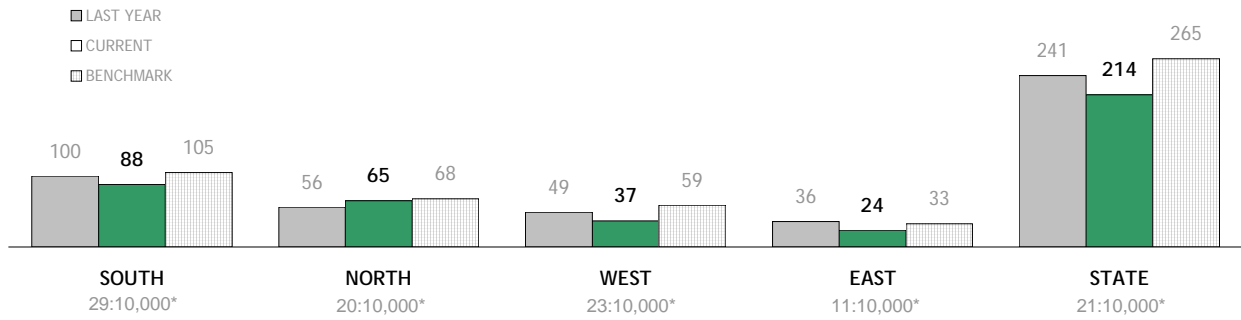

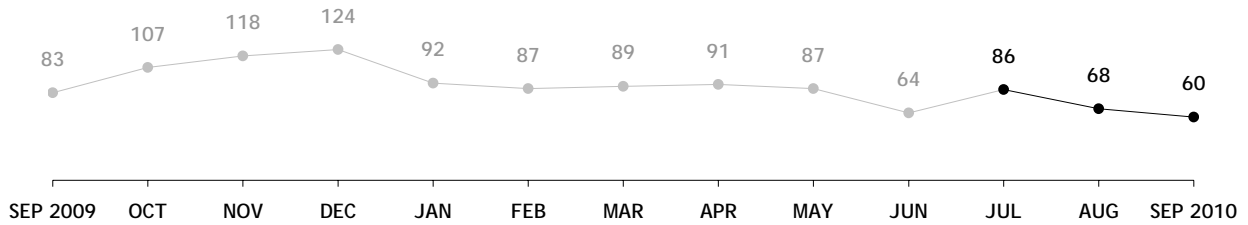
PUBLIC PLACE ASSAULTS

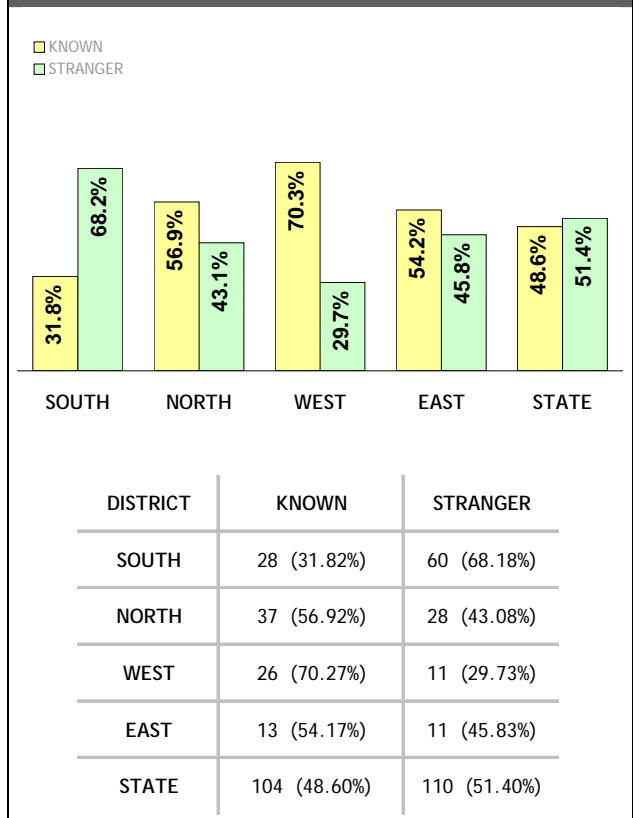

