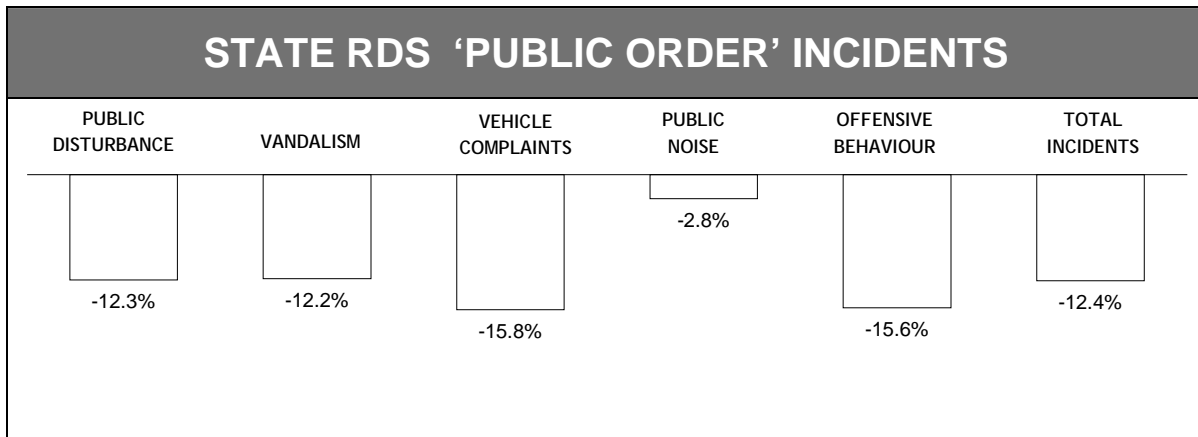

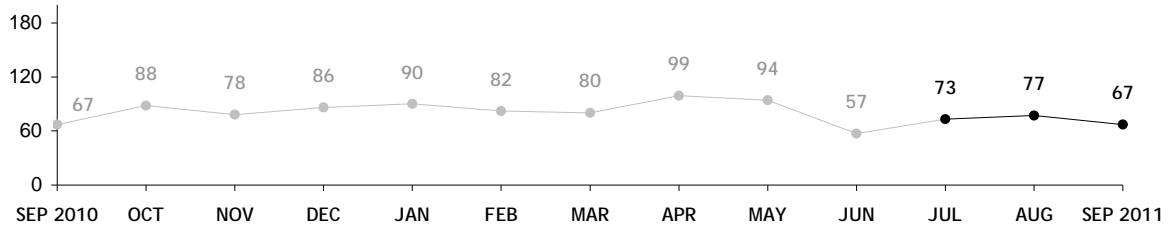
PUBLIC PLACE ASSAULTS

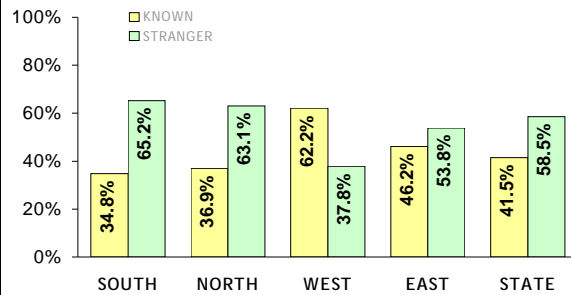

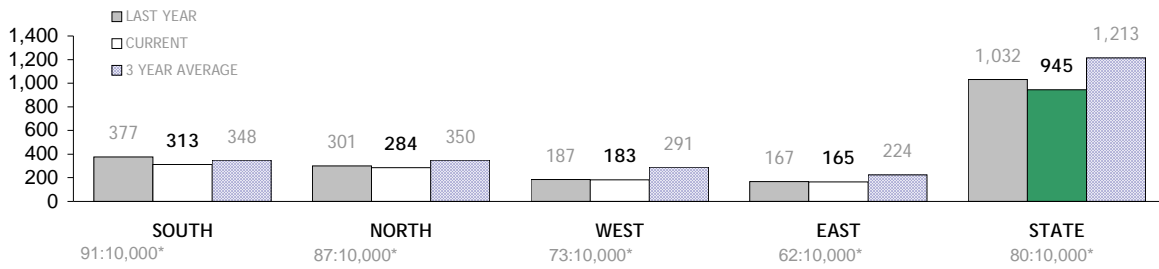
YTD OFFENDER STATUS

