public Locally (Daytime)

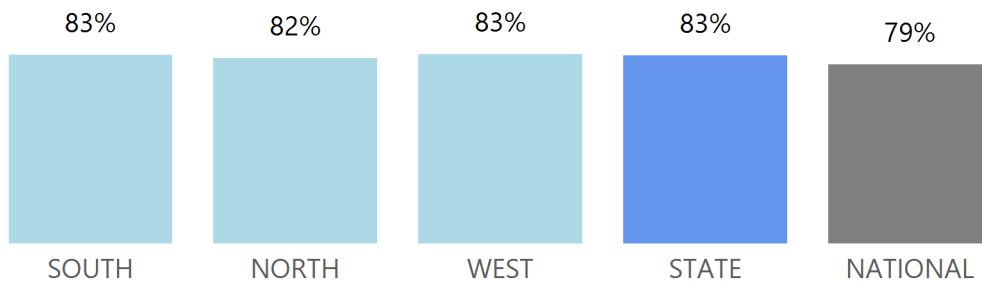

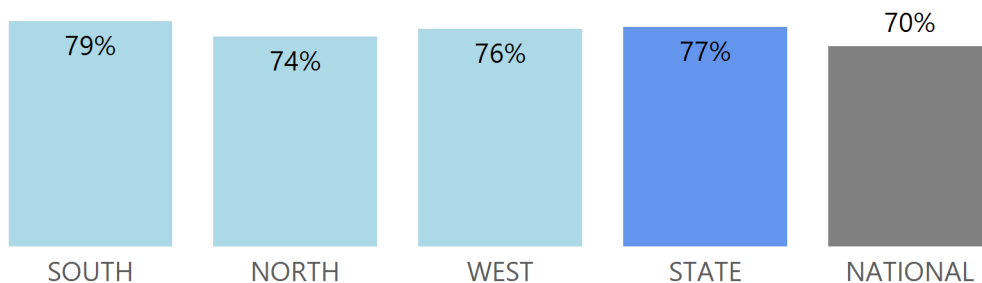
## General Satisfaction with Police Services

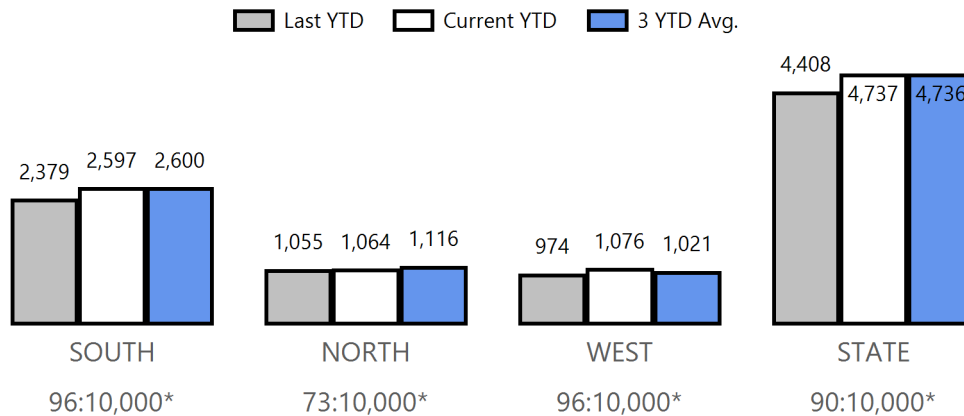
## Satisfaction - Dealing with Public Order Problems

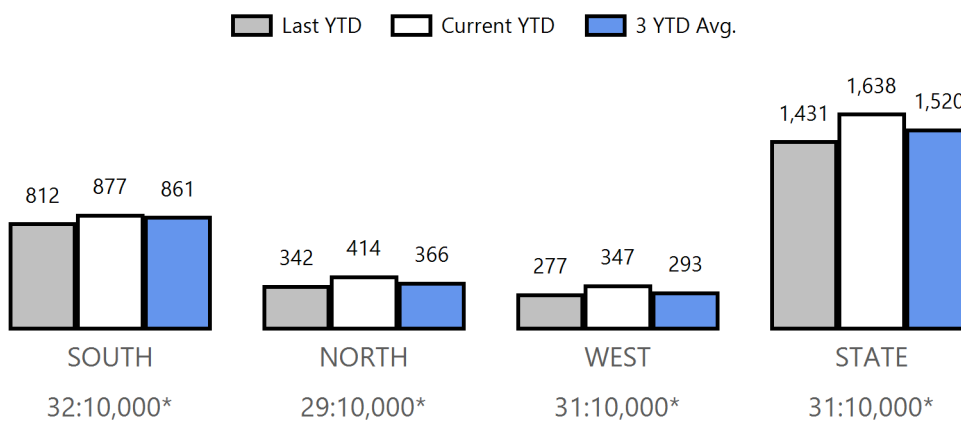
## Public Order Incidents - October 2019

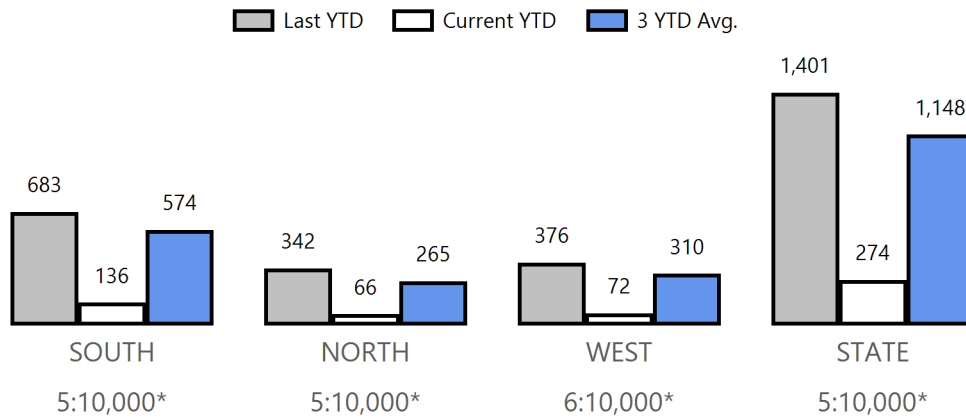
## Public Order : Disturbance - October 2019

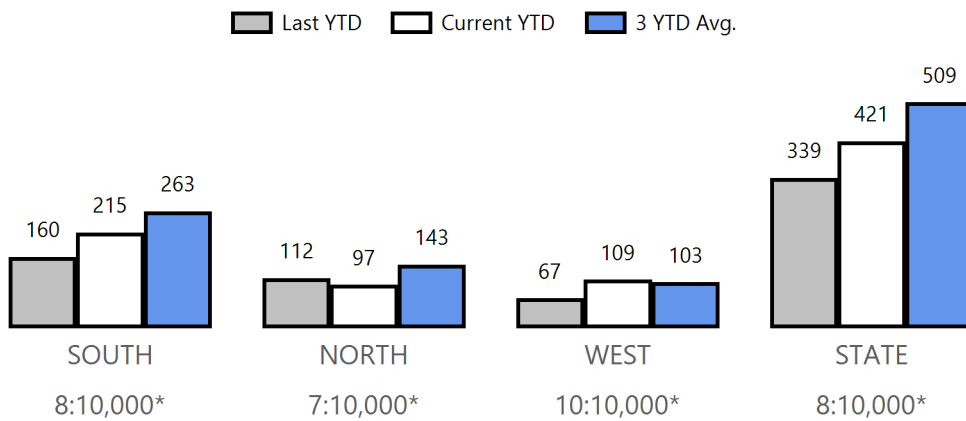
## Public Order : Noise - October 2019

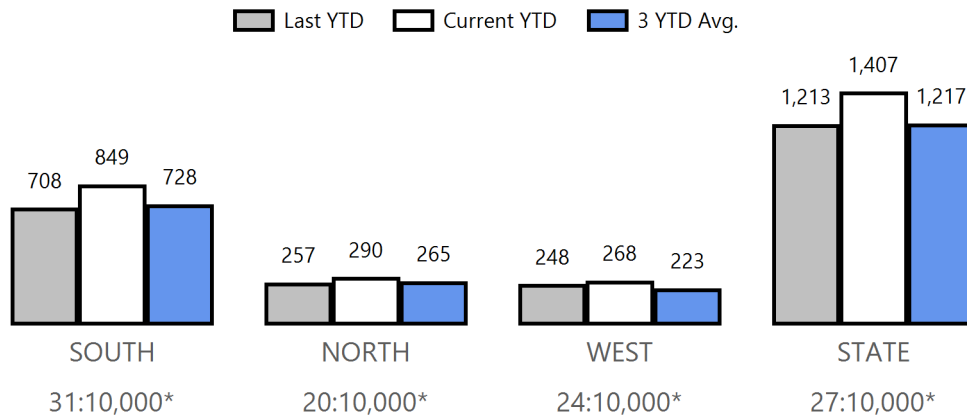

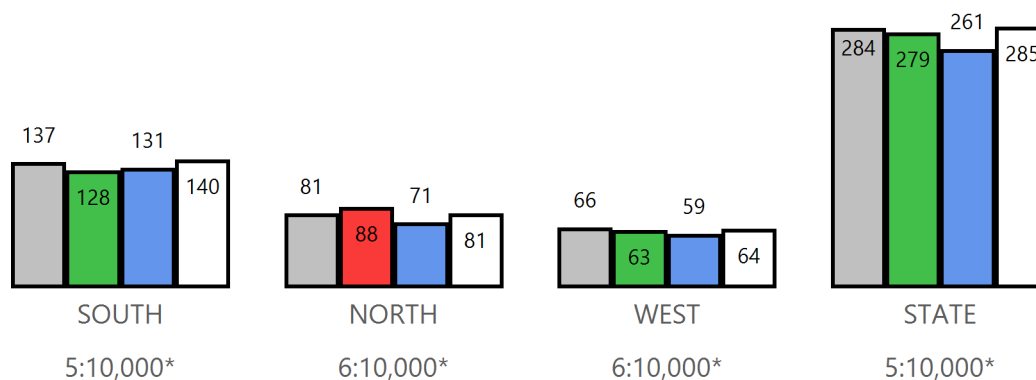
## Public Order : Offensive Behaviour - October 2019



