#### Disclaimer

The Corporate Performance Report is produced for internal purposes to measure the performance of our people, resources and systems, and to assist with the management of our business. The Report is made available to external stakeholders as the figures contained may be of public interest. Data are not extracted for the Report until one month after the reporting period has concluded. This one month period ensures there are sufficient opportunities for data to be entered into police systems and for quality assurance to be undertaken. However, the primary purpose of the Report is to measure internal performance, not provide official Departmental figures. There may be discrepancies between measures provided in this Report and official Departmental figures due to several possible factors.

Electronic data was extracted on 9 December 2019. Manual data is collated monthly by Reporting Services from information self-reported by organisational units within DPFEM or provided/downloaded from a variety of sources as indicated throughout the Report.






## Public Safety - Out in Public Locally (Daytime)




## General Satisfaction with Police Services


## Satisfaction - Dealing with Public Order Problems


## Public Order Incidents - September 2019


## Public Order : Disturbance - September 2019


## Public Order : Noise - September 2019


## Public Order : Vandalism - September 2019


## Public Order : Offensive Behaviour - September 2019





















## Total Person Offences - Victim Categories - NORTH










## Total Uniform Police Patrol Hours - September 2019


## Uniform Police - Patrol Hours




## Family Violence Incidents - September 2019



## Family Violence RAST - Excludes Other and Argument Categories






## Family Violence : Juveniles Affected - September 2019

## Family Violence : Weapons Present - September 2019






### Family Violence Orders : Police Issued - September 2019


### Family Violence Orders : Court Application - September 2019


## Family Violence - PFVO Breaches - September 2019












## SMV : Fire Damaged - September 2019


## CIB: Total Offenders - September 2019

## CIB: Total Crime Offenders - September 2019






## Explosive Detector Dog - Deployments - September 2019




## Major Traffic Operations - September 2019




## Speeding Offenders - September 2019


## Excessive Speed Offenders - 15-29km/h - September 2019


## Excessive Speed Offenders - 30km/h + - September 2019


## High Risk Offenders - September 2019


## Seatbelt Compliance Offenders - September 2019


## Mobile Phone Offenders - September 2019


## Vehicle Defect Notices - September 2019


## Random Breath Tests (ALCOHOL) - September 2019










## Unregistered Vehicle Offenders - September 2019


## Vehicle Complaints made to RDS - September 2019

### Vehicles Clamped or Confiscated - October 2019










## Fatal Crashes - September 2019




### On Road Fatal and Serious Crashes in Rural Areas (Over the last 12 months)






### Southern District Rural Policing












## Search and Rescue Operations - September 2019