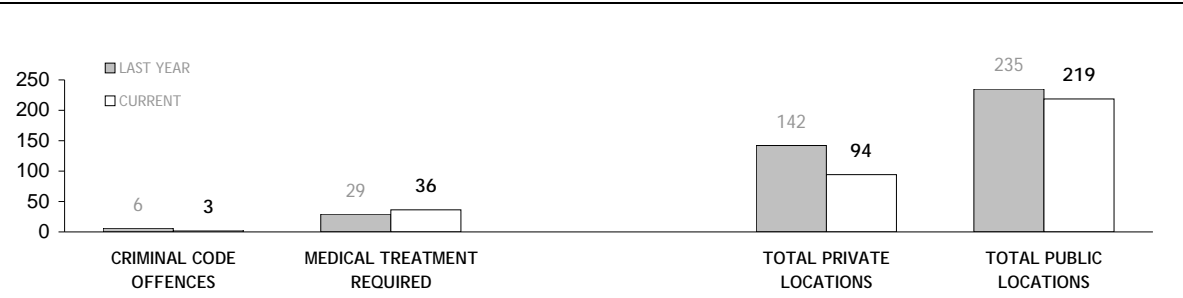
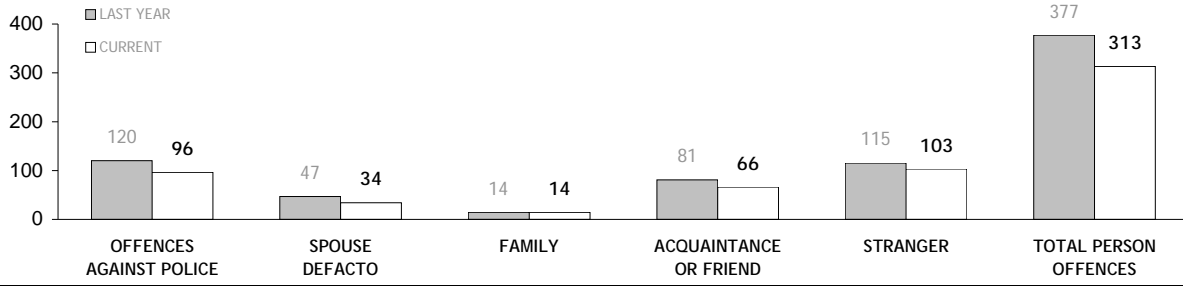
STATE PERSON OFFENCES : GENERAL CATEGORIES



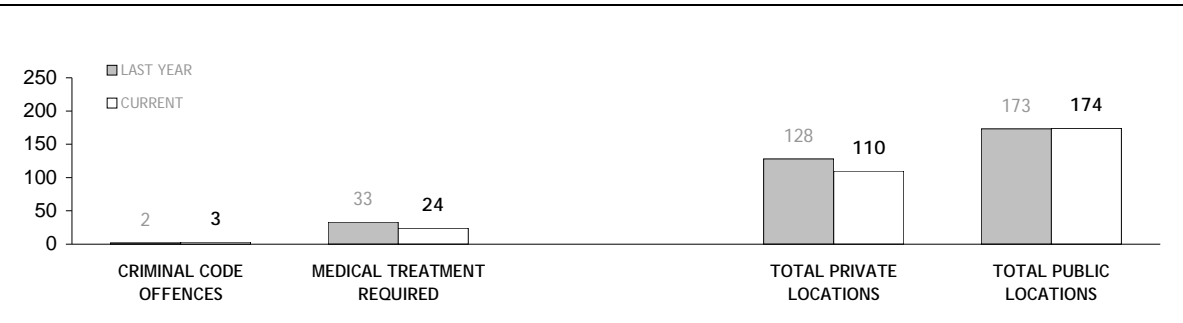
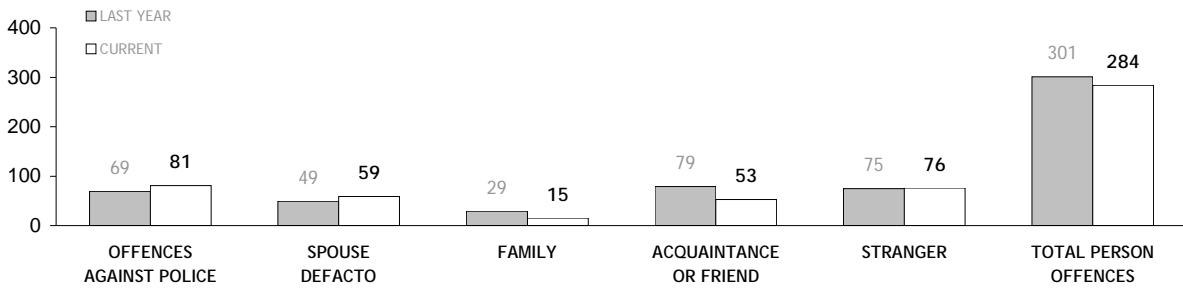