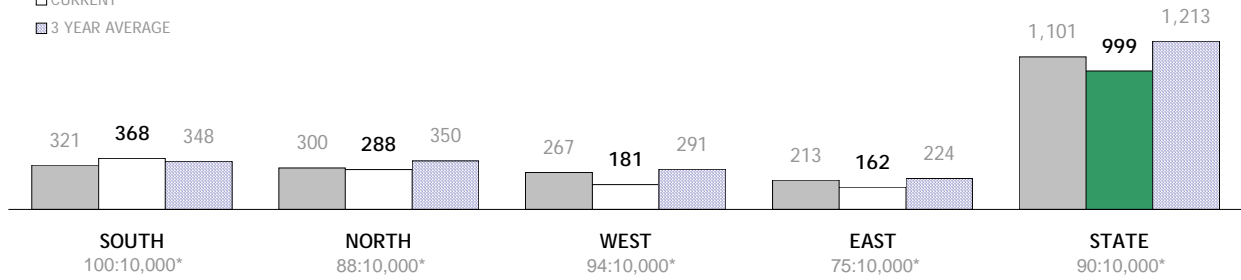

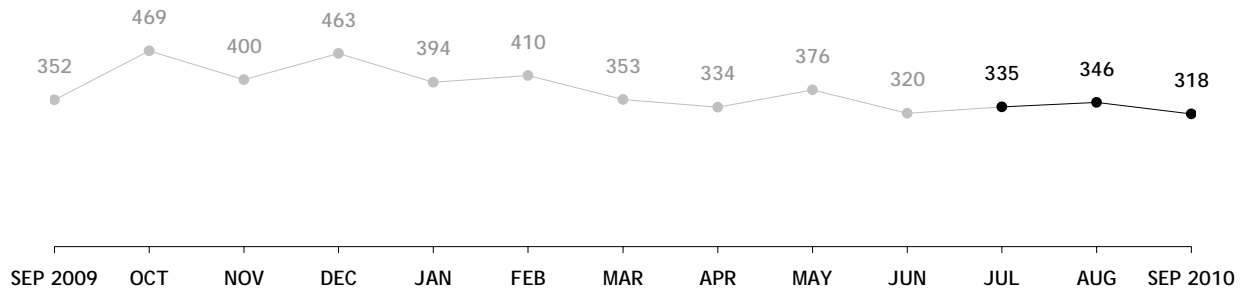
STATE TOTAL PERSON OFFENCES

STATE PERSON OFFENCES : GENERAL CATEGORIES