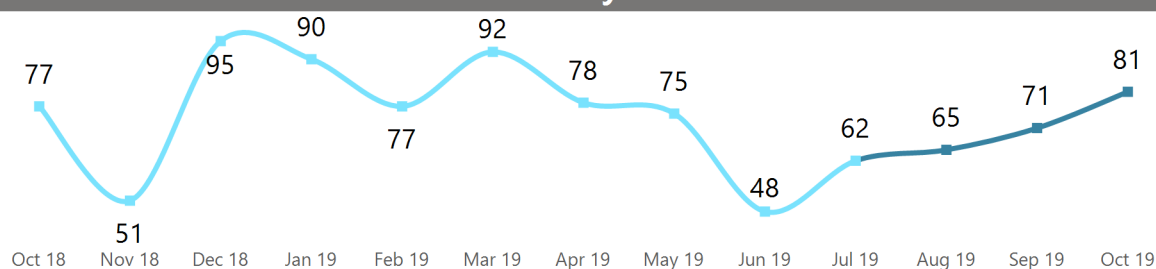

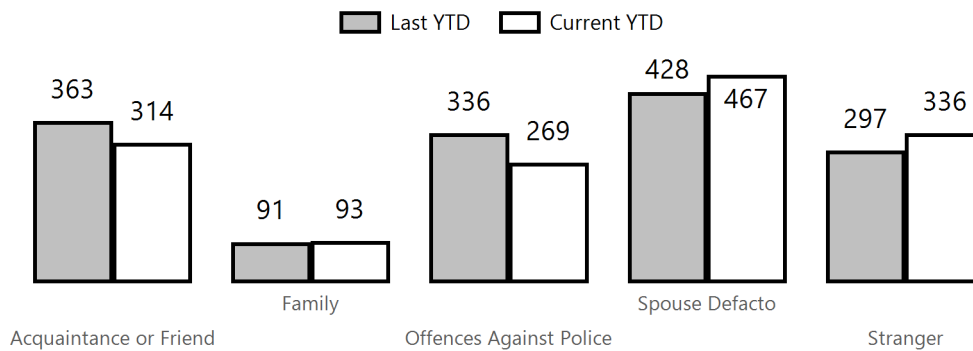

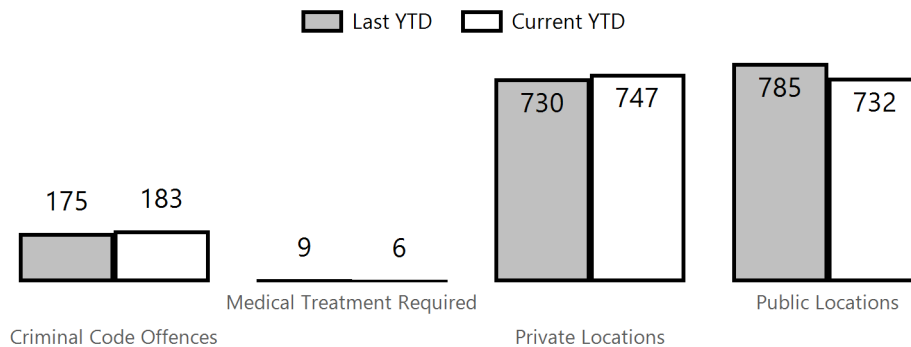

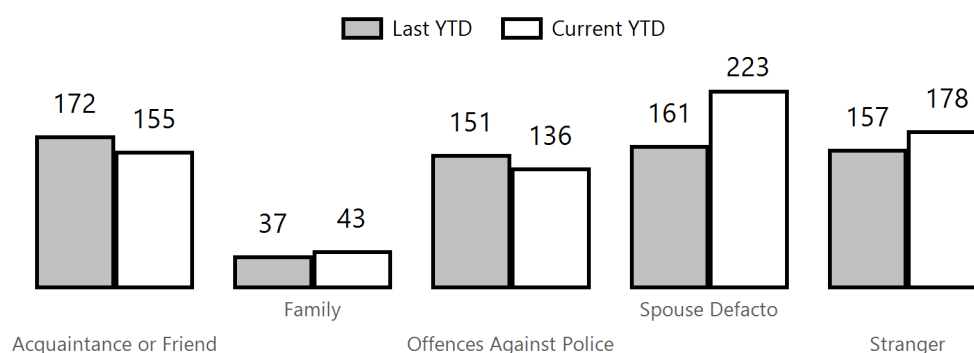

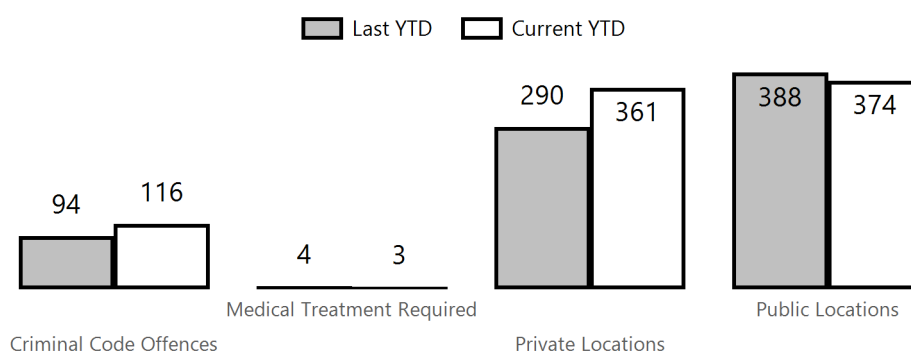

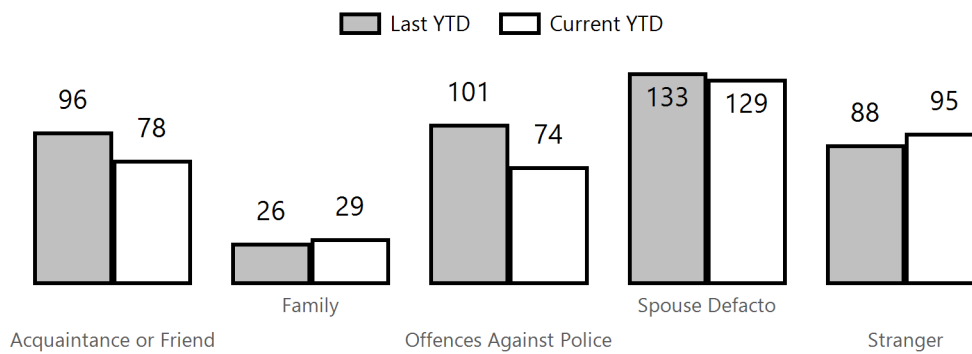

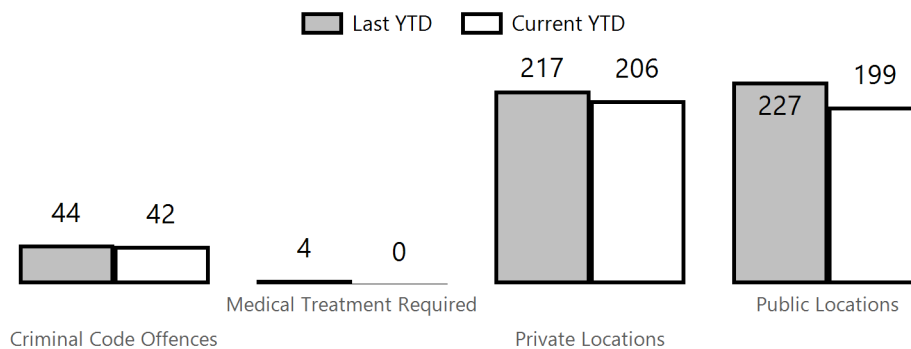

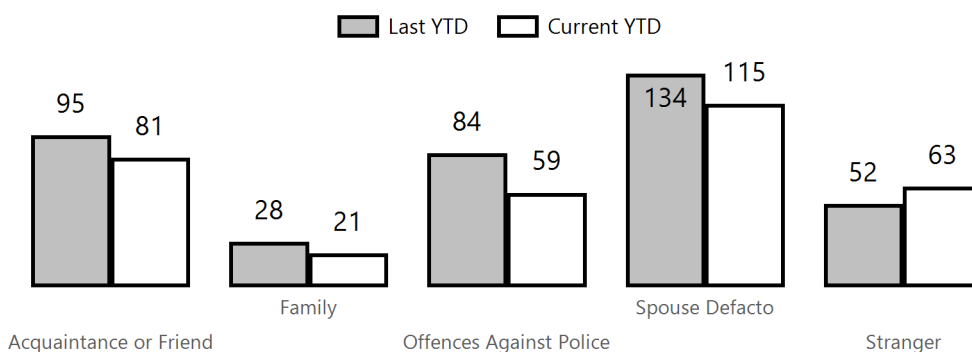

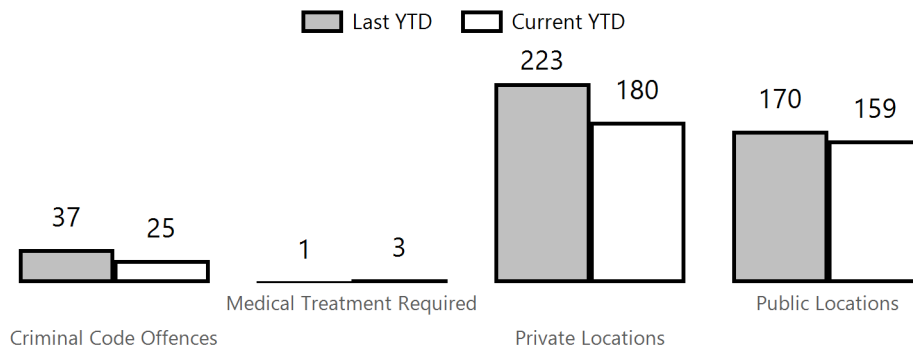

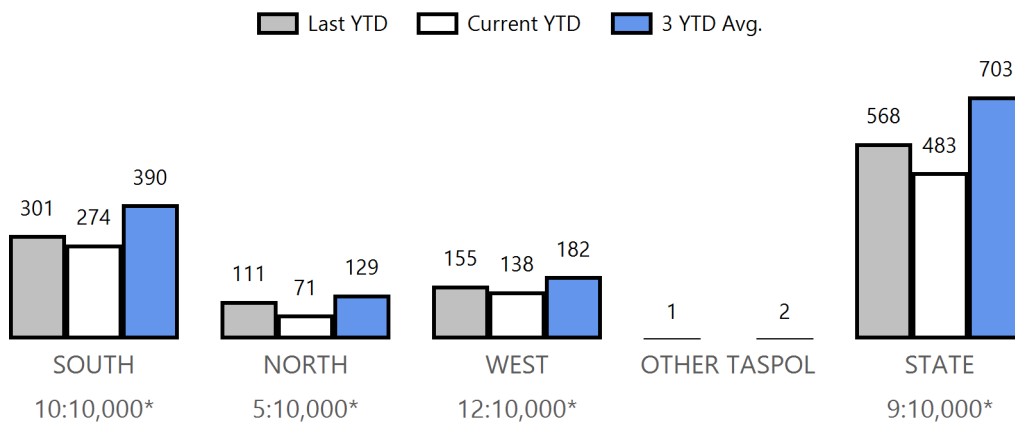

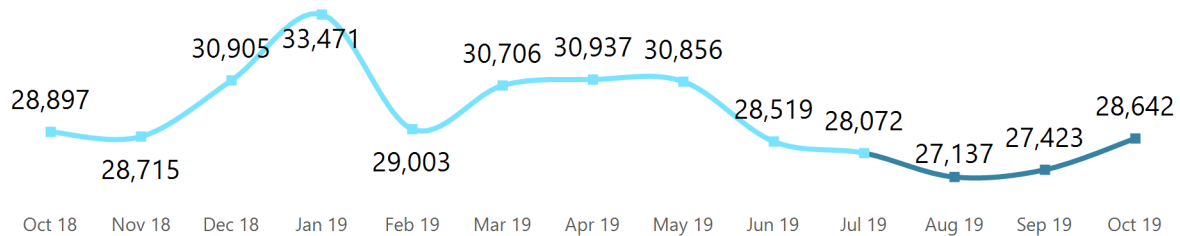
## Total Uniform Police Patrol Hours - October 2019