SOUTHERN DISTRICT TOTAL PERSON OFFENCES: VICTIM CATEGORIES

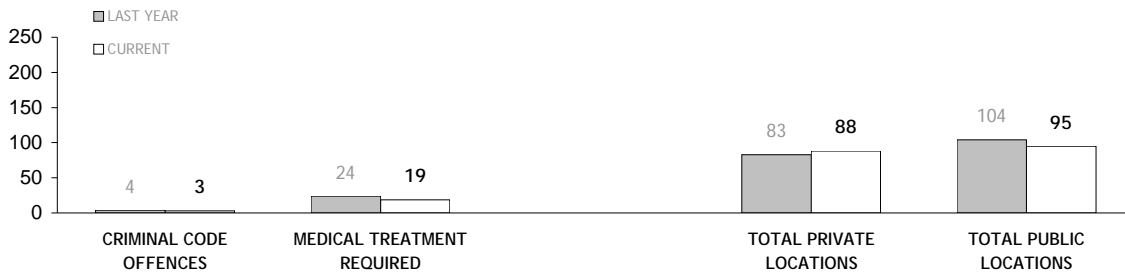
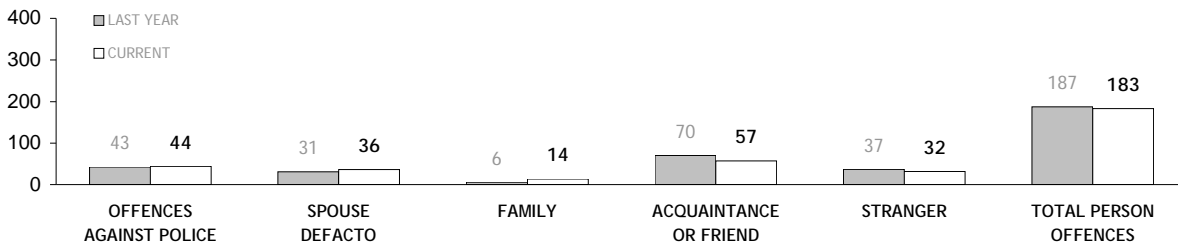