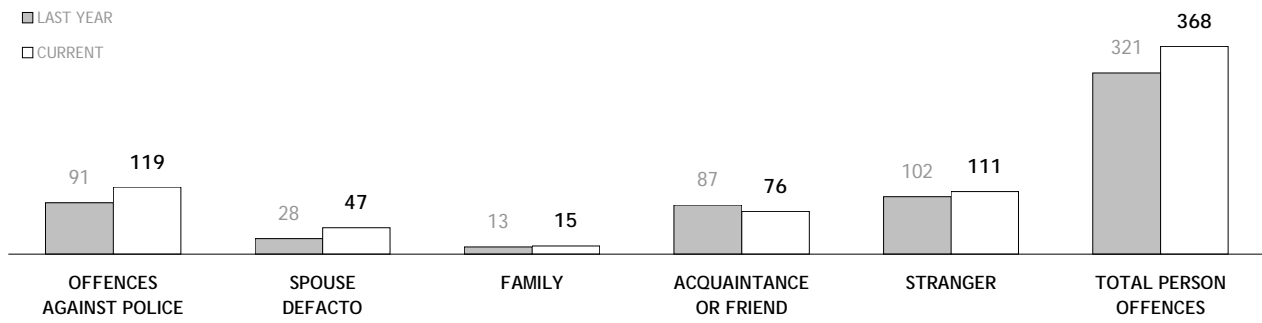

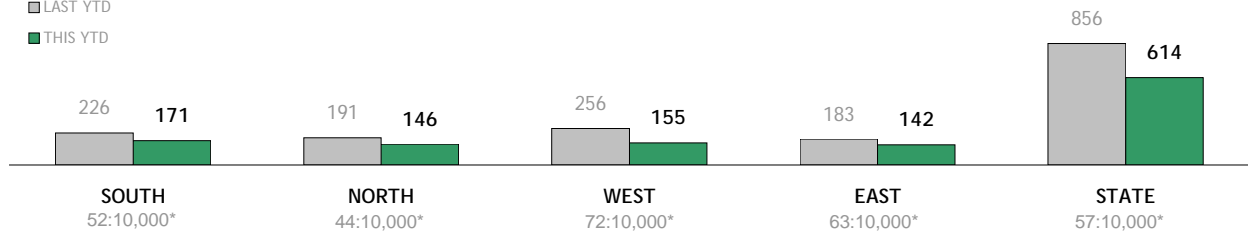

FAMILY VIOLENCE INCIDENT: RAST CLASSIFICATIONS

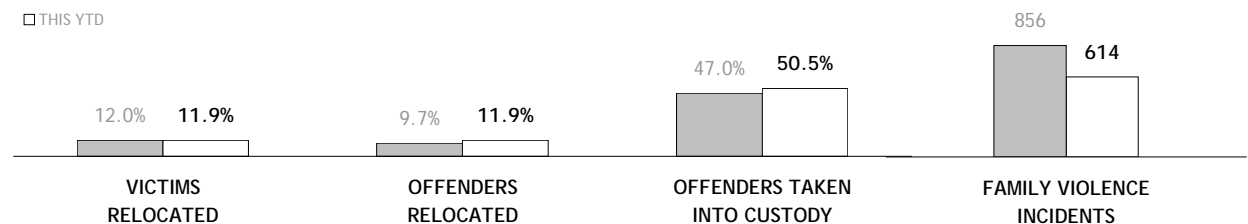