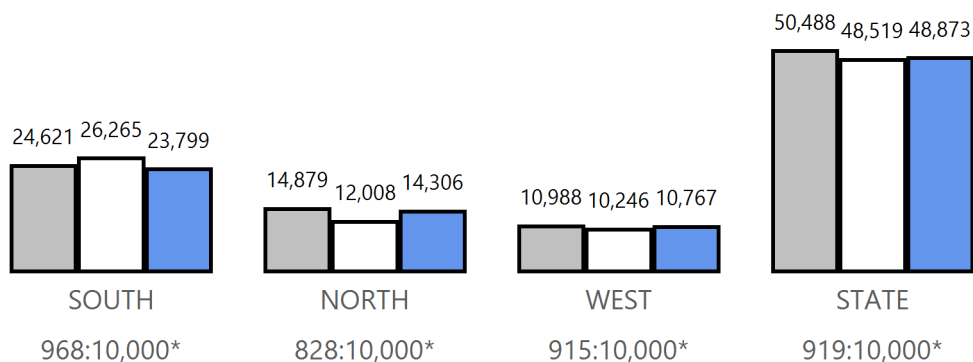
## Uniform Police - Patrol Hours

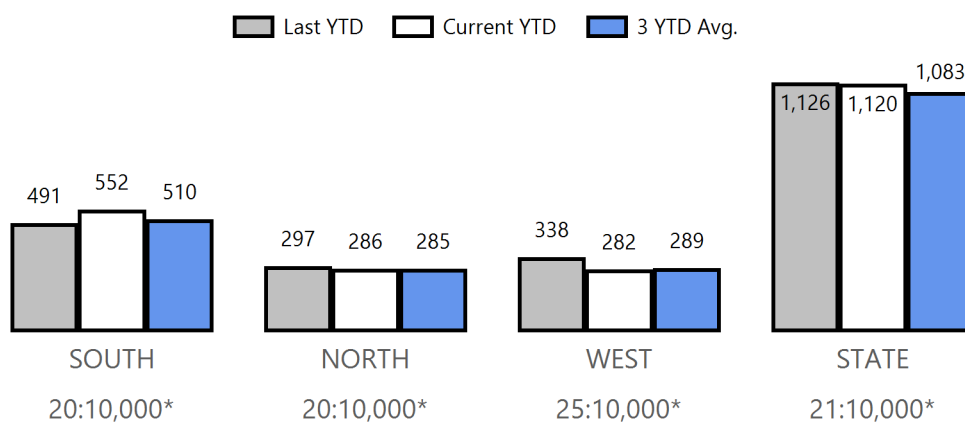

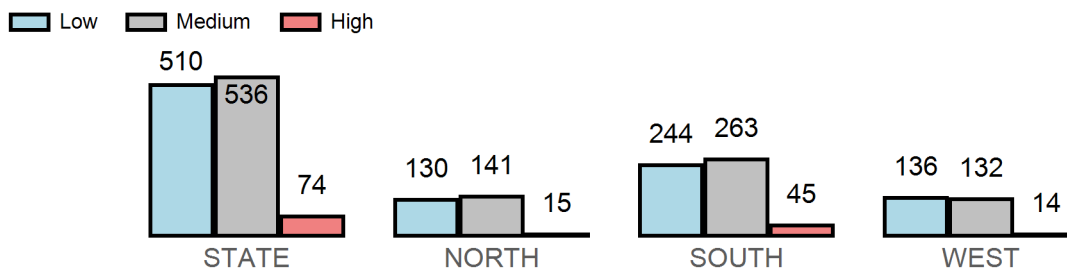
## Family Violence Incidents - October 2019

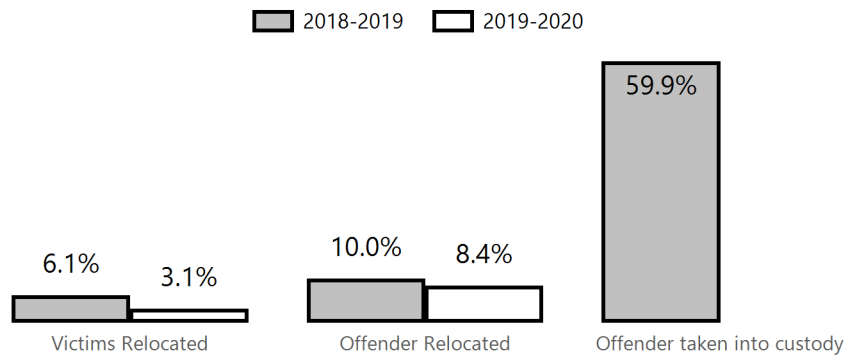

## Family Violence RAST - Excludes Other and Argument Categories



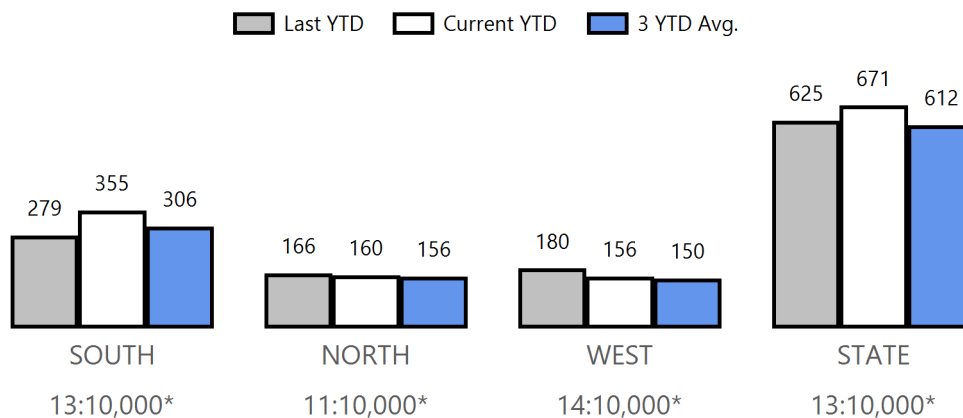

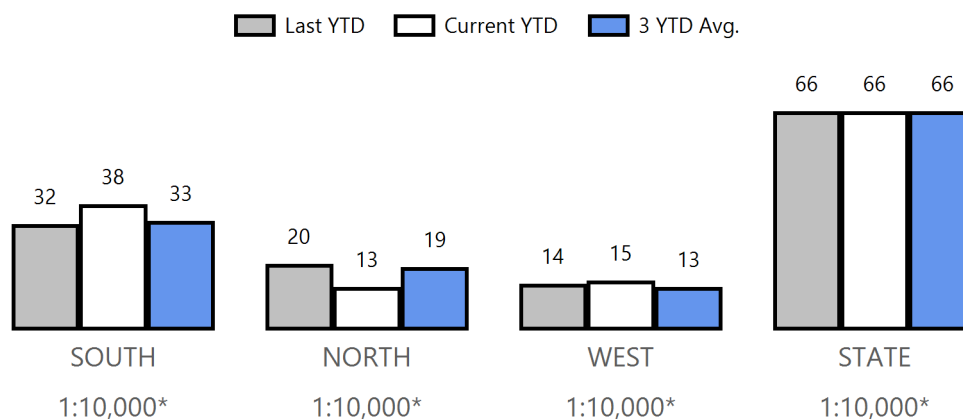
## Family Violence : Juveniles Affected - October 2019

## Family Violence : Weapons Present - October 2019



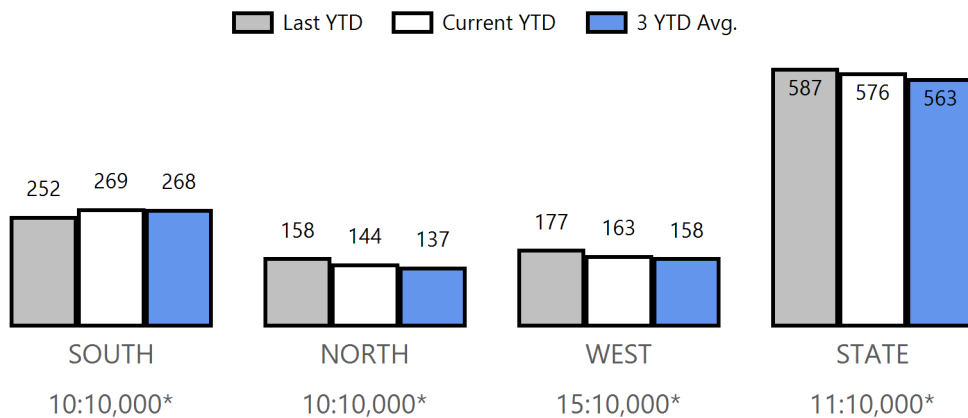

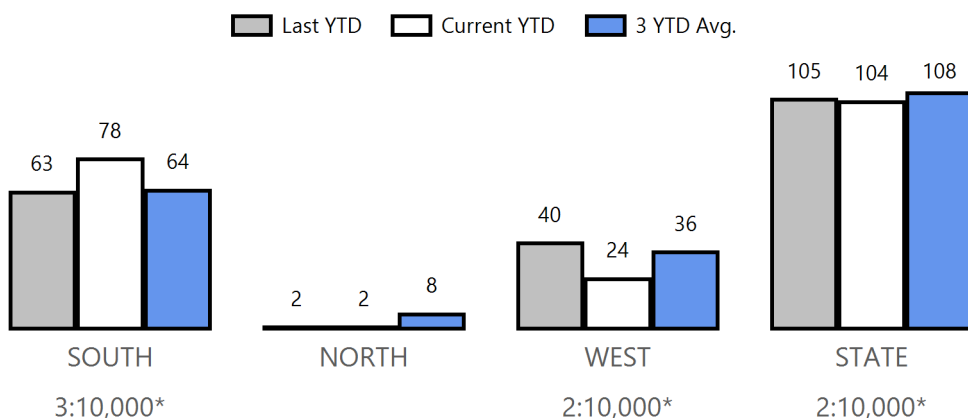
### Family Violence Orders : Police Issued - October 2019

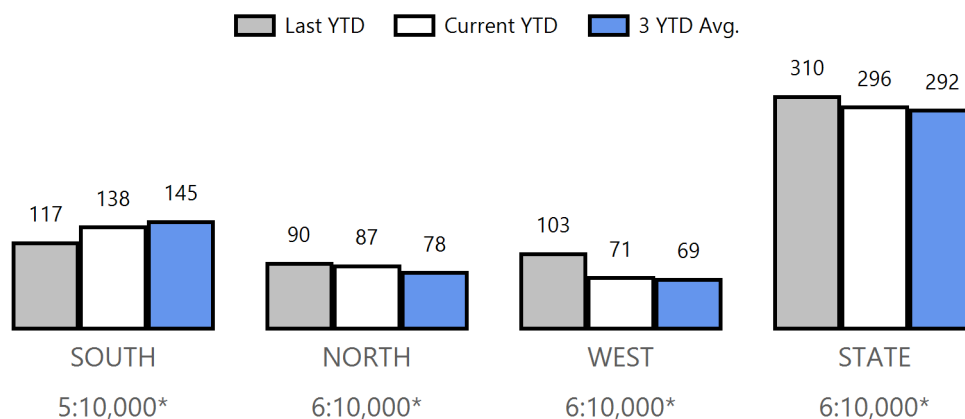
### Family Violence Orders : Court Application - October 2019

