

Summary

Section 30(1)(c) Exemption Applied, Section 35 Exemption Applied, Section 36(1)Exemption Applied, Section 39 Exemption Applied

If confirmed, these actions would constitute clear breaches of Tasmania Police expectations regarding the lawful, necessary, and authorised use of information and further the access, disclosure and supply of information. Tasmania Police privacy and information handling obligations also require that personal information held by Tasmania Police is accessed only for authorised policing purposes and never for personal interest or curiosity. Section 13.2.2 of the Tasmania Police Manual outlines that members must not show or disclose any in particulars contained in any Tasmania Police book, document or record to any person outside Tasmania Police for any purpose which does not arise out of, and in the course of, the performance or execution of their duties. Further, that Members must not disclose information obtained by virtue of their employment as a police officer without a demonstrated need to know that information.

These incidents raise concerns about judgement, ethical awareness, and compliance with Tasmania Police policies and procedures. It is my recommendation that this matter be referred to Management Review for investigation.

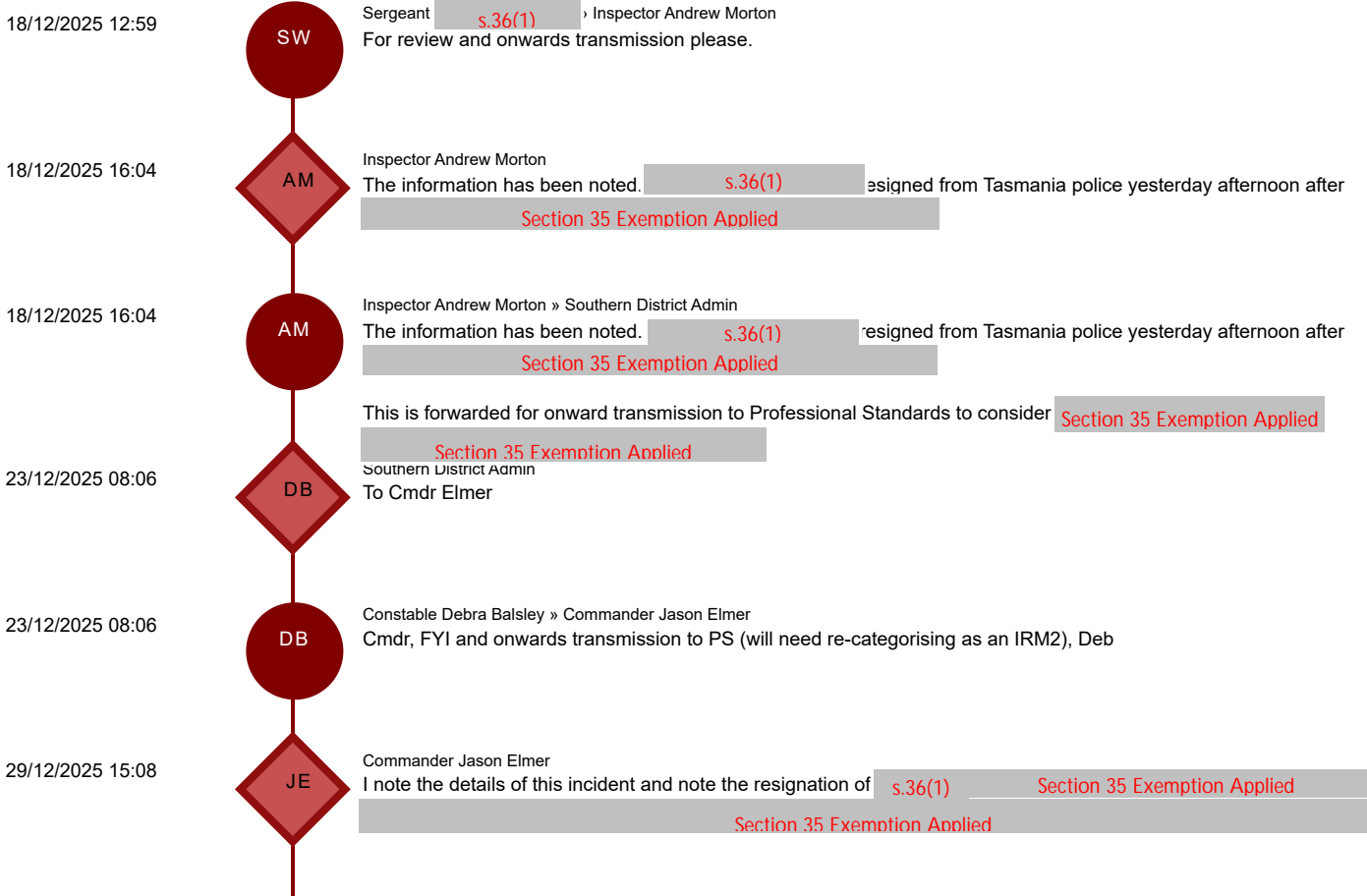

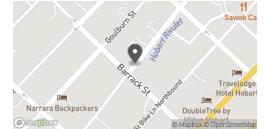

Summary

Section 30(1)(c) Exemption Applied, Section 35 Exemption Applied, Section 36(1) Exemption Applied, Section 39 Exemption Applied