TOTAL NUMBER OF OFFENCES



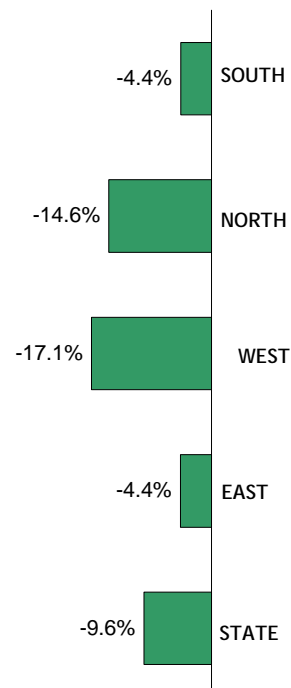

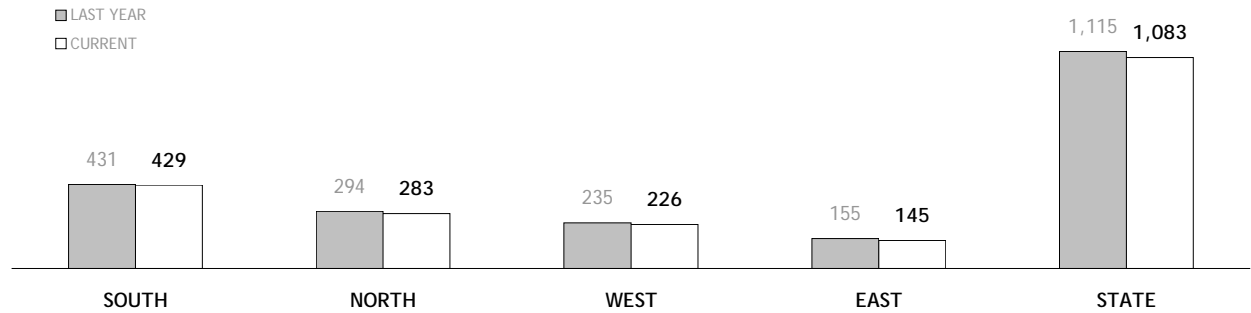


CIB CRIME OFFENDERS CHARGED