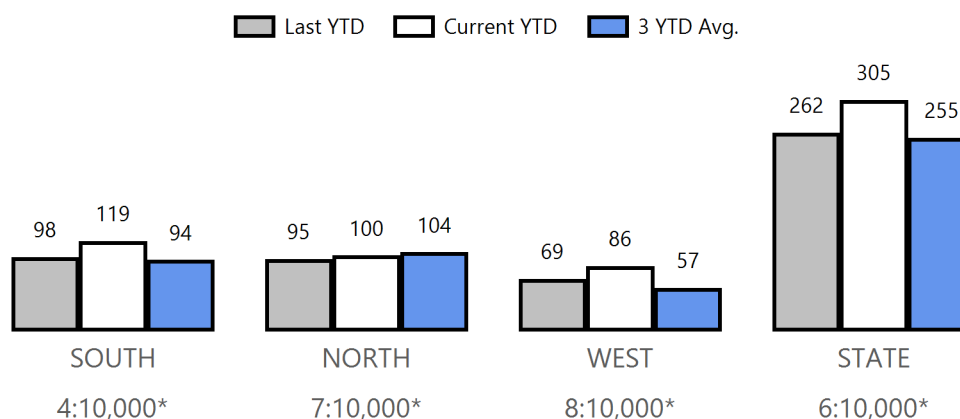
## Family Violence - PFVO Breaches - October 2019