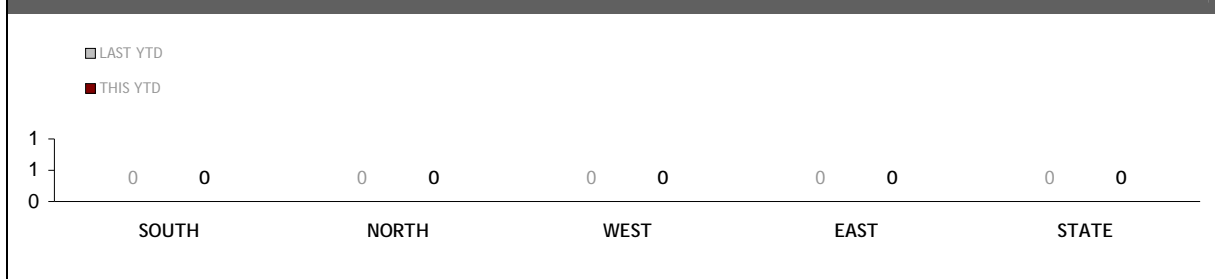

FAMILY VIOLENCE INCIDENTS: RAST NOT COMPLETED

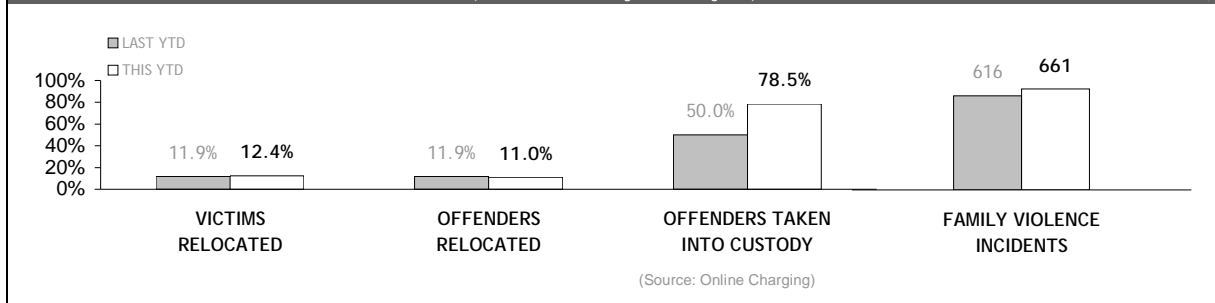

TOTAL NUMBER OF OFFENCES



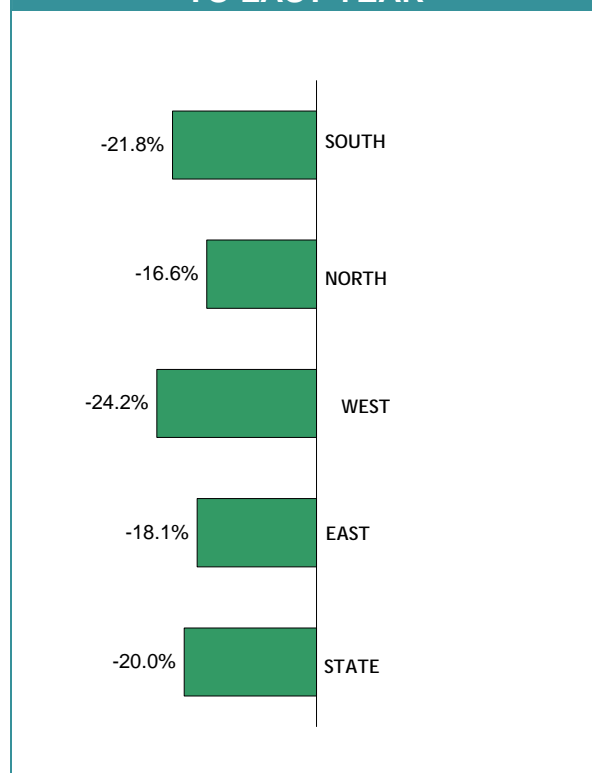