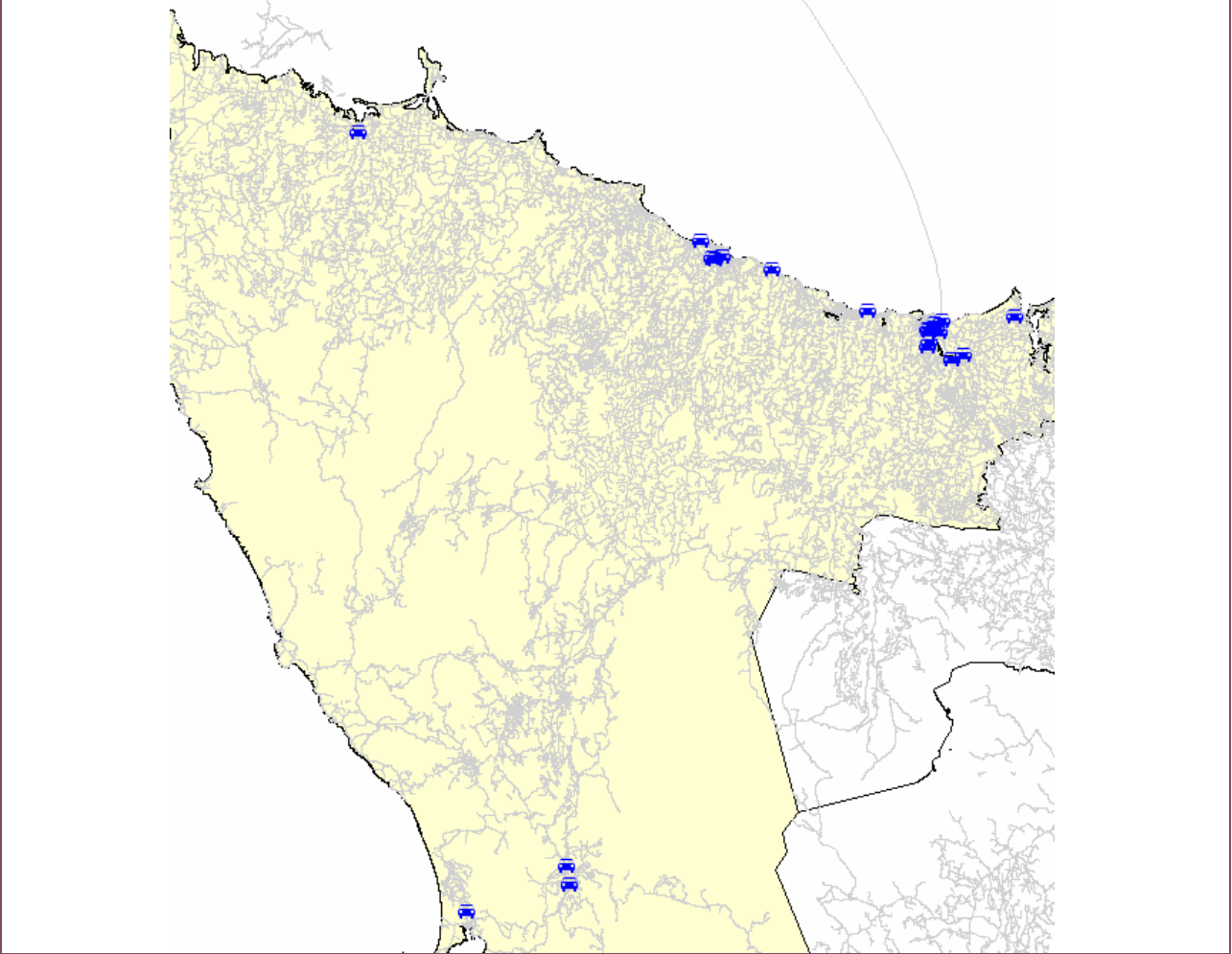


NORTHERN DISTRICT DTO LOCATIONS – SEPTEMBER 2010

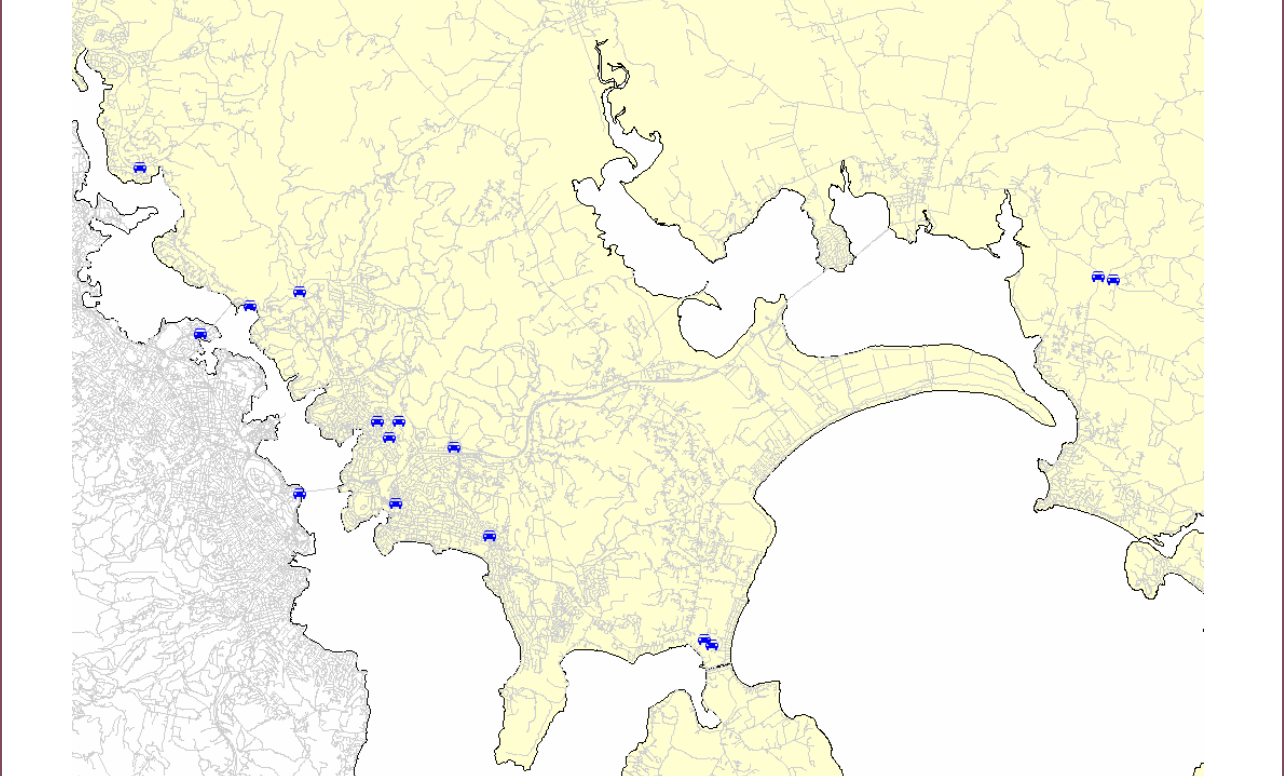

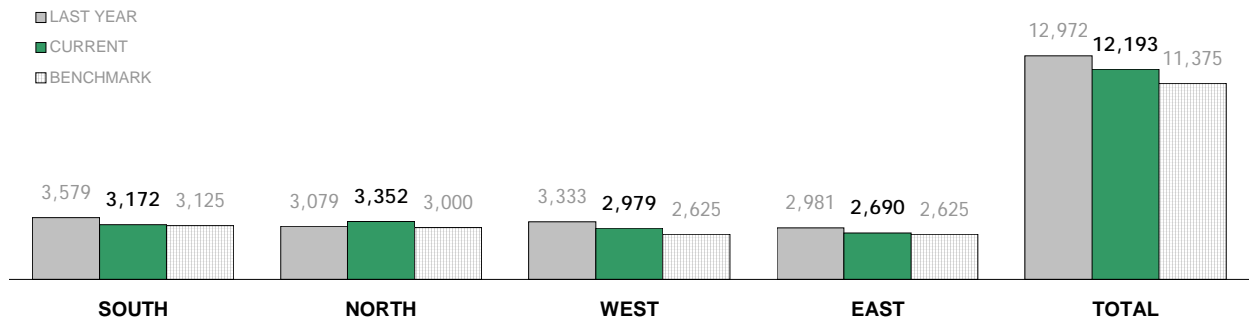