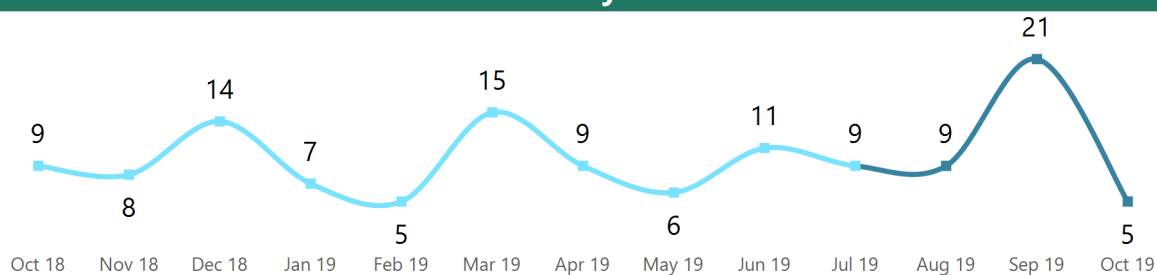


## Robbery Offences - October 2019

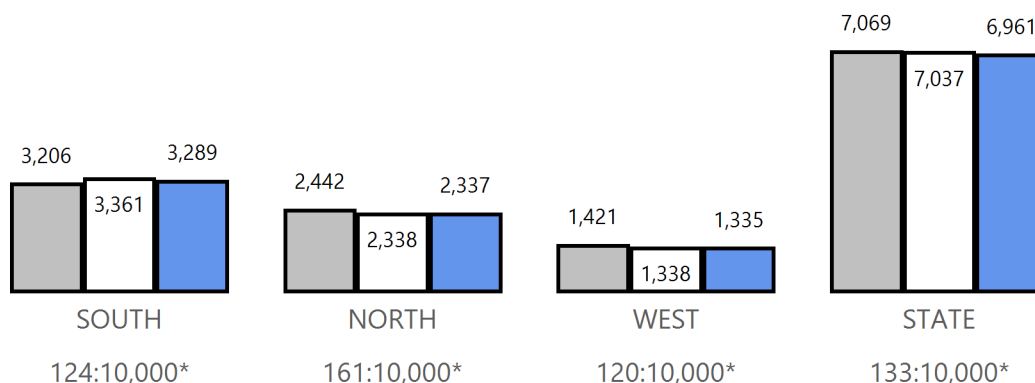

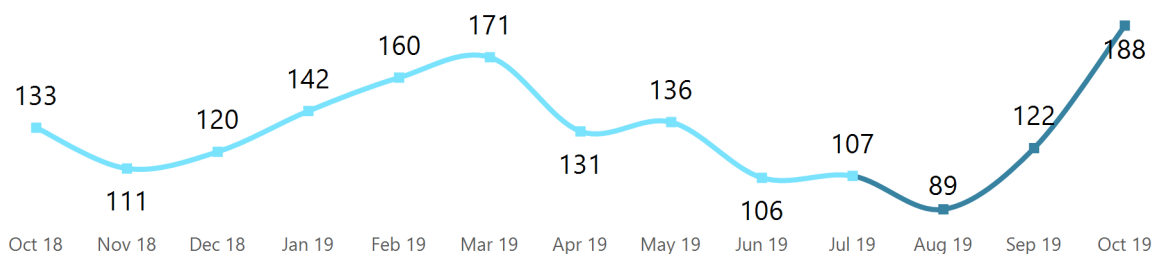

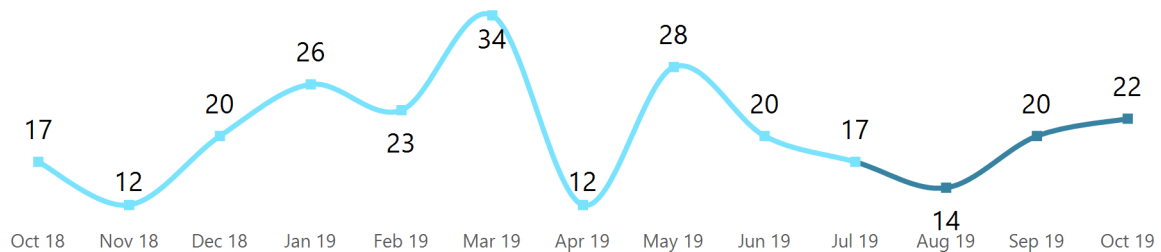
## SMV : Fire Damaged - October 2019

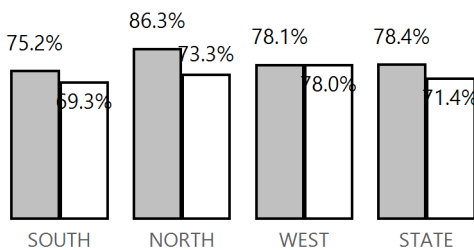

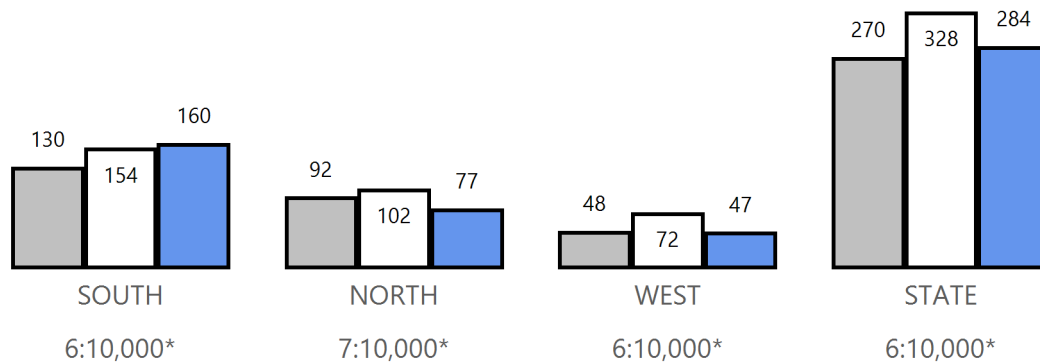

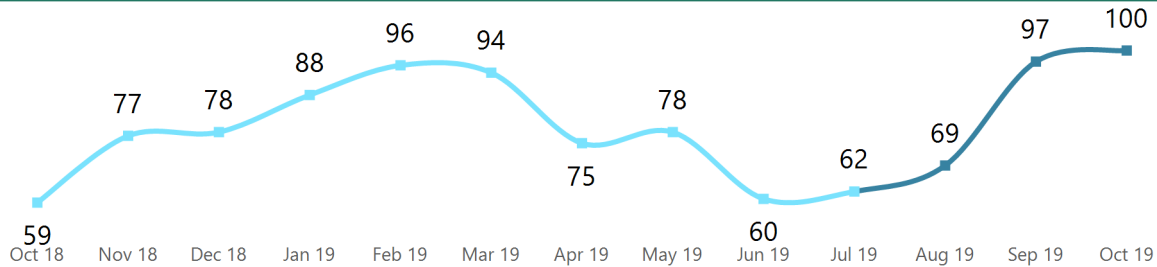


## Fraud and Similar Offences - October 2019

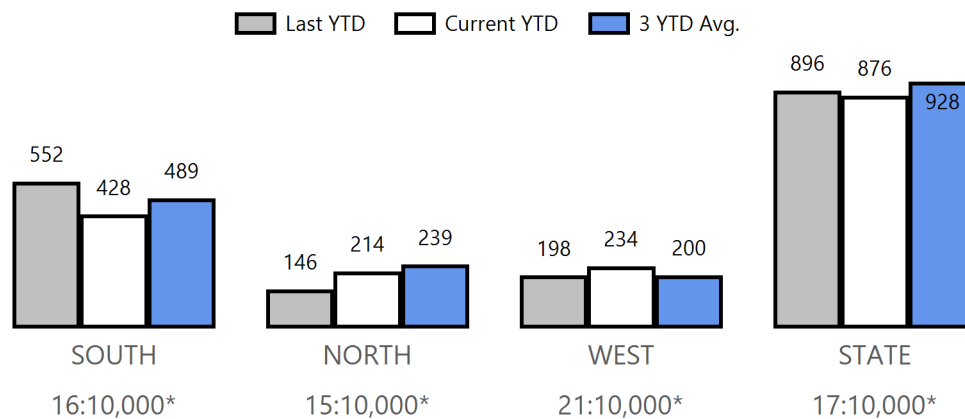
## CIB: Total Offenders - October 2019

## CIB: Total Crime Offenders - October 2019



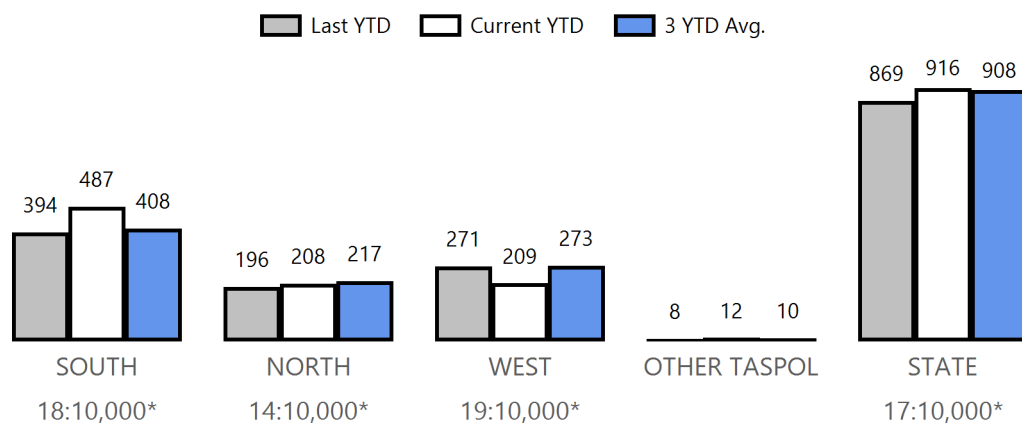

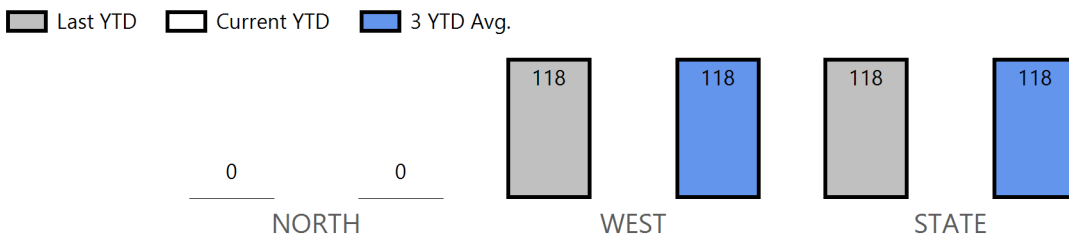
## Drug Detector Dogs - Deployments - October 2019



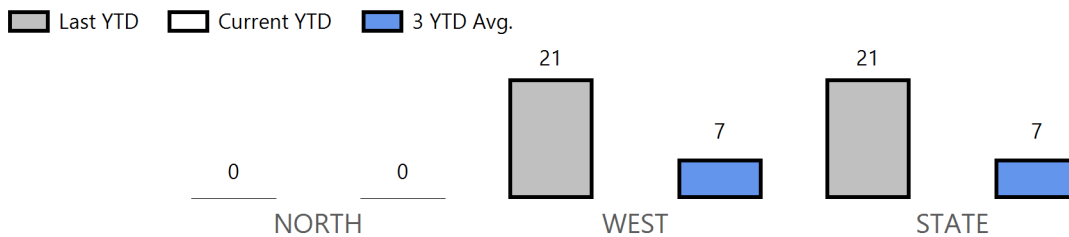

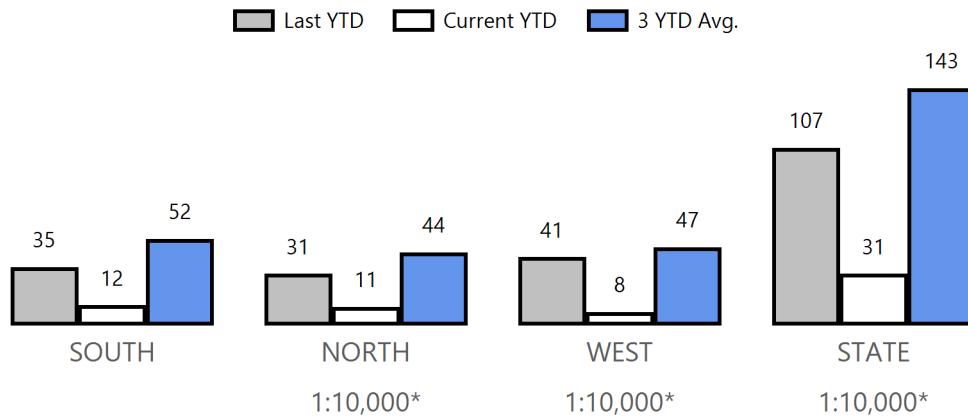


## Explosive Detector Dog - Detections - October 2019



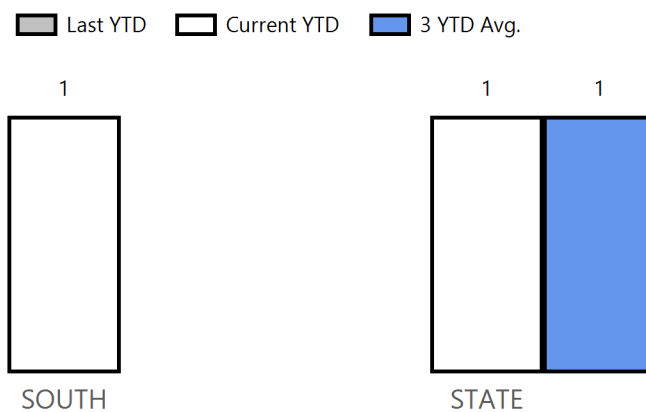

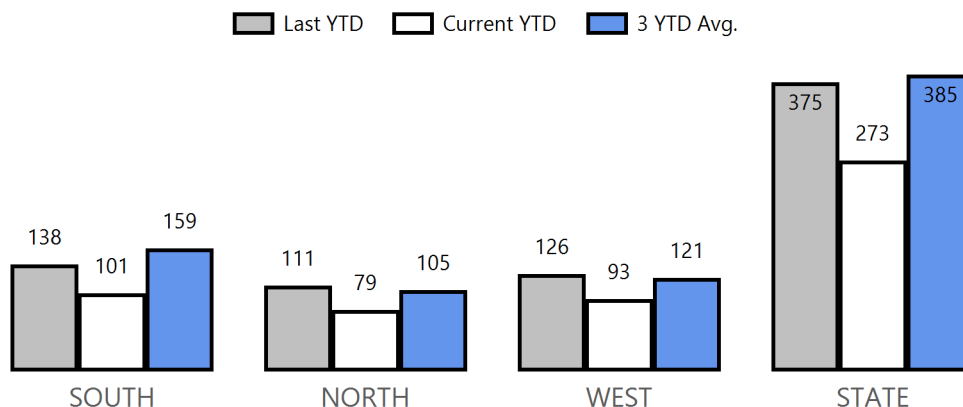
## Major Traffic Operations - October 2019

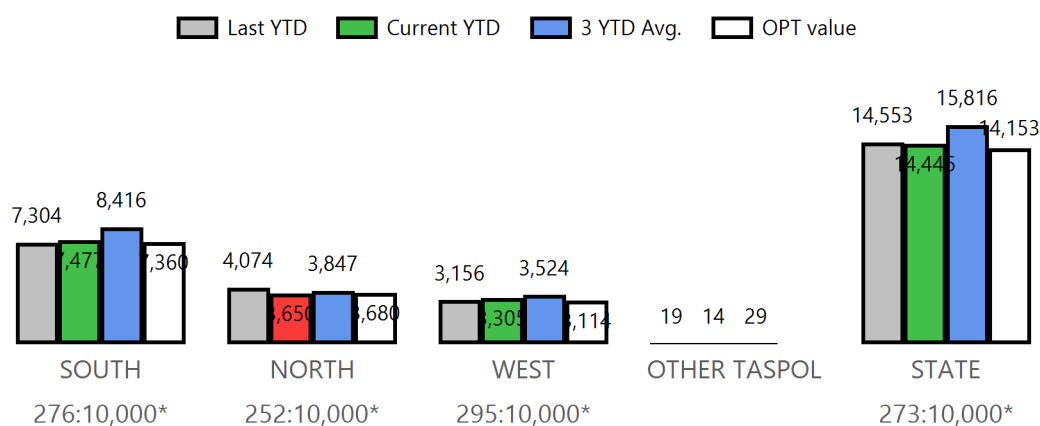

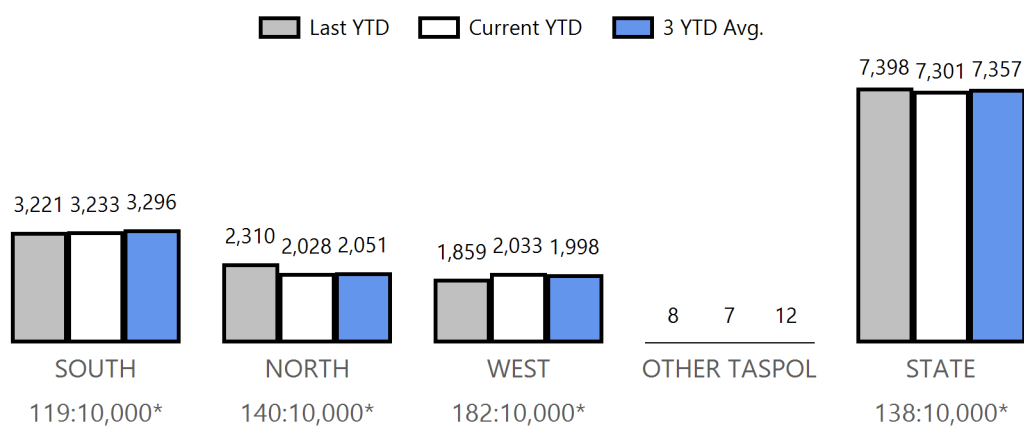
## Speeding Offenders - October 2019

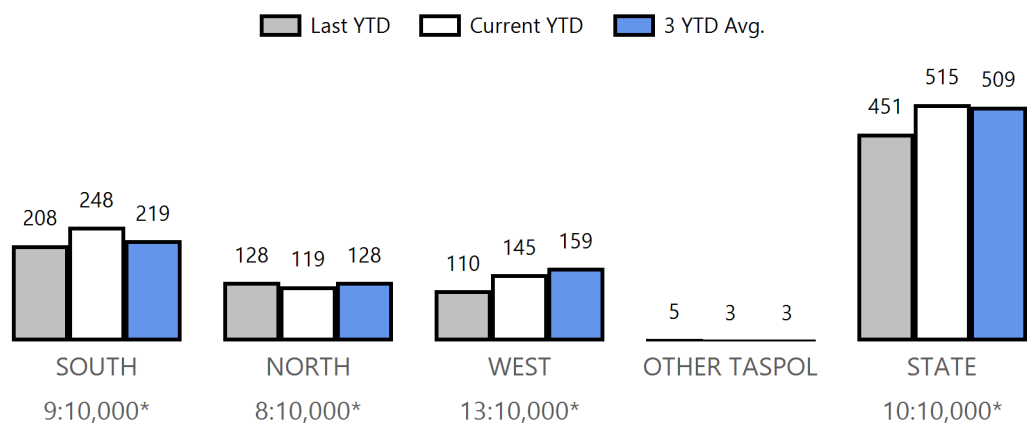
## Excessive Speed Offenders - 15-29km/h - October 2019