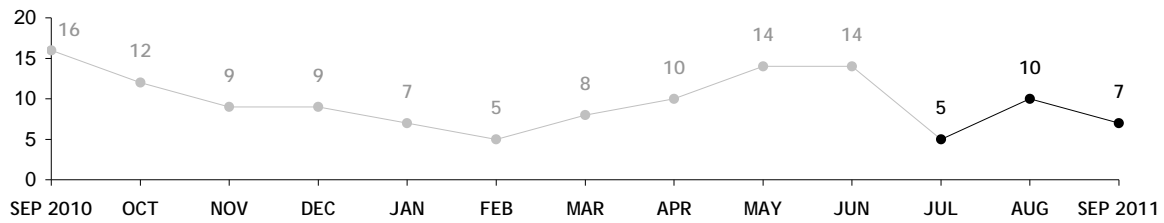
ROBBERY OFFENCES

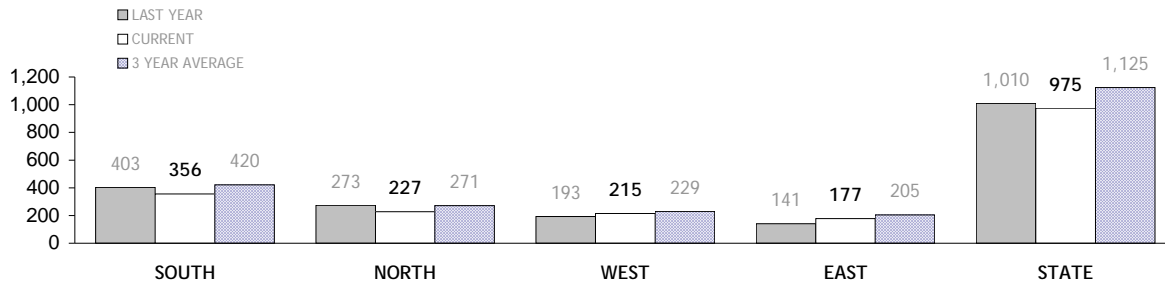
TOTAL DISTRICT SEARCH RETURNS



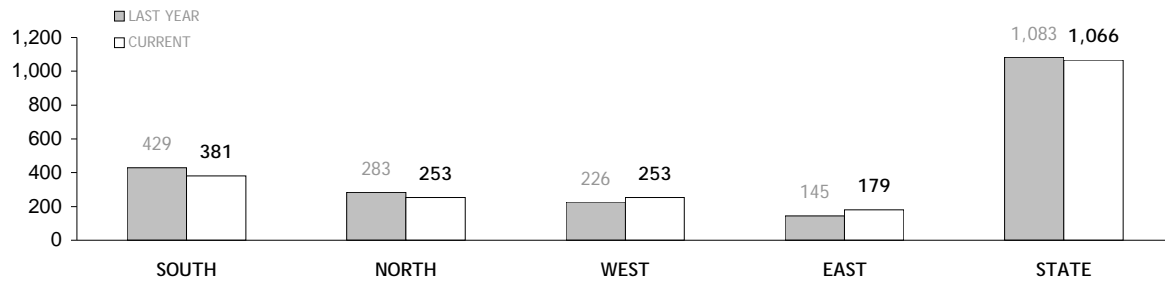

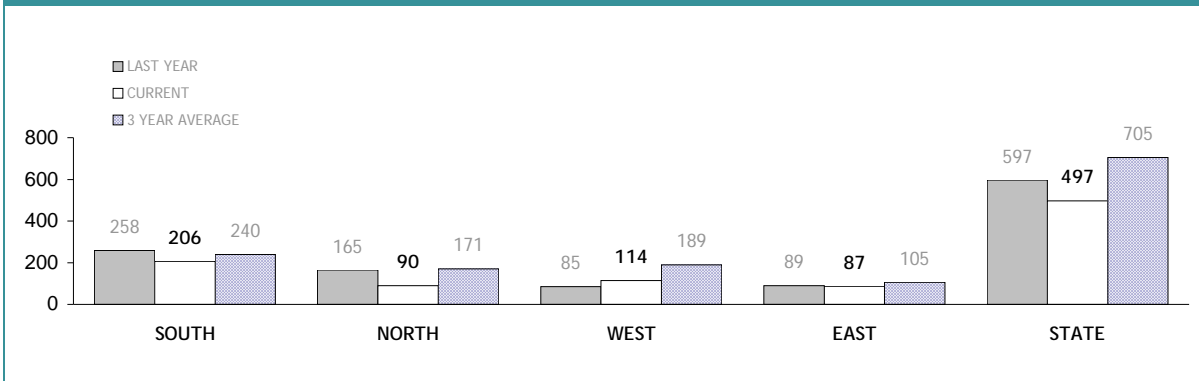