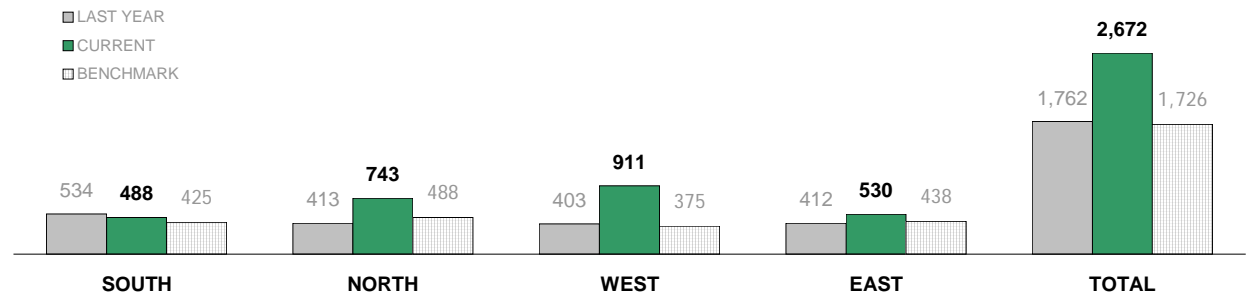
TOTAL DISTRICT SPEEDING TINS

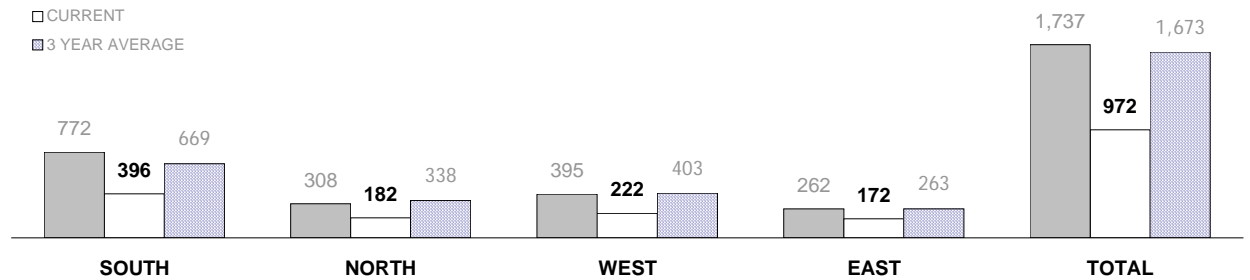
SEATBELT COMPLIANCE TINS