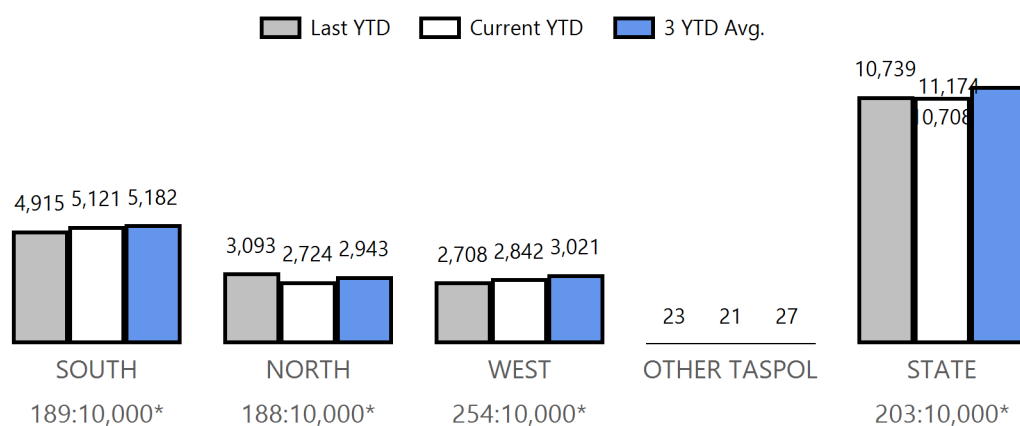

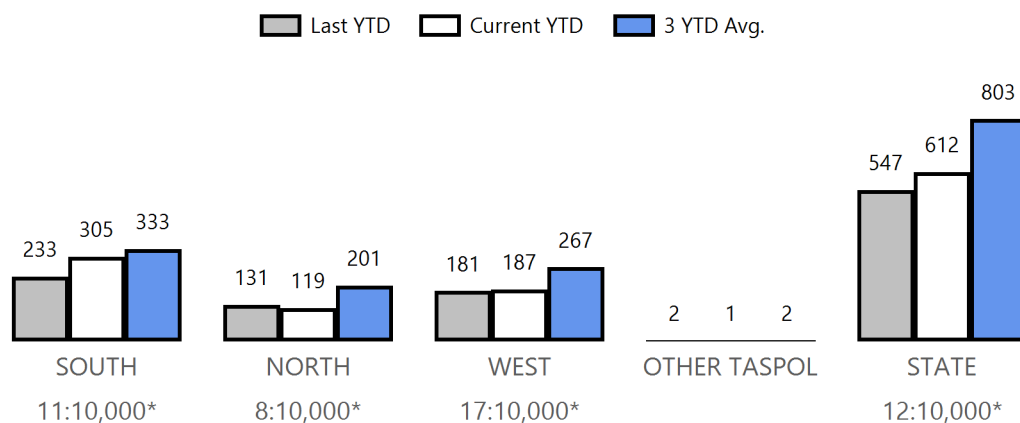

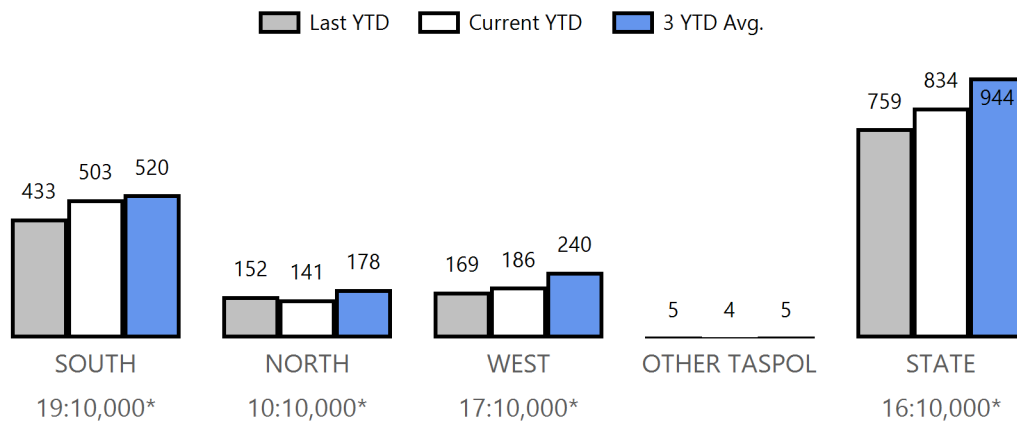
## Seatbelt Compliance Offenders - October 2019

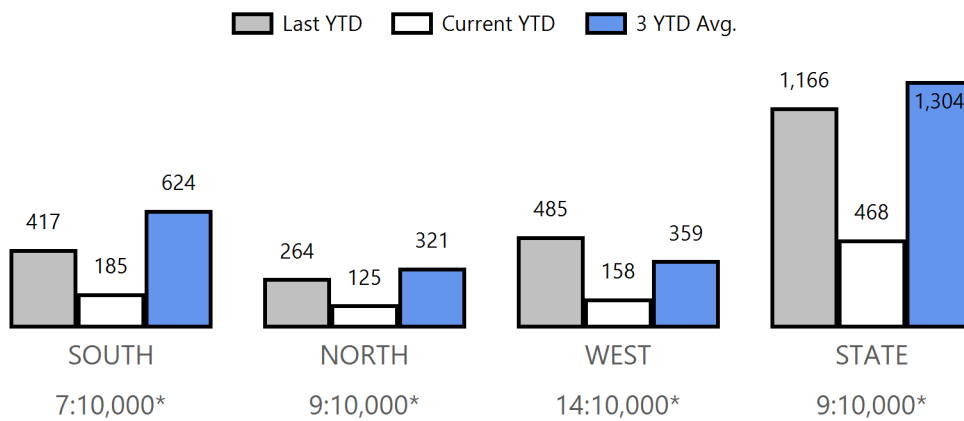

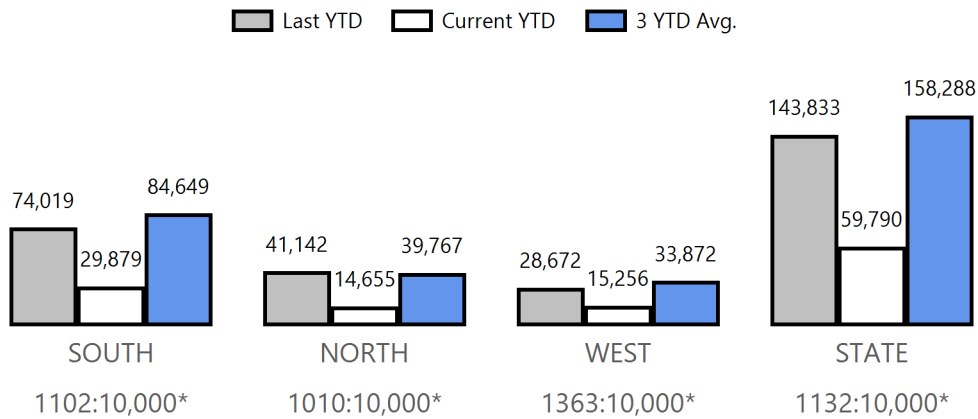

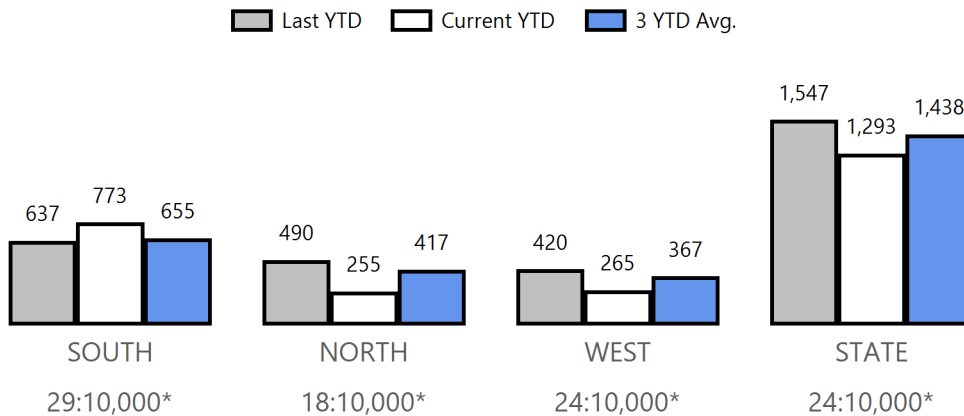

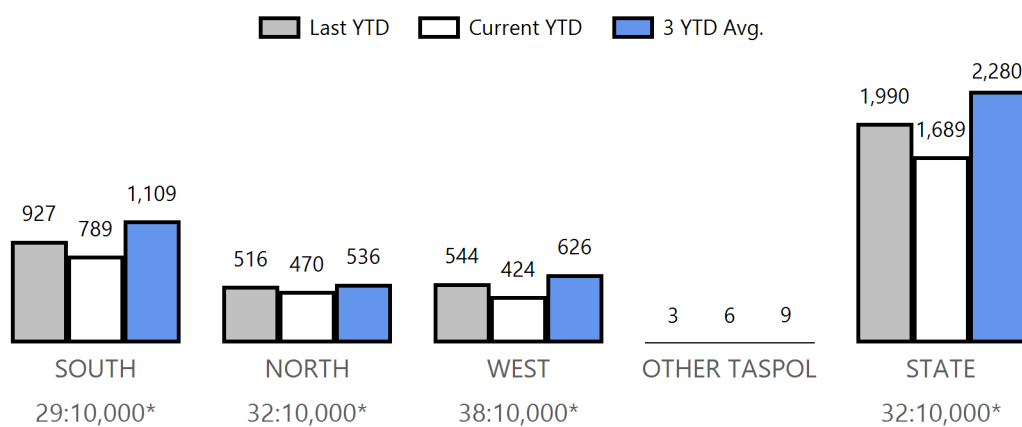

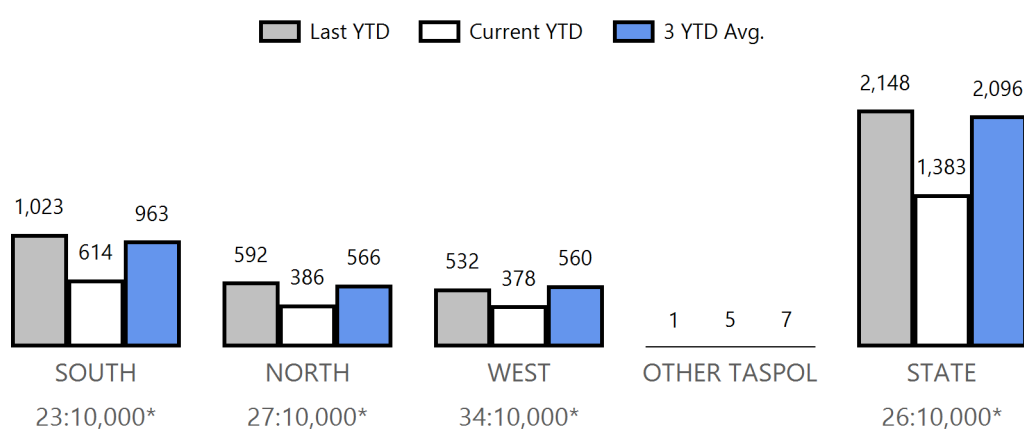

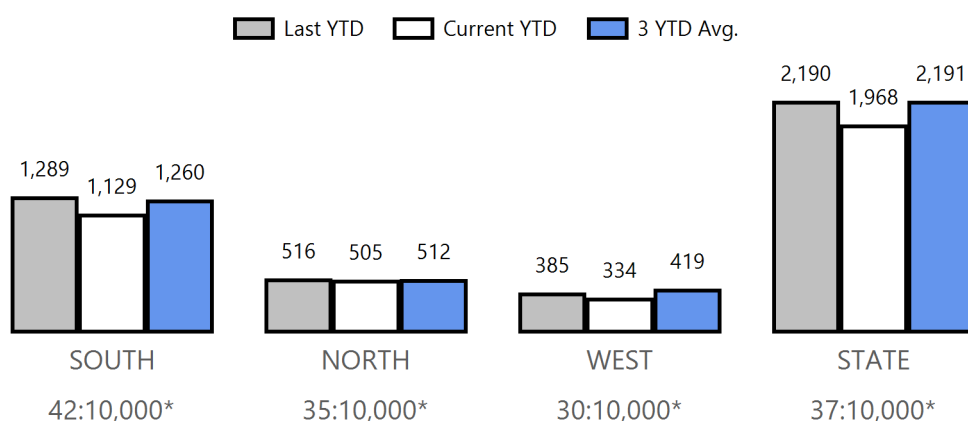
## Unregistered Vehicle Offenders - October 2019