If confirmed, these actions would constitute clear breaches of Tasmania Police policies and procedures regarding the lawful, necessary, and authorised use of information. Section 42 of The Police Services Act 2003 outlines a strict code of conduct and specifically mentions that a police officer must not access any information to which the police officer is not entitled to have access. It also requires that officers act with integrity and maintain confidentiality at all times. The acceptable use of police systems policy states that information may only be accessed where there is a legitimate operational need. Tasmania's privacy and information handling obligations also require that personal information held by Tasmania Police is accessed only for authorised policing purposes and never for personal interest or curiosity.

These incidents raise concerns about judgement, ethical awareness, and compliance with Tasmania Police policies and procedures. It is my recommendation that this matter be referred to Management Review for assessment, including verification through an audit of her access history. I can be contacted directly if further information is required.

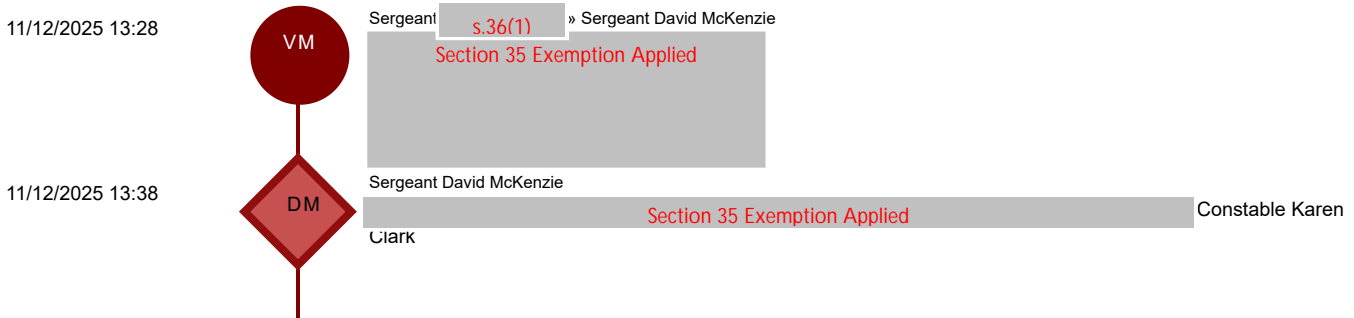

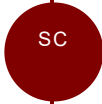

Completion notes: At 13:15 on Wednesday 17 December 2025 TC I spoke to s.36(1) in the presence of Shane Tilley (PAT), Martin Grub (Wellbeing Support), Acting Inspector Morton (Southern Prosecution Services) and Acting Sergeant Teagan Walkley (Recruiting Services).

This conversation took place in the Inspector's Office at Prosecution Services.

I spoke to s.36(1) about:

- * Poor attitude at work
- * Being consistently late for work
- * Making private appointments in work time without authorisation
- * The unauthorised accesses to data as detailed in this BlueTeam entry

At the conclusion of the conversation s.36(1) elected to resign from Tasmania Police. Resignation Notice RN25/128 has been submitted.