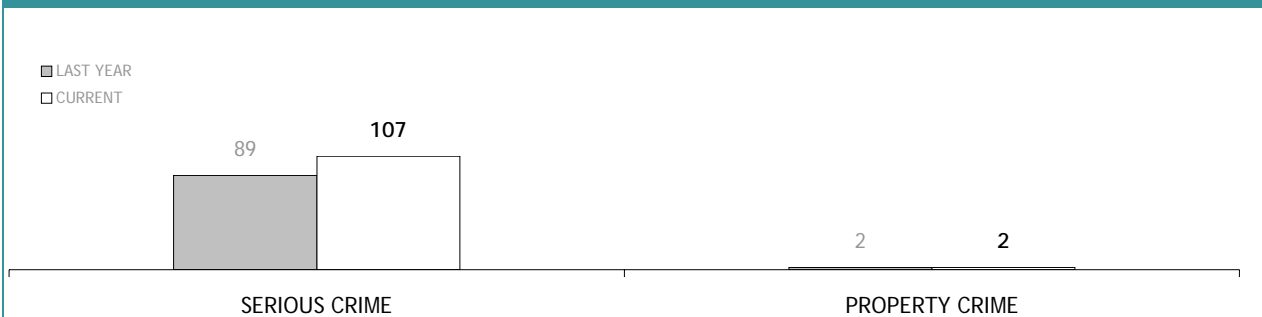
BIOLOGICAL EXAMINATION SECTION : YTD ITEMS RECEIVED

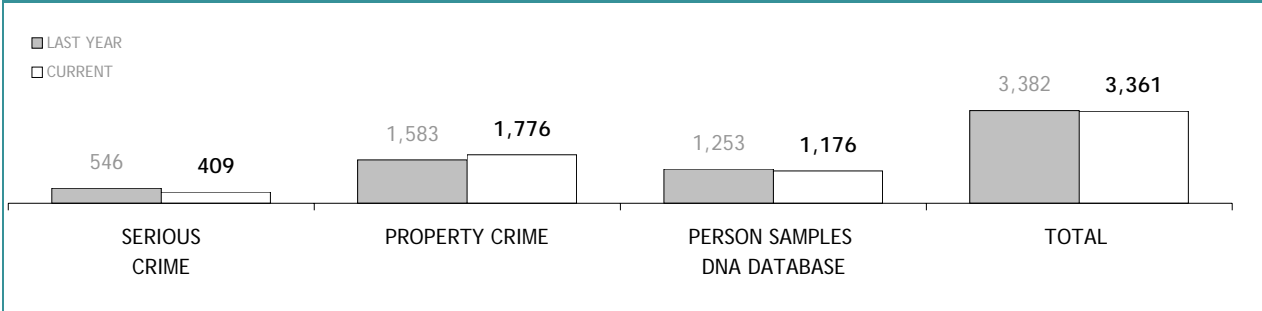

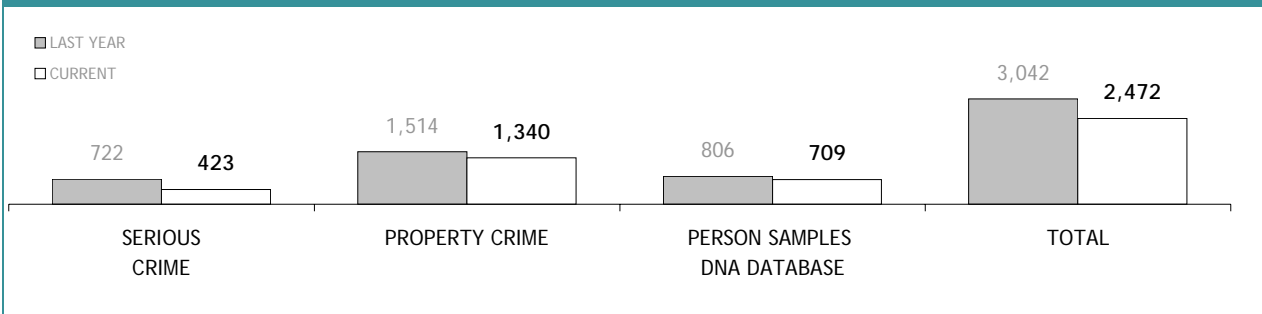