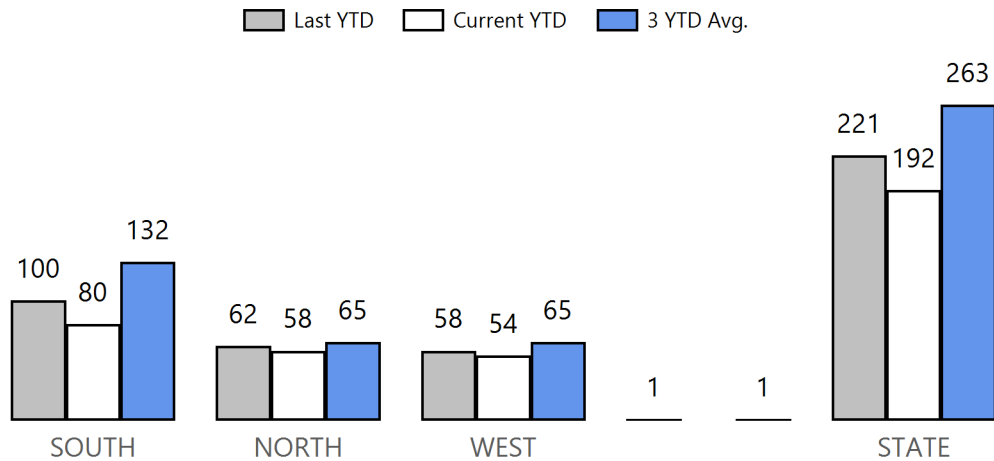
## Vehicle Complaints made to RDS - October 2019

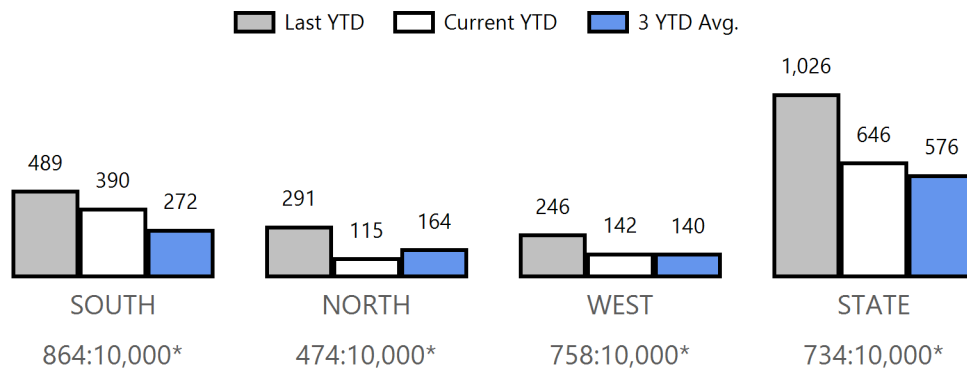

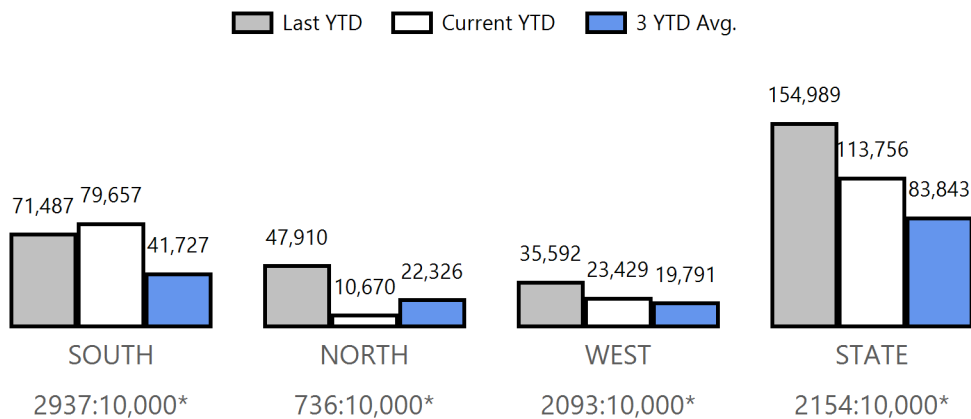
## Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) Camera : Roadside Hours - October 2019

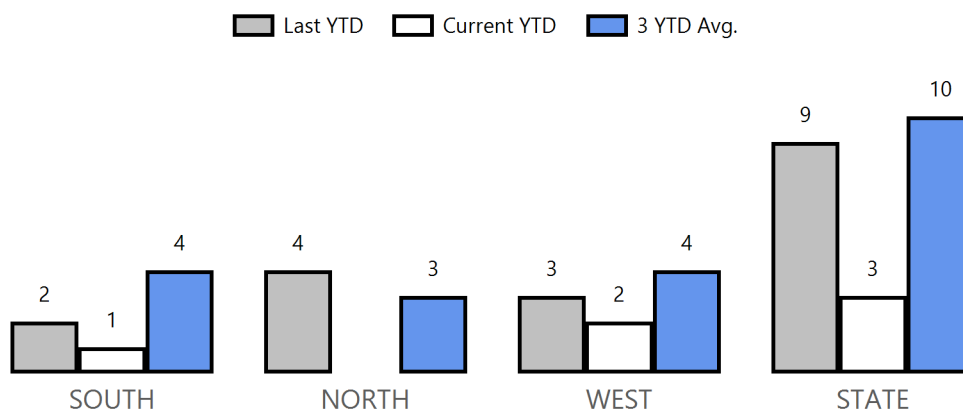

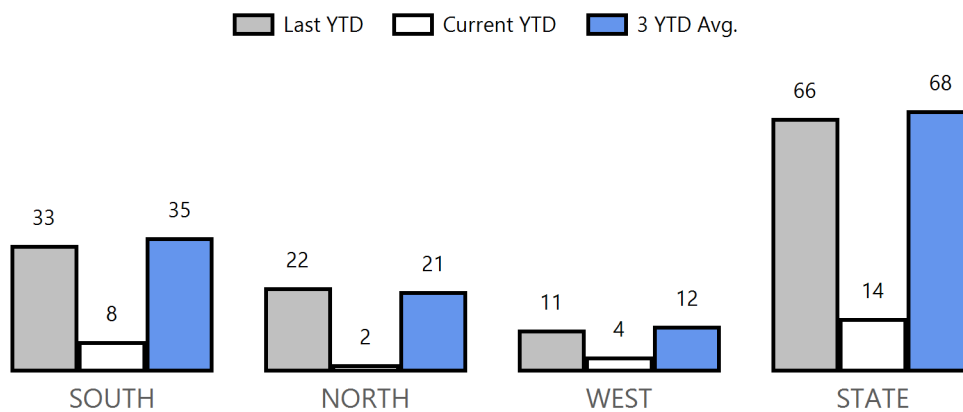
### Fatal Crashes - October 2019

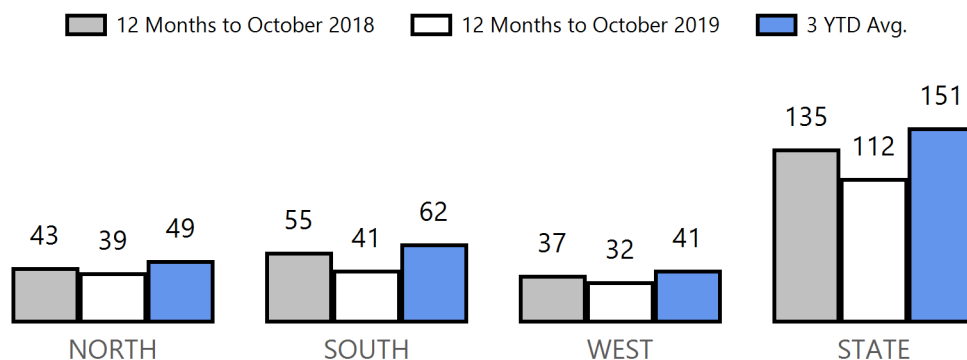

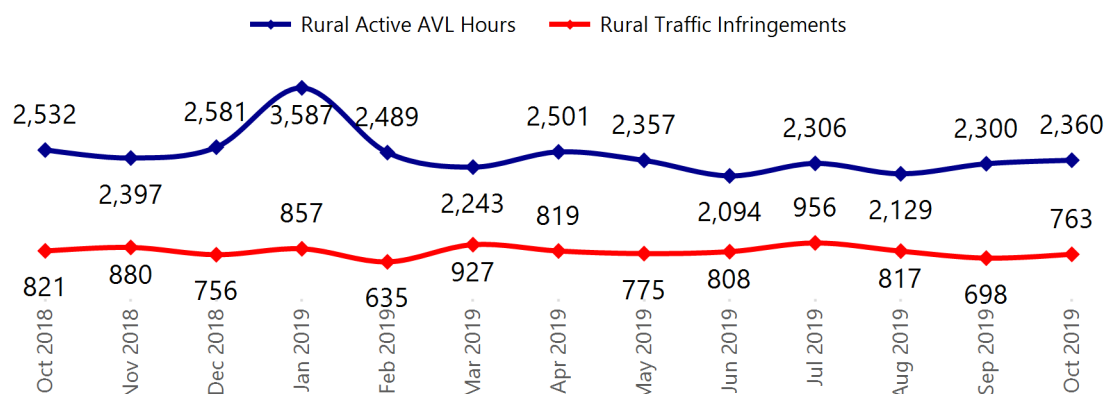
### On Road Fatal and Serious Crashes in Rural Areas (Over the last 12 months)