TOTAL DISTRICT DRUG DIVERSIONS



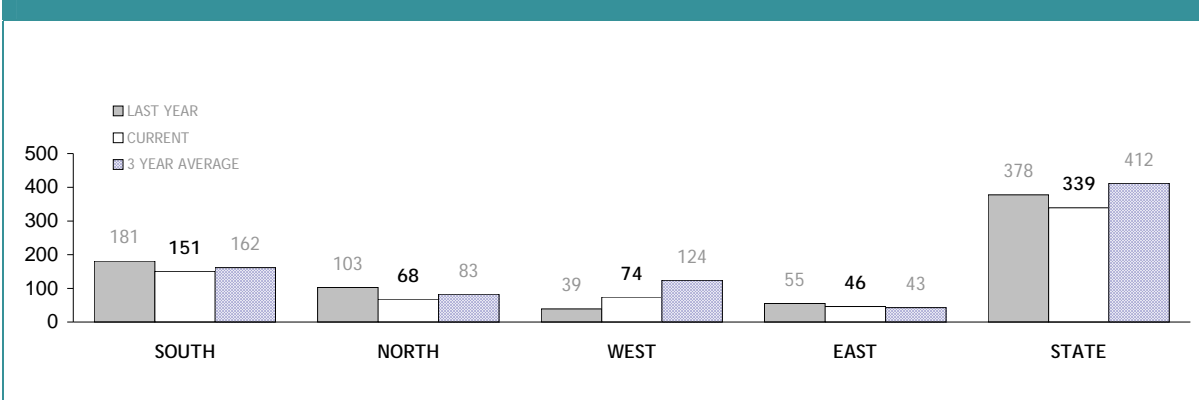

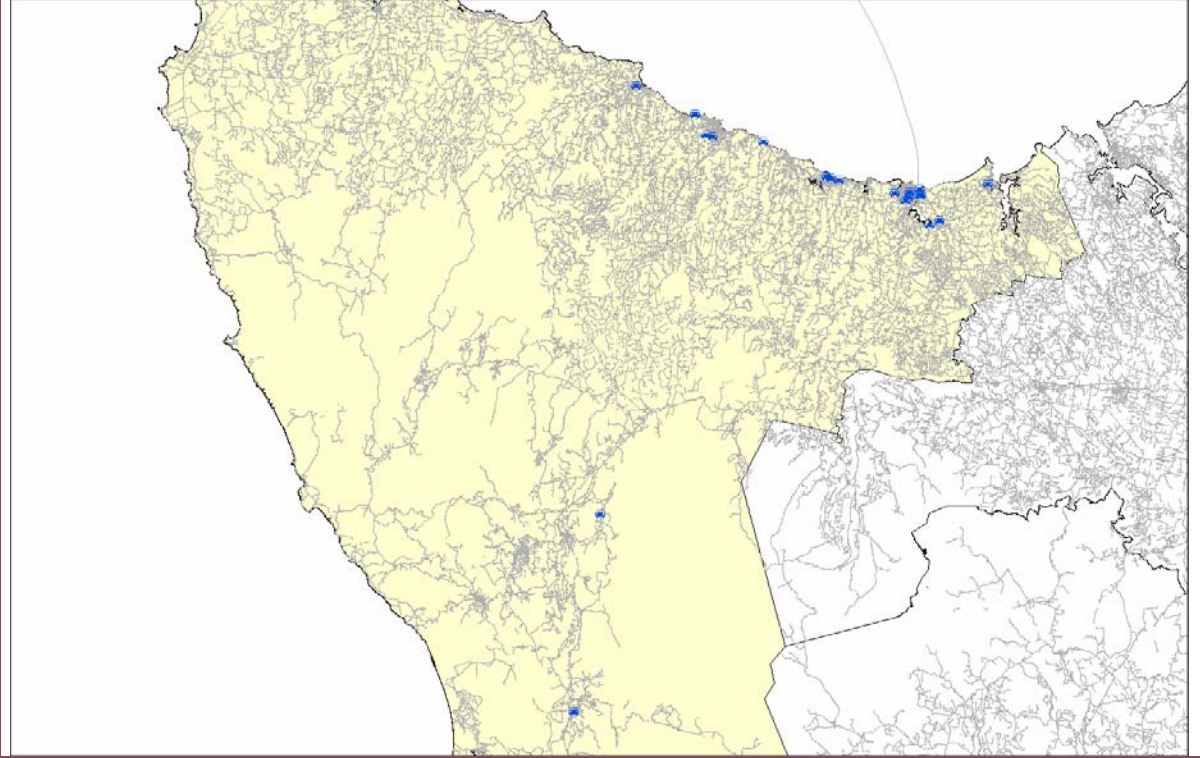

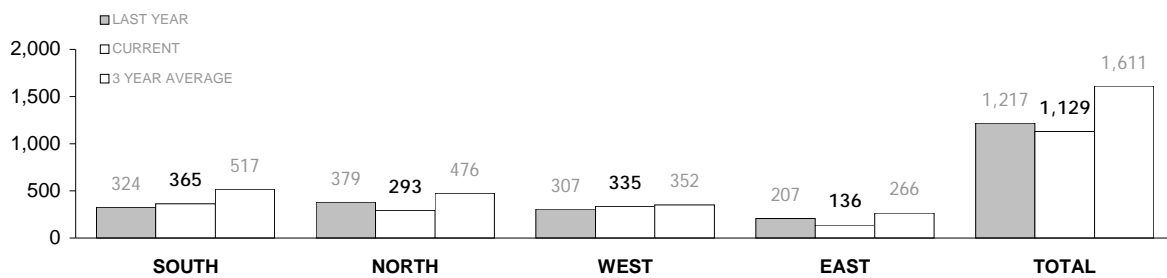
HIGH RISK TRAFFIC OFFENCES