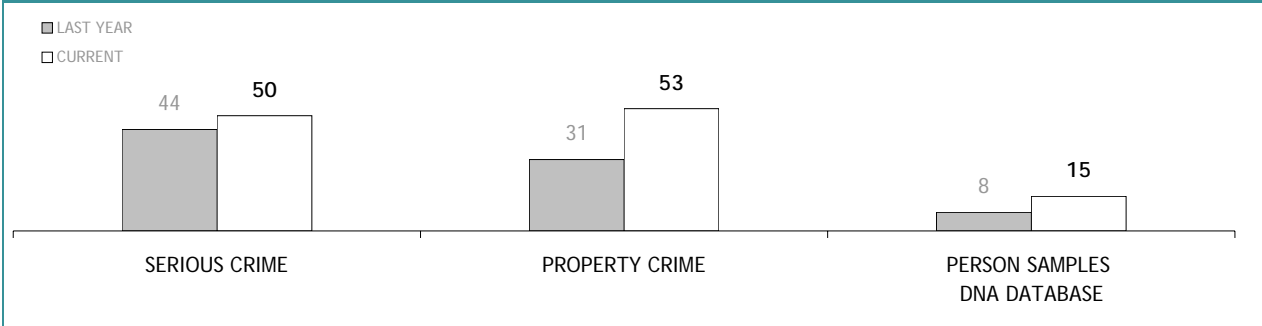
DNA SECTION : YTD SAMPLES RECEIVED

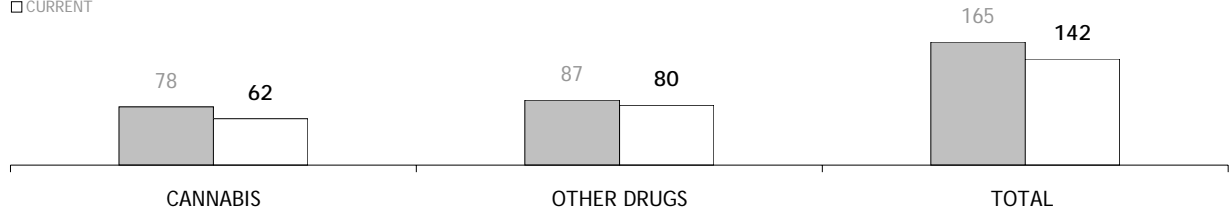

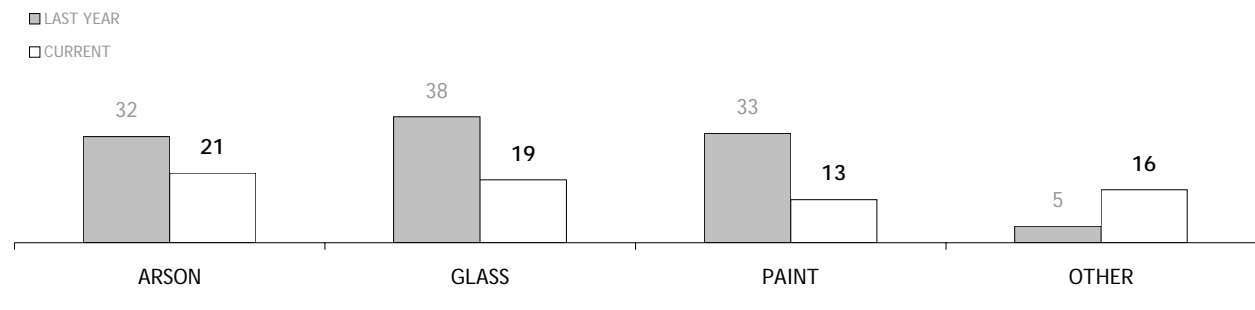