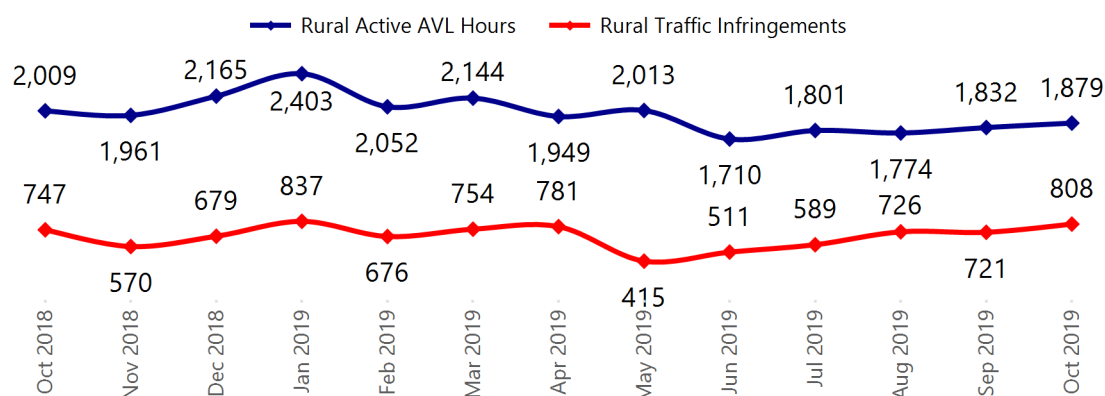

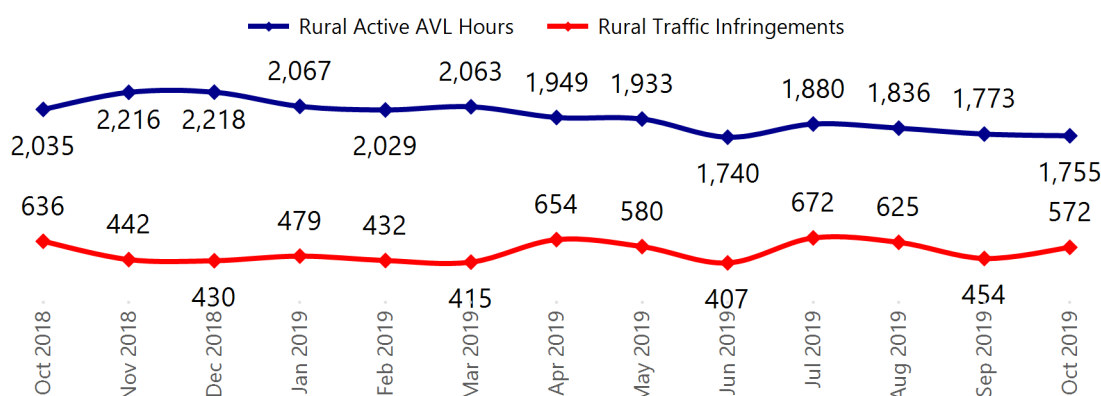
### Southern District Rural Policing

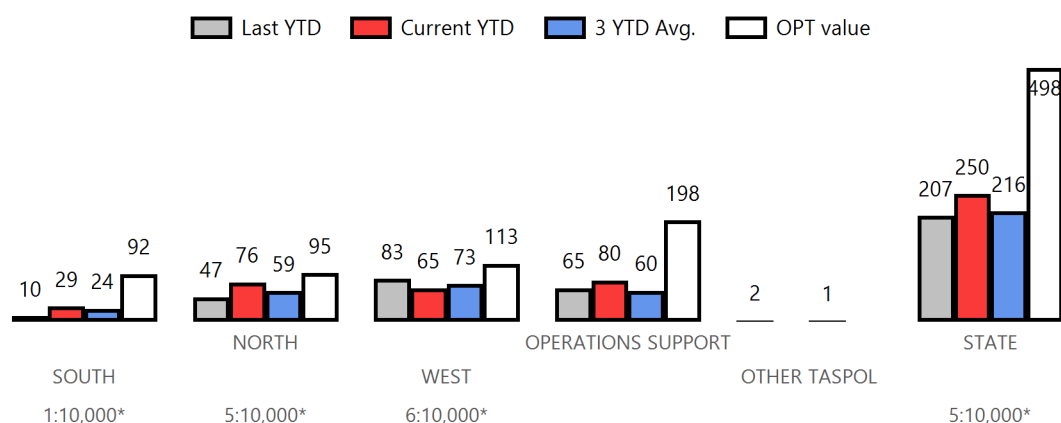

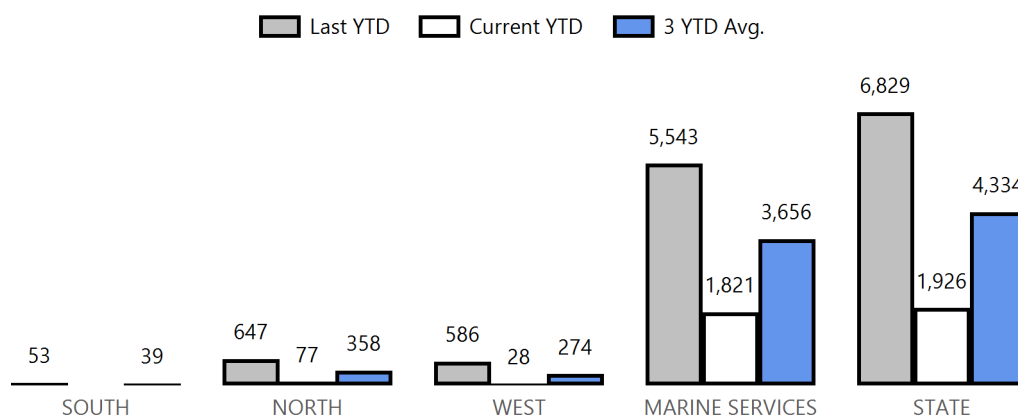

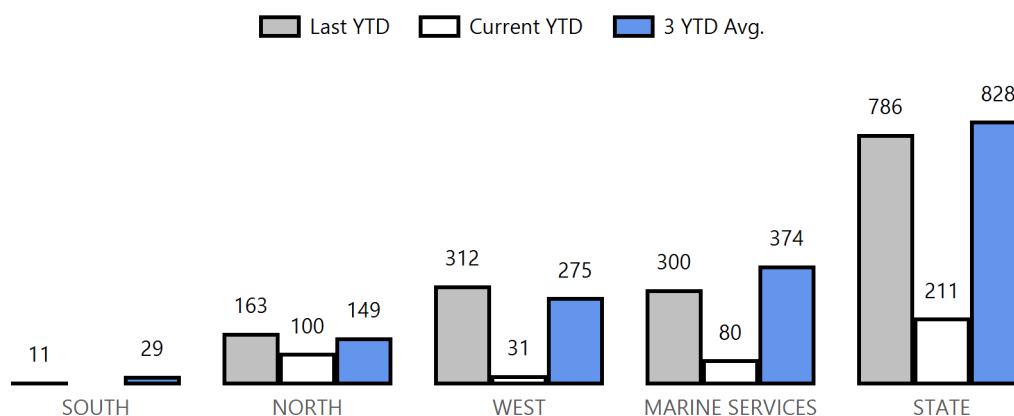

## Sea Inspections (Vessel & Non-Vessel) - October 2019



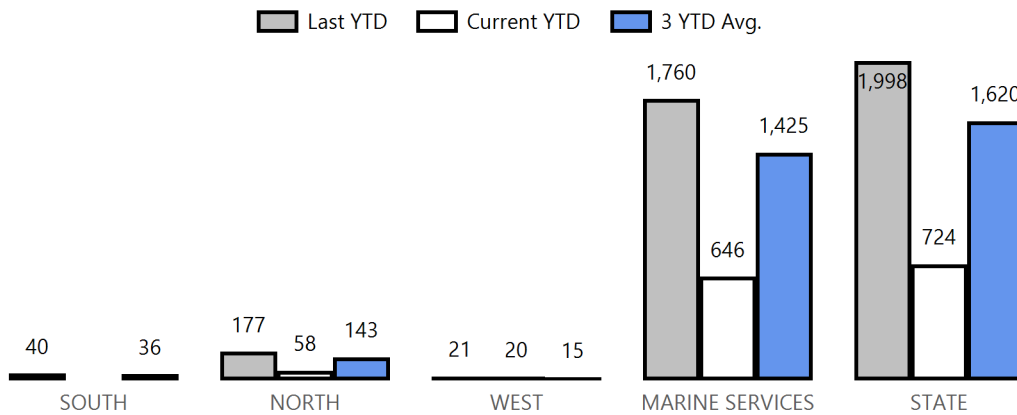

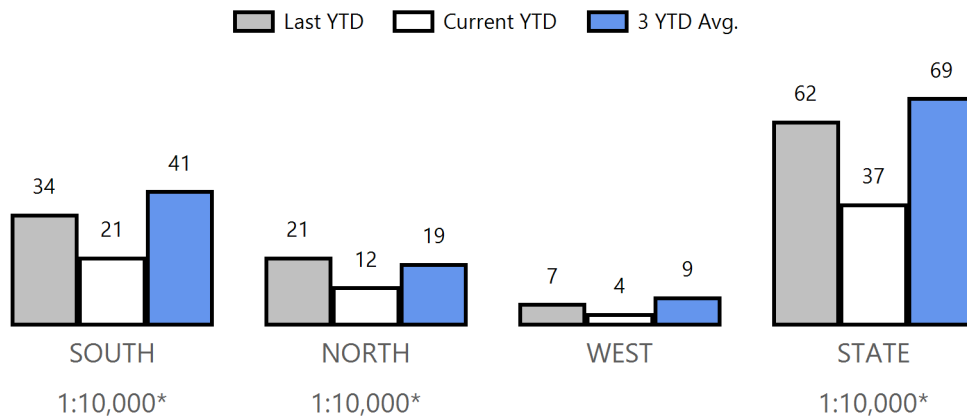

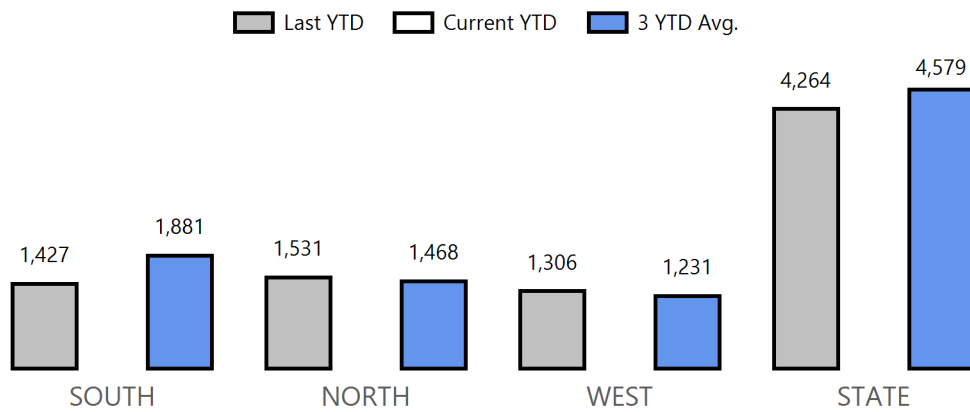
## Search and Rescue Operations - October 2019