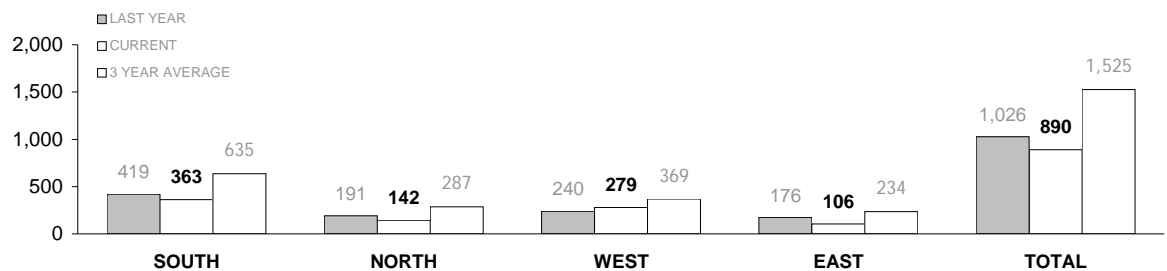
SEATBELT COMPLIANCE TINS

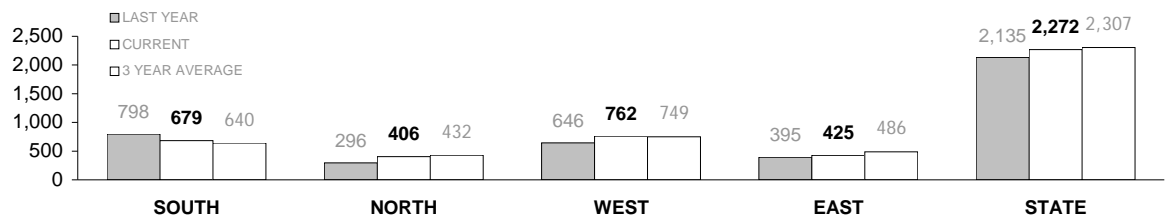

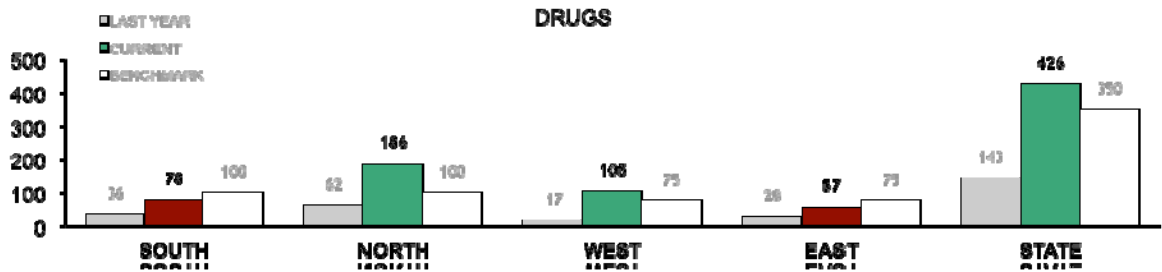
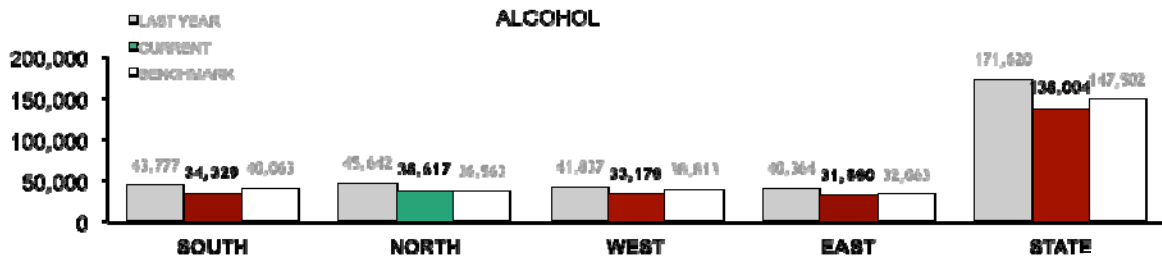


TOTAL VEHICLE DEFECT NOTICES
